
# **Leicester and Leicestershire Apprenticeship Data Summary 2021/2022**







### **LLEP area apprenticeship data update 2021/2022**

Information on full-year final data on apprenticeships and traineeships in England for the 2021/22 academic year (August 2021 to July 2022) is now available.

Please see below an easy-use summary of the LLEP area data, created to support partners and stakeholders with apprenticeship information, and to assist the aims of our LLEP Apprenticeship Strategy\*.


#### **Summary of Headlines:**

- The number of apprenticeships in the LLEP area **continues to rise but is still lower than pre-pandemic levels**. **Higher** Apprenticeships have **risen consistently** in the last three years.
- Apprentices aged **over 25 account for more than half apprenticeship starts**. However, over 25s generally account for more **lower**-level apprenticeships in the city (almost half) compared to a quarter in the county.
- **FE colleges are the largest volume providers** of apprenticeships in the LLEP area.
- **Health, Public Services and Care is the most common sector area taken**, replacing Business Administration, which is now second with **Engineering and Manufacturing third**. This is the same as the national profile.
- In the last **3 years to 2020/21 there has been a decrease in large businesses** starting apprentices, both in number and of the local proportion. An **increasing proportion of local starts are with small business** (although the number has fallen slightly).
- Large employer apprenticeship starts have fallen most noticeably in North West Leicestershire, Blaby and Leicester city.
- 5 out of 8 districts (including city) have **more female than male starters** (with one district equal).



## **Time series of apprenticeship starts**



Apprenticeship starts have increased overall in the past three years. Levels are around 1/3 lower than 2016/17 levels but relatively close to 2017/18 levels.

The number of Higher Apprenticeship starts in the LLEP area has more than tripled since 2016/17.

# Apprenticeship starts - LLEP area summary

Overall number of apprenticeships is higher than 2019/20.

However, this is still lower than the prepandemic number of 7,560 starts per year.


Higher Apprenticeships have grown consistently over the past 3 years from 24% of all apprenticeships in 2019/20 to 30% in 2021/22.

Advanced Apprenticeships are the highest category and higher than 2019/20 after a dip in 2020/21

Intermediate Apprenticeships are lower than 2019/20 but higher than 2020/21. Intermediate apprenticeships are now the smallest category representing 28% of apprenticeships.

County and City breakdown shows that the city tends to have a higher proportion of Intermediate apprenticeships.

# Apprenticeships Summary



#### Apprenticeship starts by age

The number of learners aged 25+ in the county taking Higher Apprenticeships is more than triple those taking Intermediate level.

Learners aged 25+ take 65% of all Higher Apprenticeships in the county, 40% of Advanced Apprenticeships and 25% of Intermediate apprenticeships.

The most noticeable difference with the city is that more learners aged 25+ take Intermediate Apprenticeships representing 47% of the group compared to 25% in the county.

Linked to this, under 19s represent 28% of Intermediate Apprenticeships in the city, whereas the figure is 47.5% in the county.

## Apprenticeship providers in LLEP area

Leicester College is the highest provider in the LLEP area. 3 of the top 4 providers are FE colleges. The fourth, Lifetime training, provide cross sector training at all levels.

Learners aged 25+ is almost double the number of under 19s.

Approximately 1 in 6 apprenticeships is provided by Leicestershire's Further Education colleges.

- Health, Public Services and Care
- Business, Administration and Law
- Engineering and Manufacturing
- Retail and Commercial Enterprise


This has changed from 2020/21 when Business was top, Health second and Retail third.

The order is the same as the national profile.

The most popular apprenticeships include several managerial and professional services jobs which is counter to more traditional stereotypes of apprenticeships.

Popular roles include:

- Team Leader of supervisor
- Accountancy or Taxation professional
- Operations or Departmental manager


#### Apprenticeships by business size (2020/21 data)


The majority of apprenticeship starts are with large businesses (over 250 employees) with the second highest group small businesses (0-49 employees).

Medium sized businesses (50-249) are the smallest group.

Although the order has not changed, the number of apprenticeship starts with large businesses has fallen as a proportion with the actual numbers falling from 4380 to 2890 over 3 years.


The same period has seen growth in the proportion of small businesses taking on an apprentice as a percentage of the LLEP total. However, the actual number has still fallen, from 2070 to 1770.








The above graph shows how apprenticeship starts by business size have changed over the previous 3 years. This demonstrates areas where large changes have happened, impacting the overall LLEP figure. Most notably falls in large employer apprenticeship starts in Blaby, Leicester and NW Leicestershire.

# **Demographics by District**










#### **LLEP area advertised apprenticeship vacancy information\***

Advertised pay for apprenticeships (where given), has increased by 21.9% during this time-period. The median advertised pay for apprenticeships, where given, is £17.1k per year. Please note, in the majority of advertised vacancies pay is not detailed in the advert. The top 7 most advertised job areas for apprenticeships are:

- Business administration roles
- Chefs
- Customer service roles
- IT user support roles
- Nursery nurse and assistants
- Marketing and sales leads
- Engineering technicians
