





### SPOTLIGHT STORY - It's time to update your **Provider Access Policy!**

The Provider Access Legislation is new guidance that came into force in January 2023. It builds on Benchmark 7 and adds new specific requirements for schools. It's a key mechanism to further help learners understand and take-up, not just apprenticeships, but wider technical education options such as T-Levels and Higher Technical Qualifications.


