
## Initial Breakdown - Charnwood

The Business Register and Employment Survey (BRES) provides employee and employment estimates at detailed geographical and industrial levels and is regarded as the definitive source of official government employee statistics by industry. The latest data released in November 2021 relates to 2020 and provides an insight into the impact of the Covid 19 pandemic on industry and related employment. Data is at a 2 digit level (Standard Industrial Code).










#### Employment Growth Districts




#### Positive Employment Growth (2019 - 2020) - LLEP Area


