
Initial Breakdown - Leicester

The latest data released in November 2021 relates to 2020 and provides an insight into the impact of the Covid 19 pandemic on industry and related employment. Data is at a 2 digit level (Standard Industrial Code).




## **Employment and Geographical Share**










## Positive Employment Growth (2019 - 2020) - LLEP Area




