

Melton Annual Economic Profile 2023

Introduction

Since the completion of the last economic profile (2022) there have been many changes to the economy.

The completion of the last profile was marked by the reopening of the economy and the withdrawal of government support for business following the Covid 19 pandemic. The reopening of markets saw a resetting of the economy which led to some businesses/ industries having to rethink how they operate/ do business.

Some businesses/ industries were affected more than others. For many this has been a tough period of trading that has been further exasperated by world events. The resetting of and recovery of the economy looks to go well beyond 2023, the war in Ukraine, staff and skills shortages, energy prices, Brexit, a cost of living crises and inflationary pressures are set to prolong recovery and uncertainty is likely to remain a key feature of the local and national economies.

Purpose

Annual Economic Profiles have been produced since 2013. Their purpose is to bring together data from a variety of sources that:

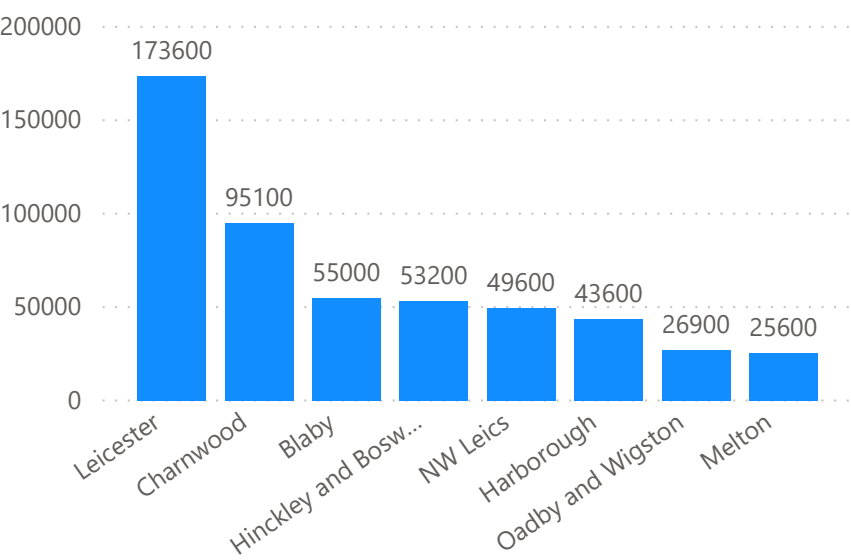
- Help provide a snapshot of the local economy.

Note: It is important to understand that some data supplied has time-lags. As a result data may not fully appreciate how local and national events have impacted the economy.

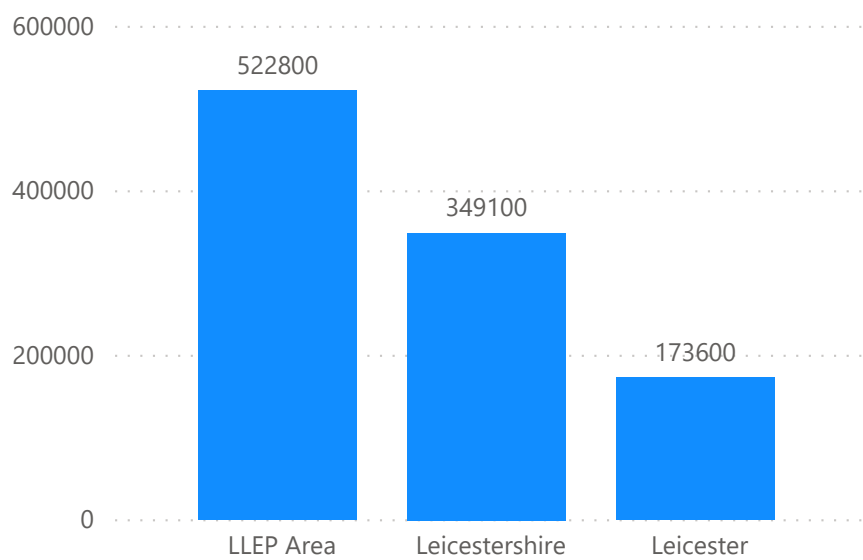
Economic Activity

In the Melton area 25,600 people were economically active. This was 88.6% of those that were of working age. The England average was 78.7%.
The 26,500 make up 4.9% of the working age population of the Leicester and Leicestershire area that are economically active.

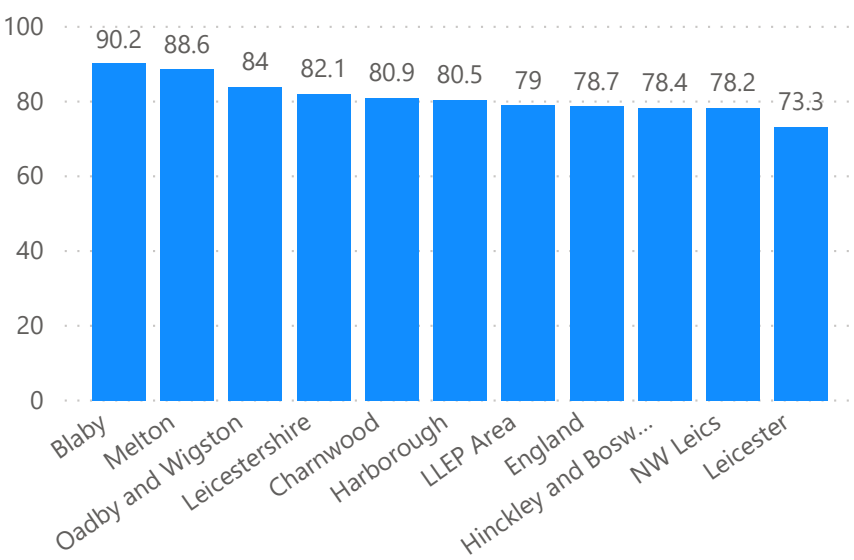

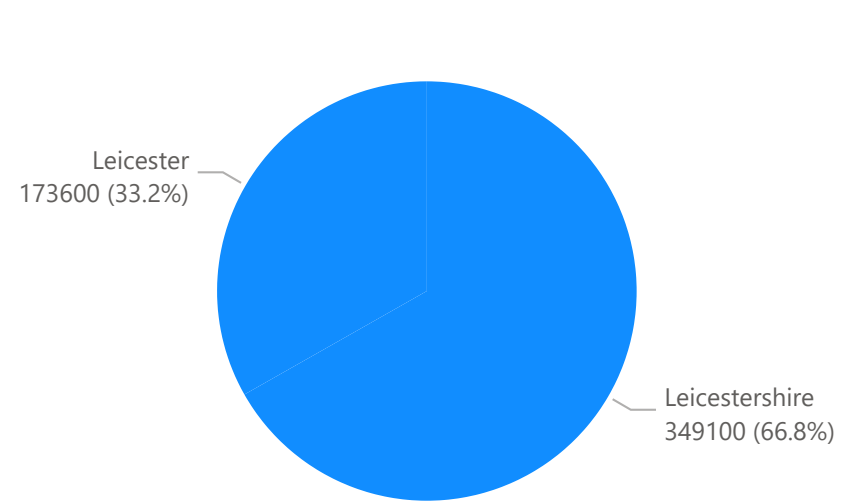
Activity LA Numbers



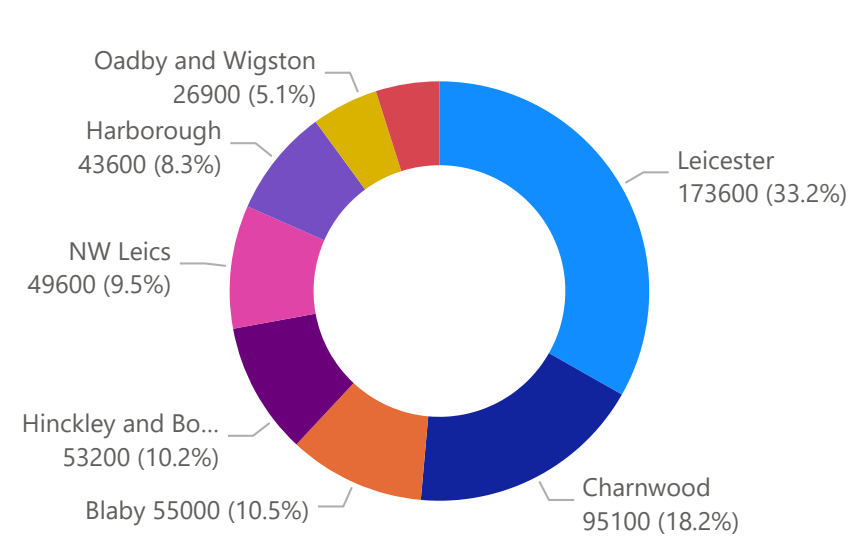
Activity District Share



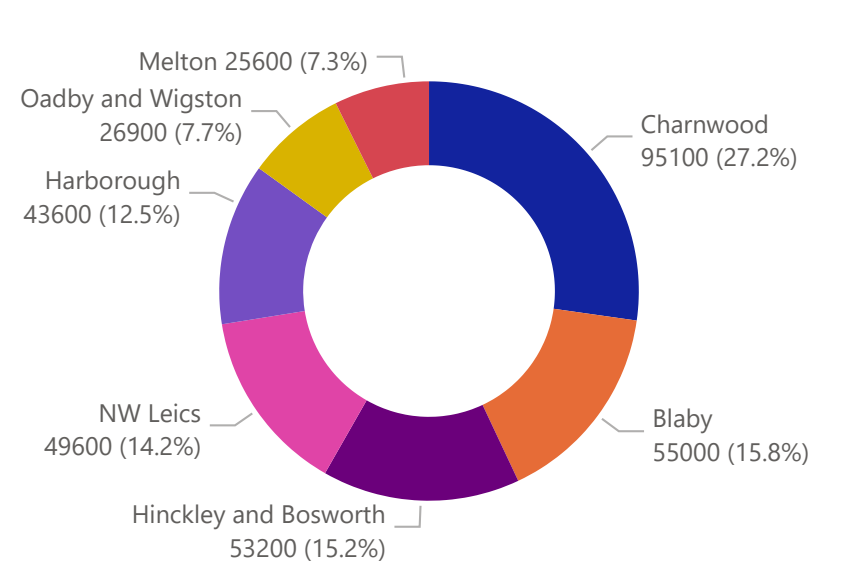

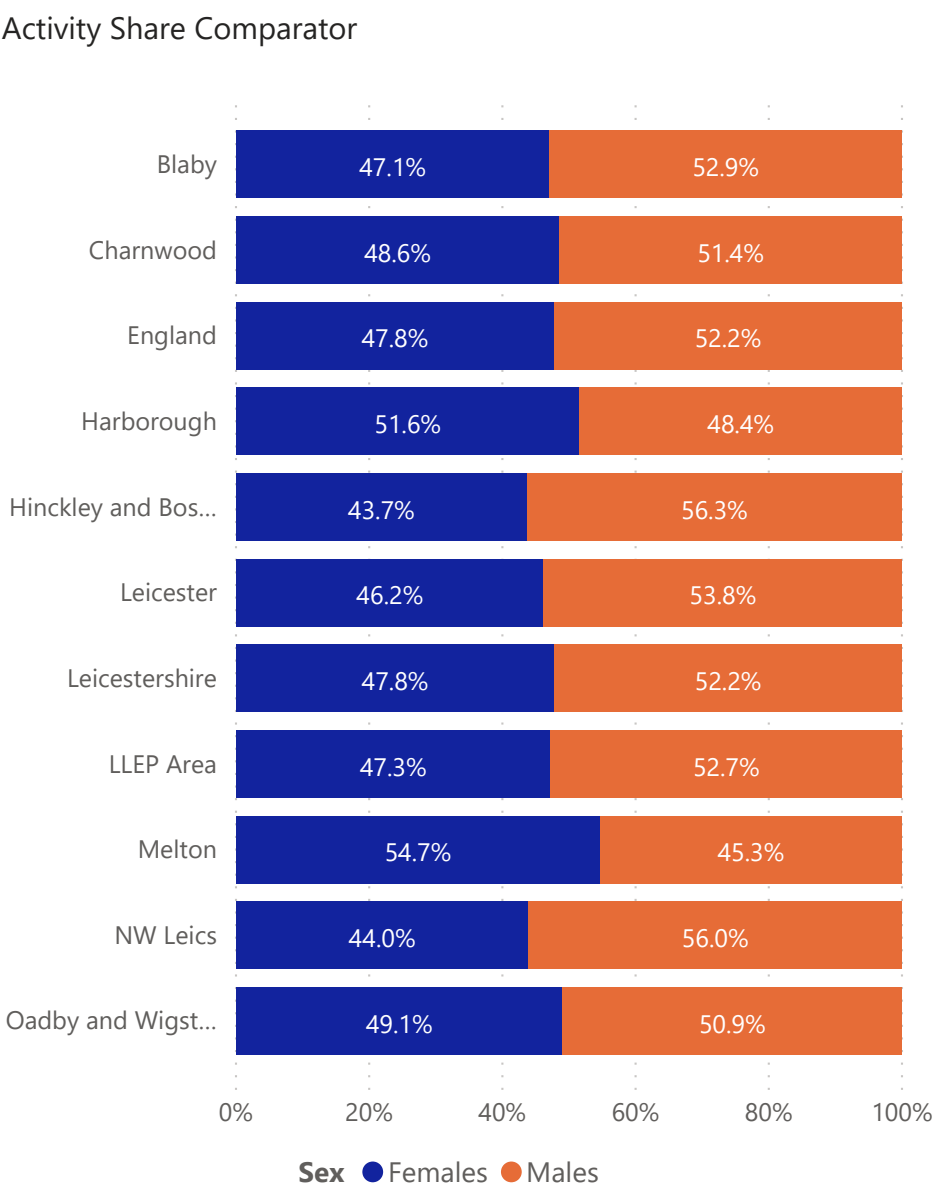
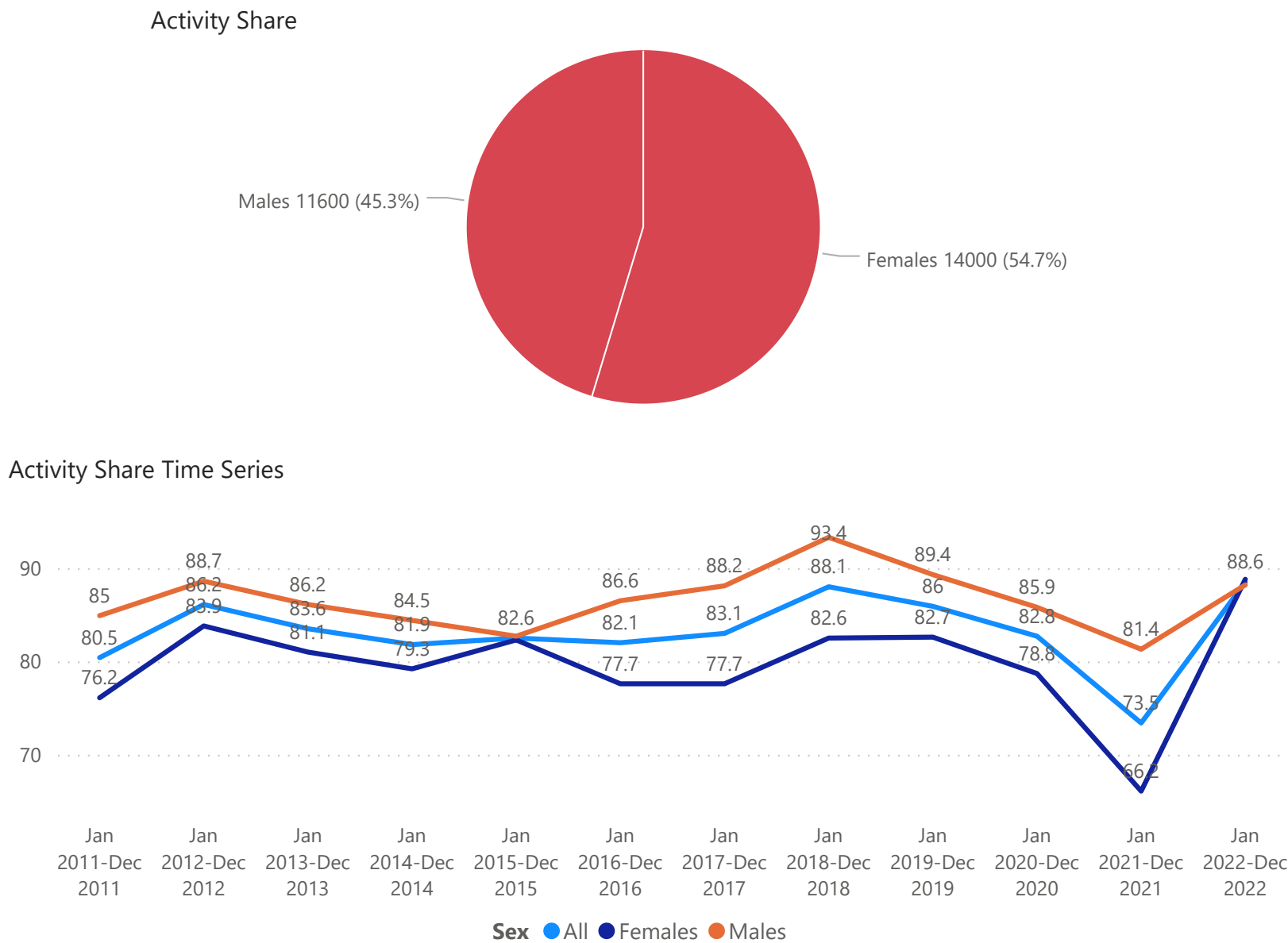


Activity Share (Leicestershire)



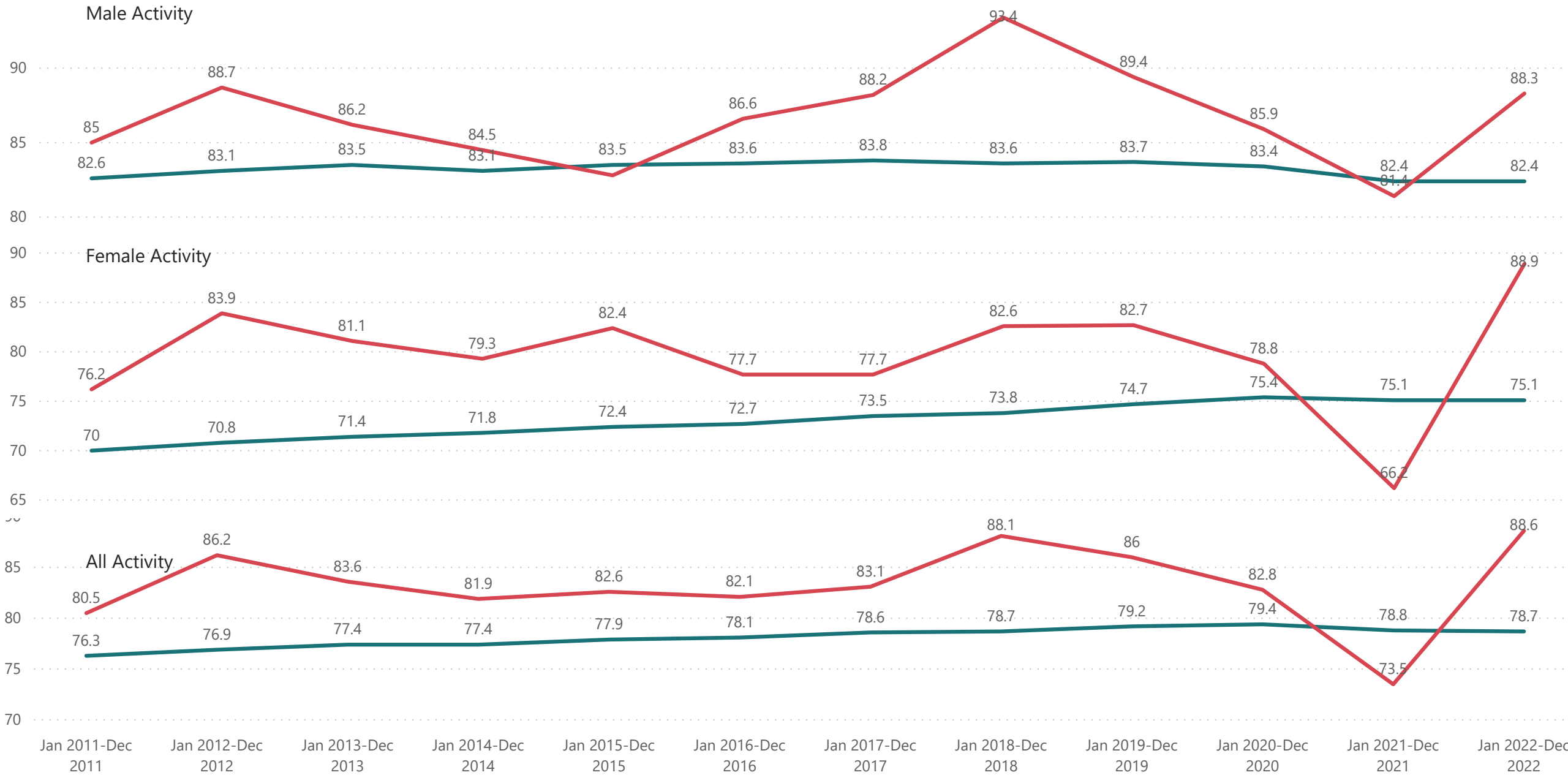
Economic Activity Sex

Of the male working age population 88.3% (11,600) were economically active. Of the female working age population 88.9% (14,000) were active.
Forty five point three percent of those who were economically active were male and 54.7% were female.

Area England Melton

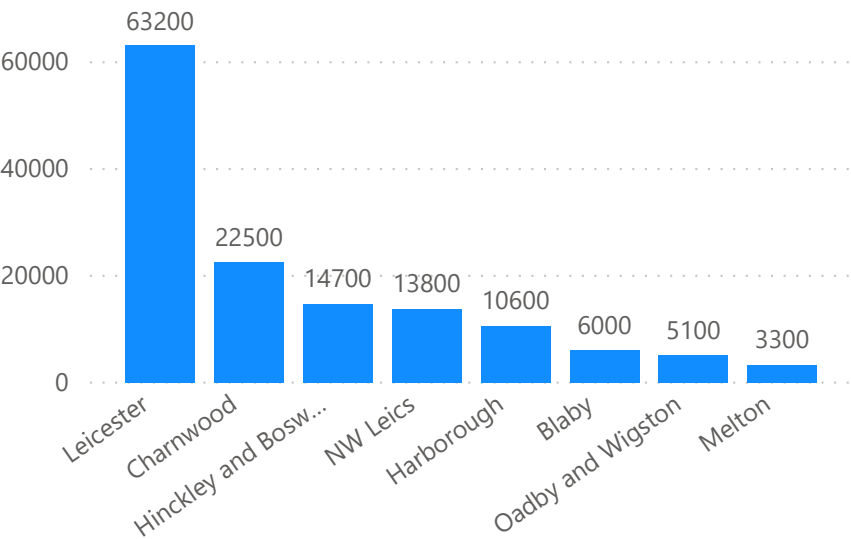


Economic Inactivity

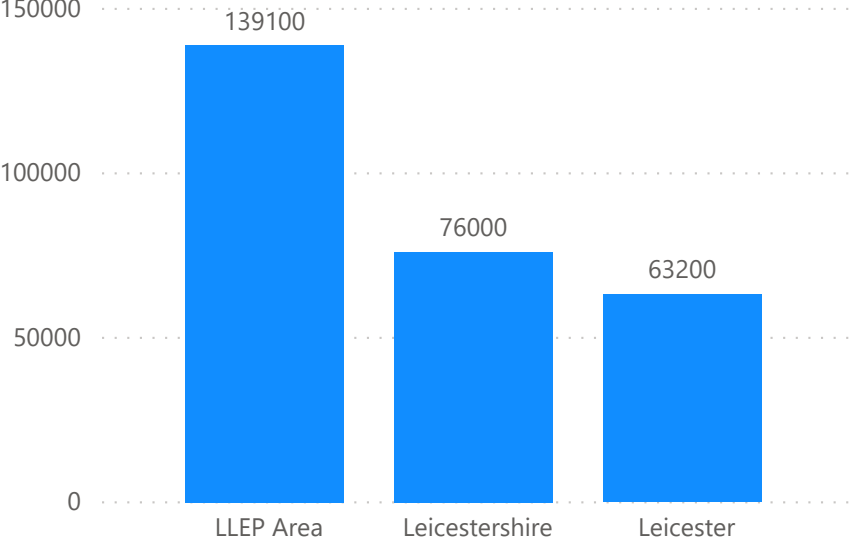
In the Melton area 3,300 were economically inactive. This was 11.4% of those that were of working age. The average was 21.3%.

Of those that were of working age that were economically inactive, in the Leicester and Leicestershire area, 2.4% lived in Melton.

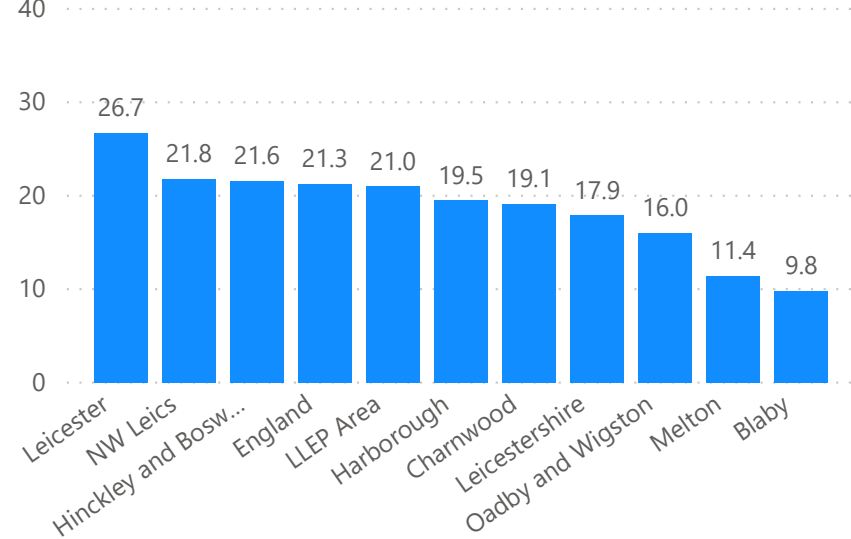

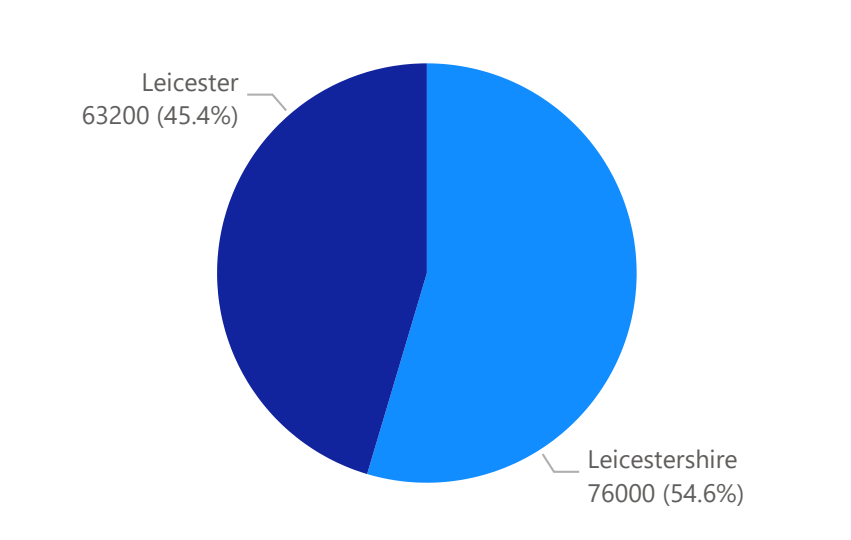
Inactivity LA Numbers



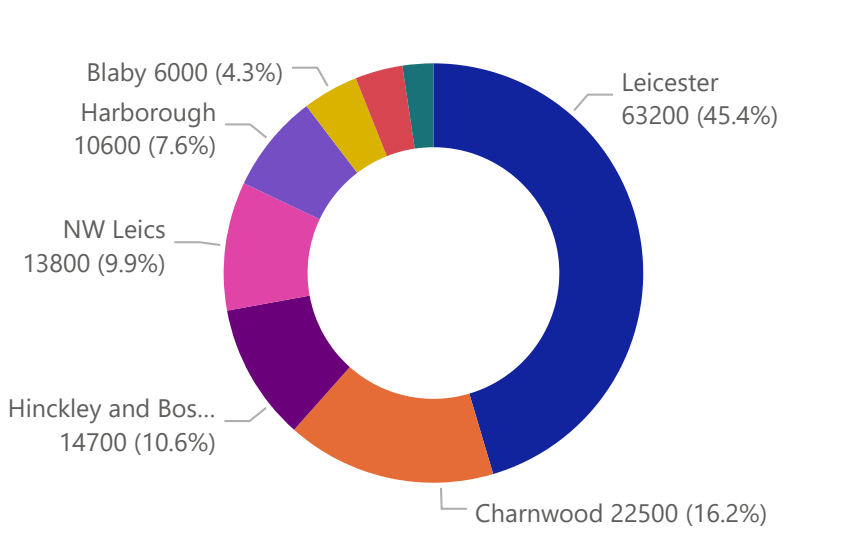
Inactivity District Share



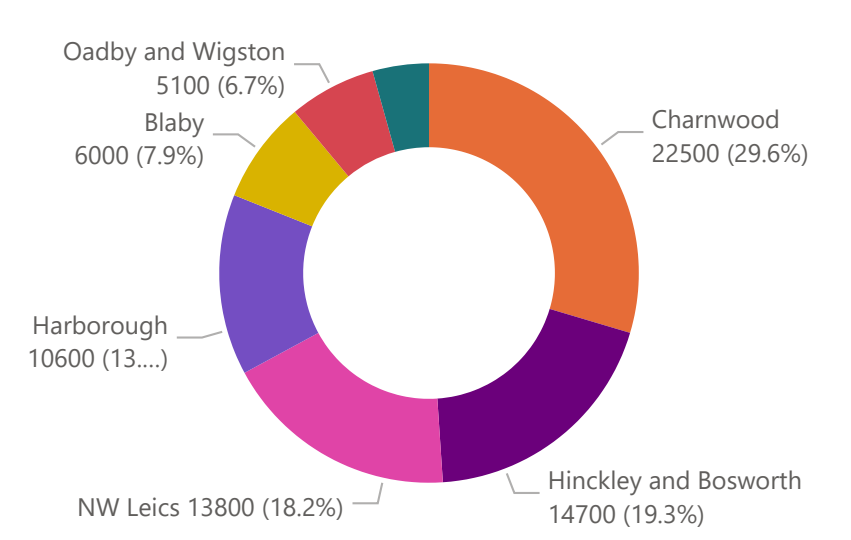
Inactivity LA Share



Inactivity Share (LLEP Area)



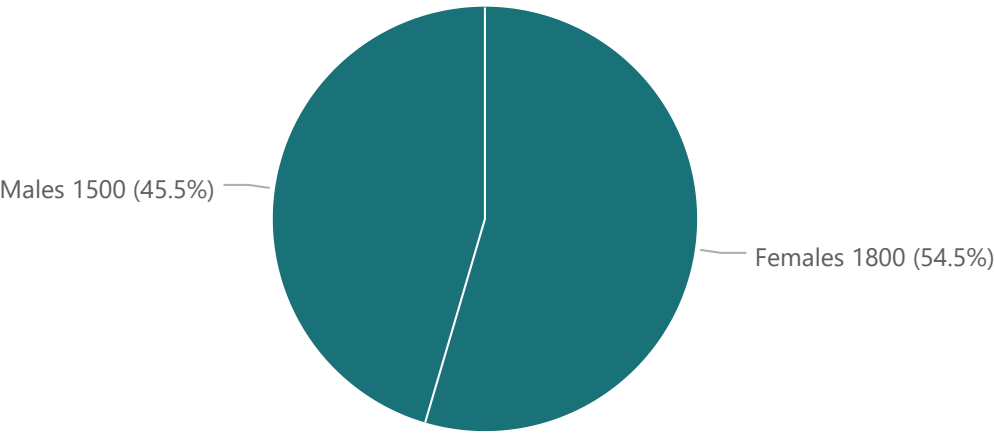
Inactivity Share (Leicestershire)



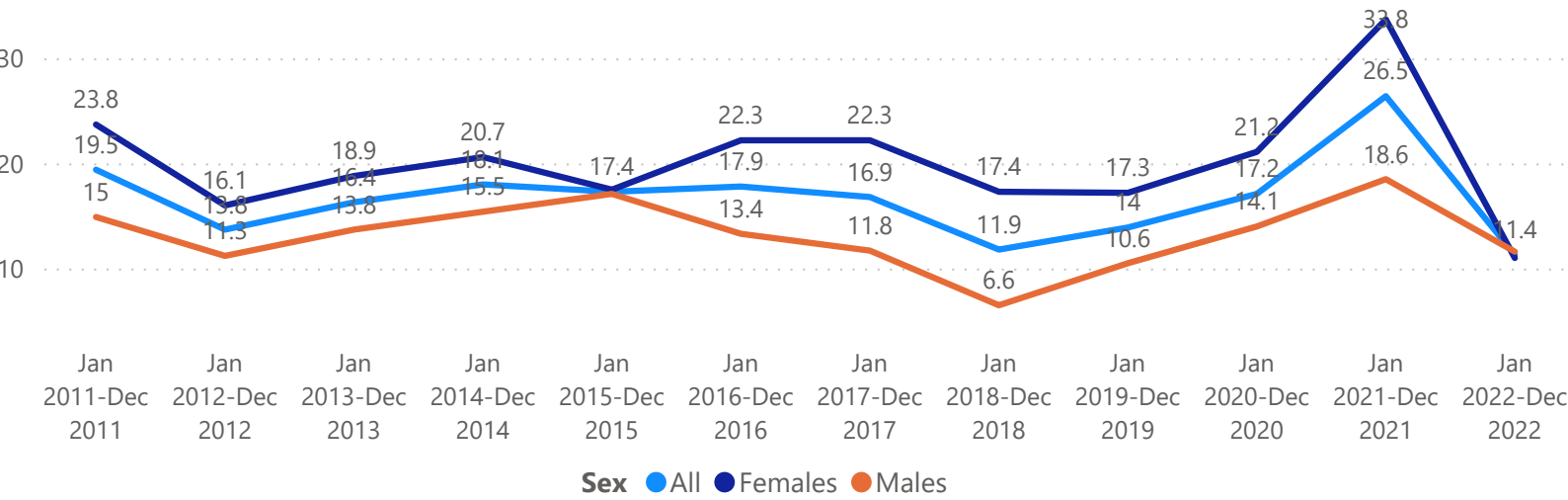
Economic Inactivity Sex

Of the male working age population 11.7% (1,500) were economically inactive. Of the female working age population 11.1% (1,800) were inactive.
Fifty four point five percent of those that were inactive were female and 45.5% male.

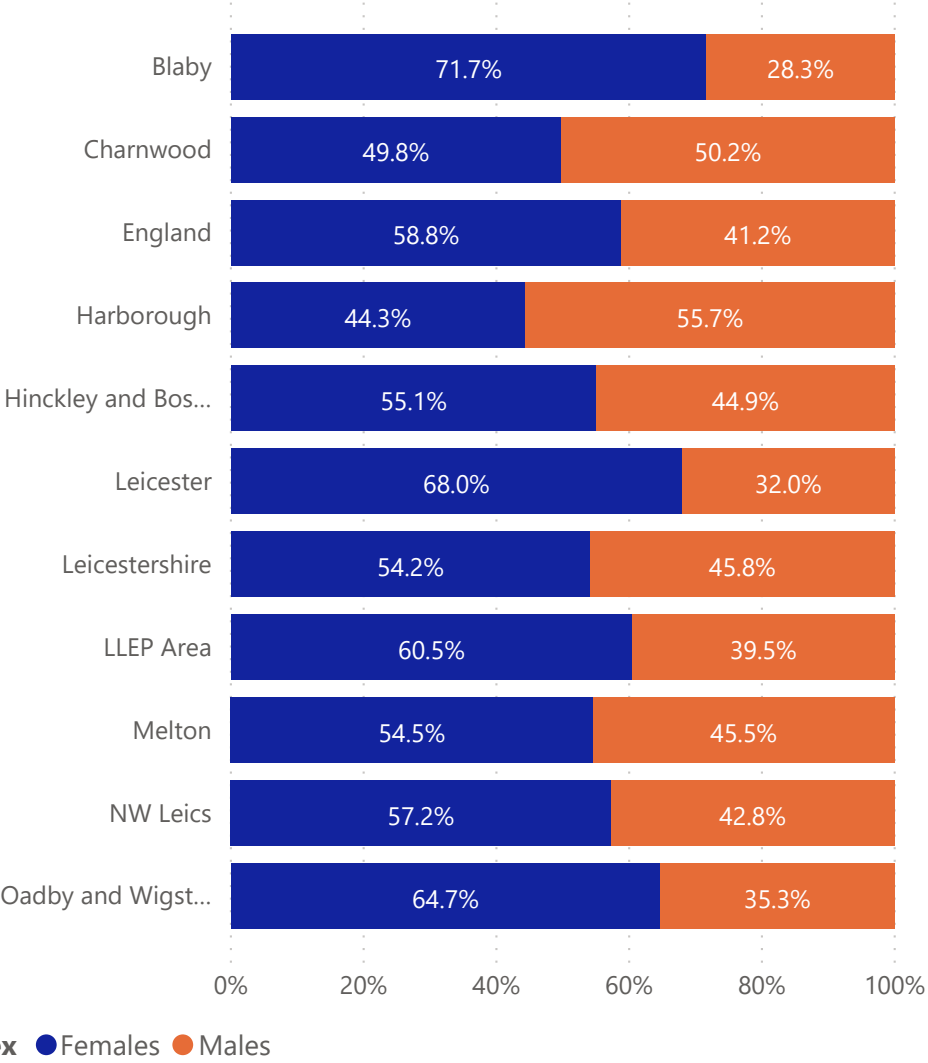
Inactivity Share



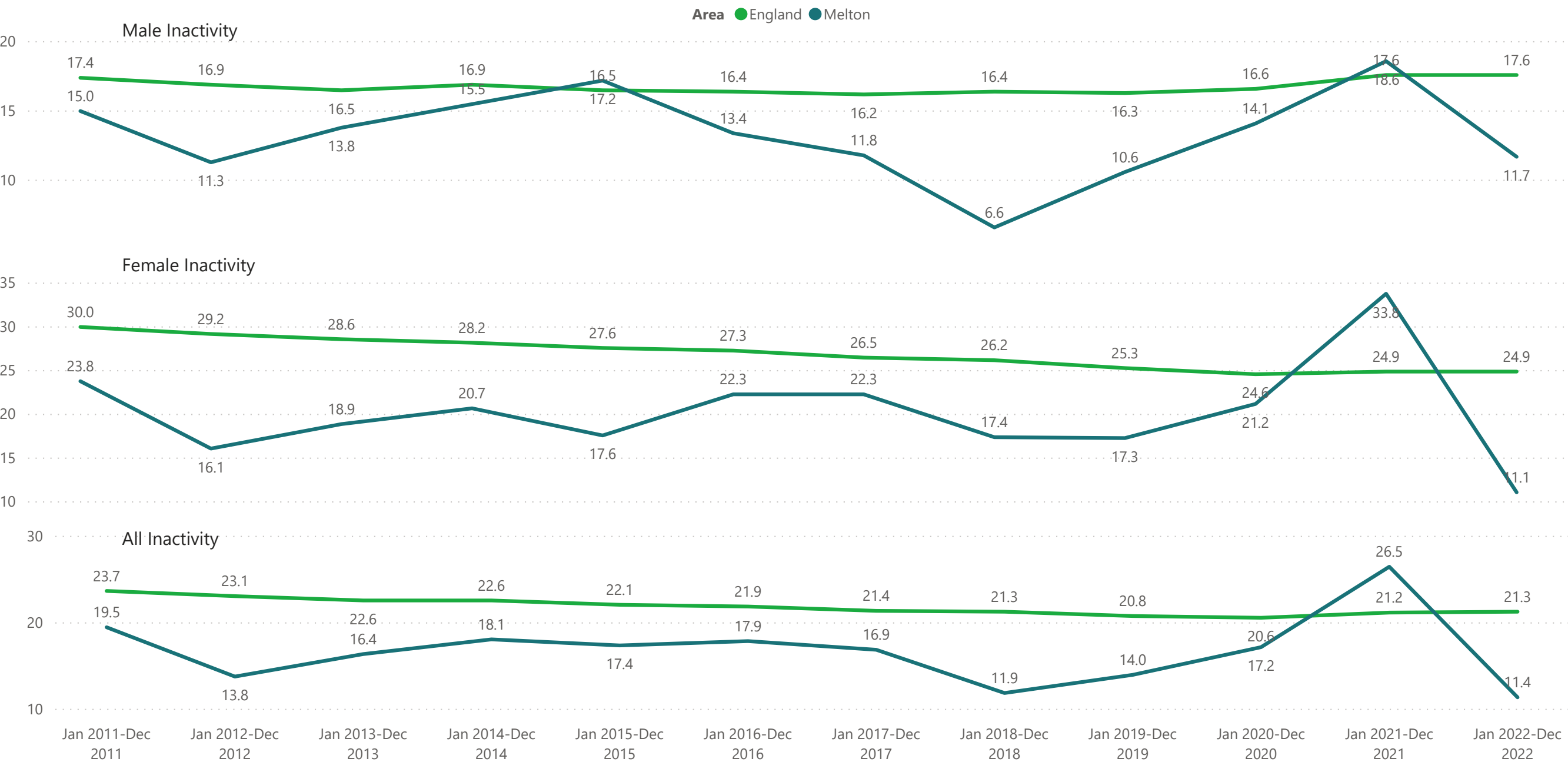
Inactivity Share Time Series



Inactivity Share Comparator

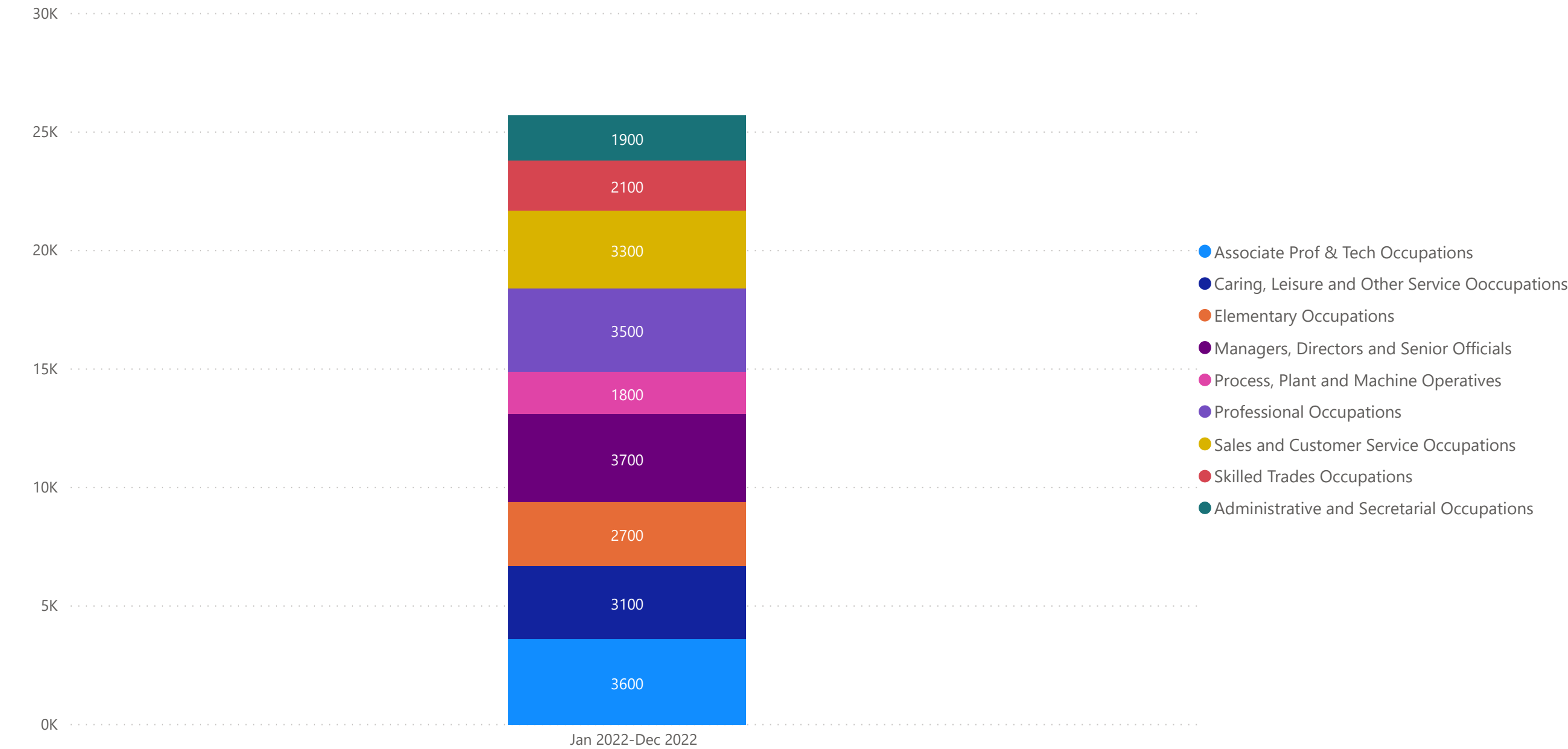


Economic Inactivity Sex



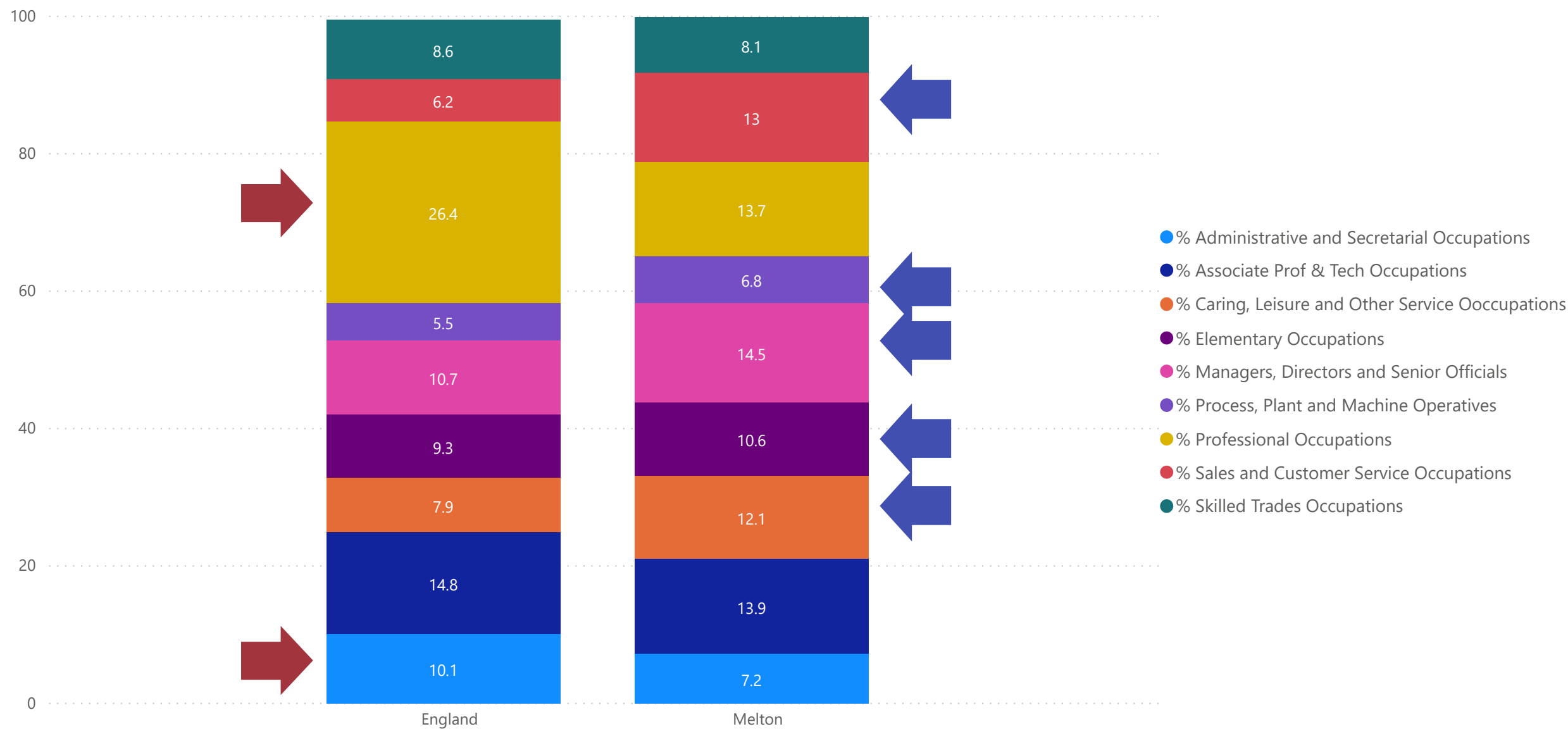
Job Type Occupation Numbers

With 3,700 Managers, Directors and Senior Officials is the largest of the broad occupation areas identified.

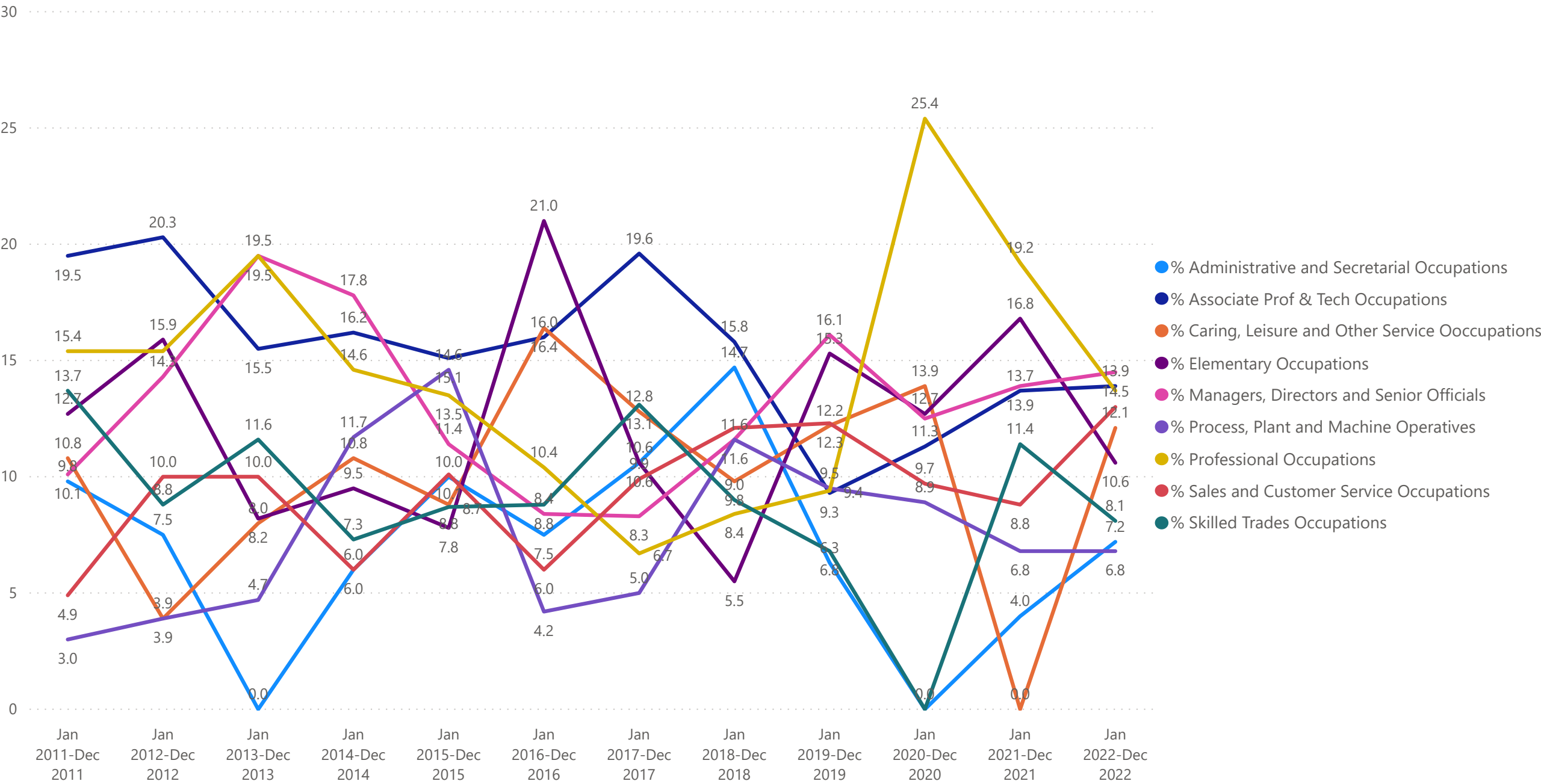


Job Type Occupation Share

Of the broad occupation areas identified there were 6 with a 10% share or more of jobs. With a share of 14.5% of all jobs Managers, Directors and Senior Officials. is the largest occupation area.. The Melton area has on average a larger share of Sales and Customer Service, Process, Plant and Machine Operatives, Managers, Directors and Senior Officials, Elementary Occupations and Caring, Leisure and Other Service Occupations. There are on average fewer Professional, Administration and Secretarial occupations. In the case of Professional occupations this is significant.

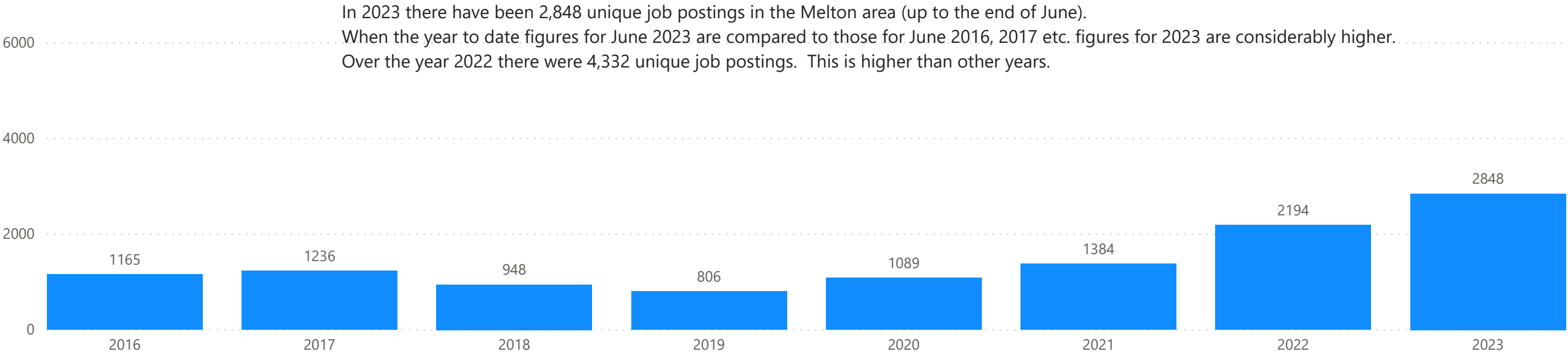


Job Type - Growth (2011 - 2022)

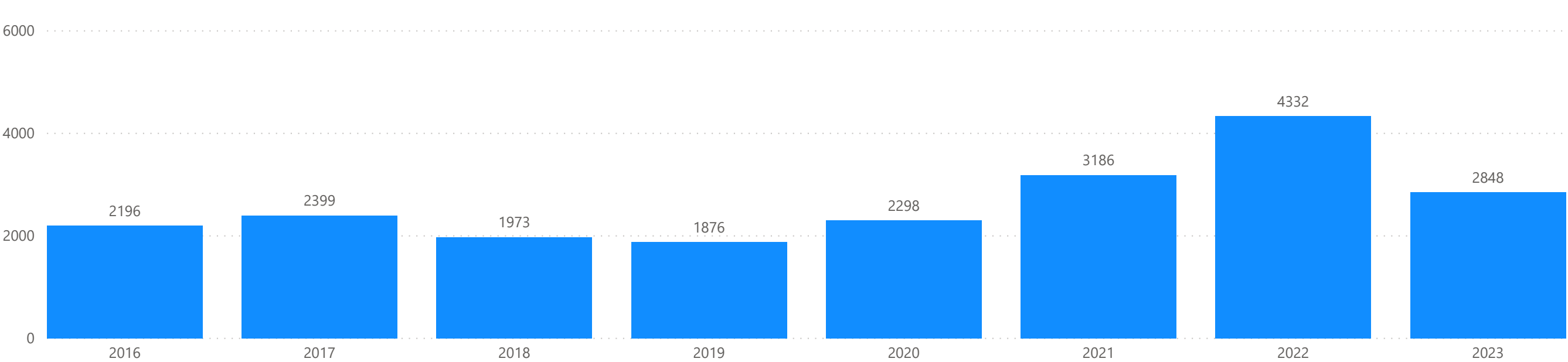


Job Postings Year to Date

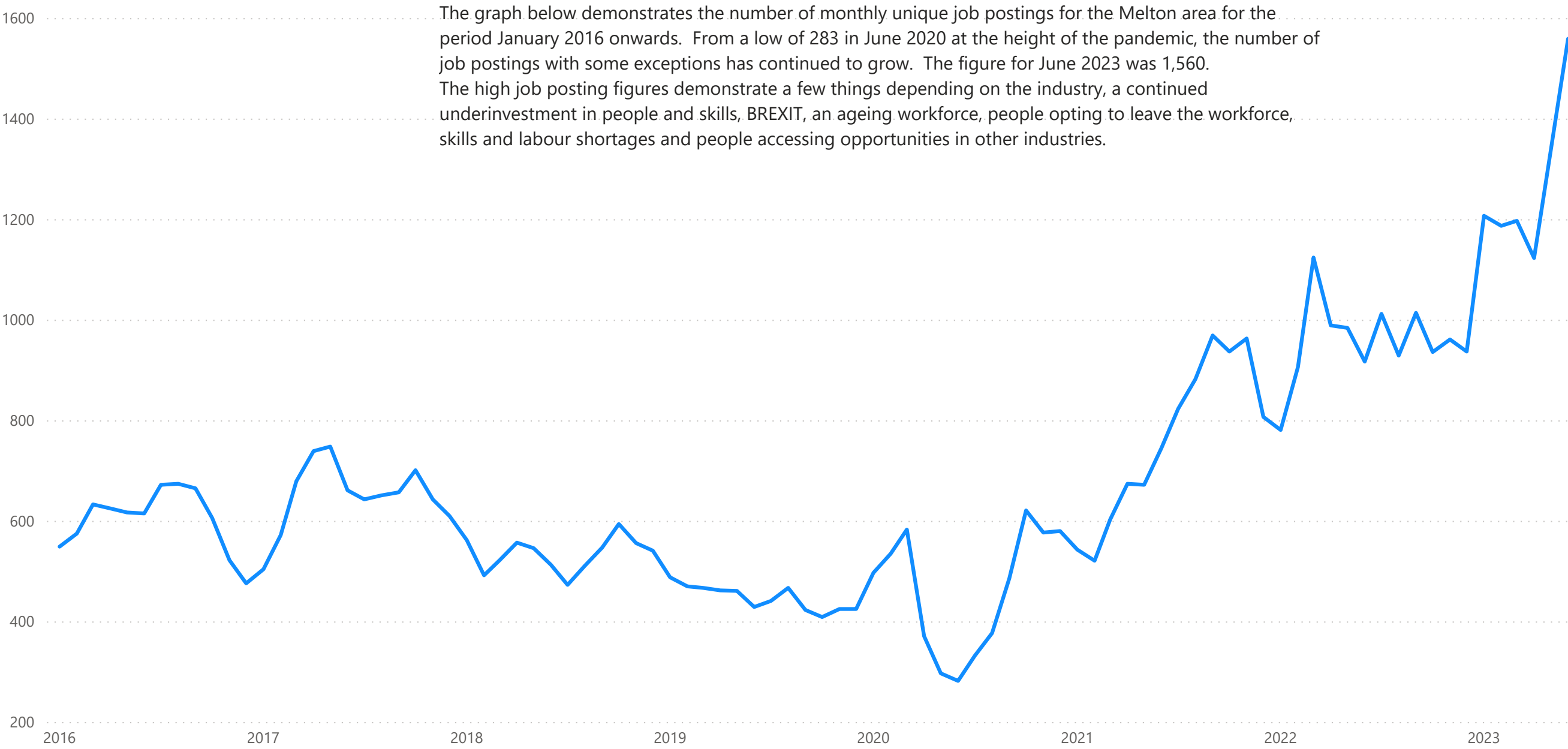


Job Postings Year to Date (Whole Year)



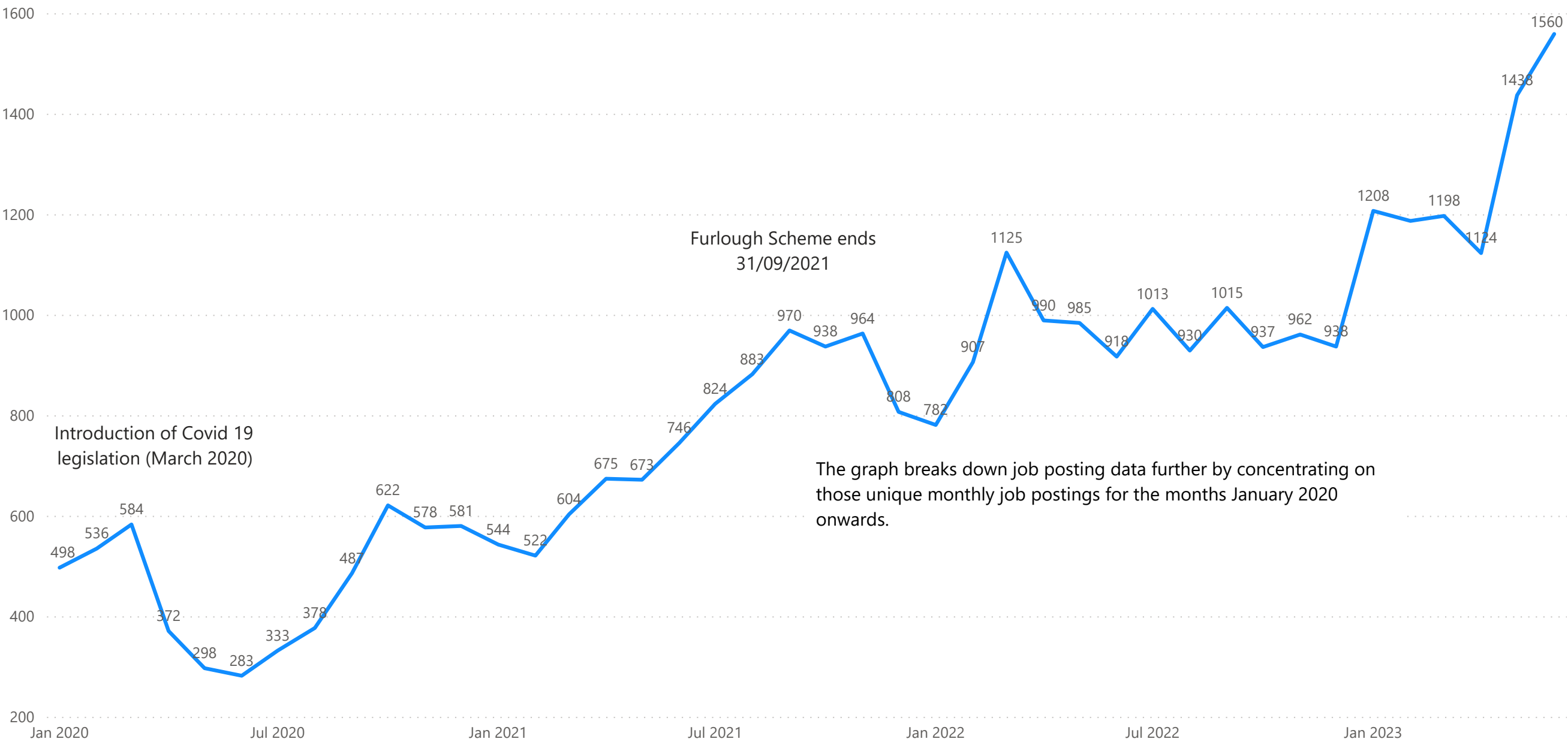

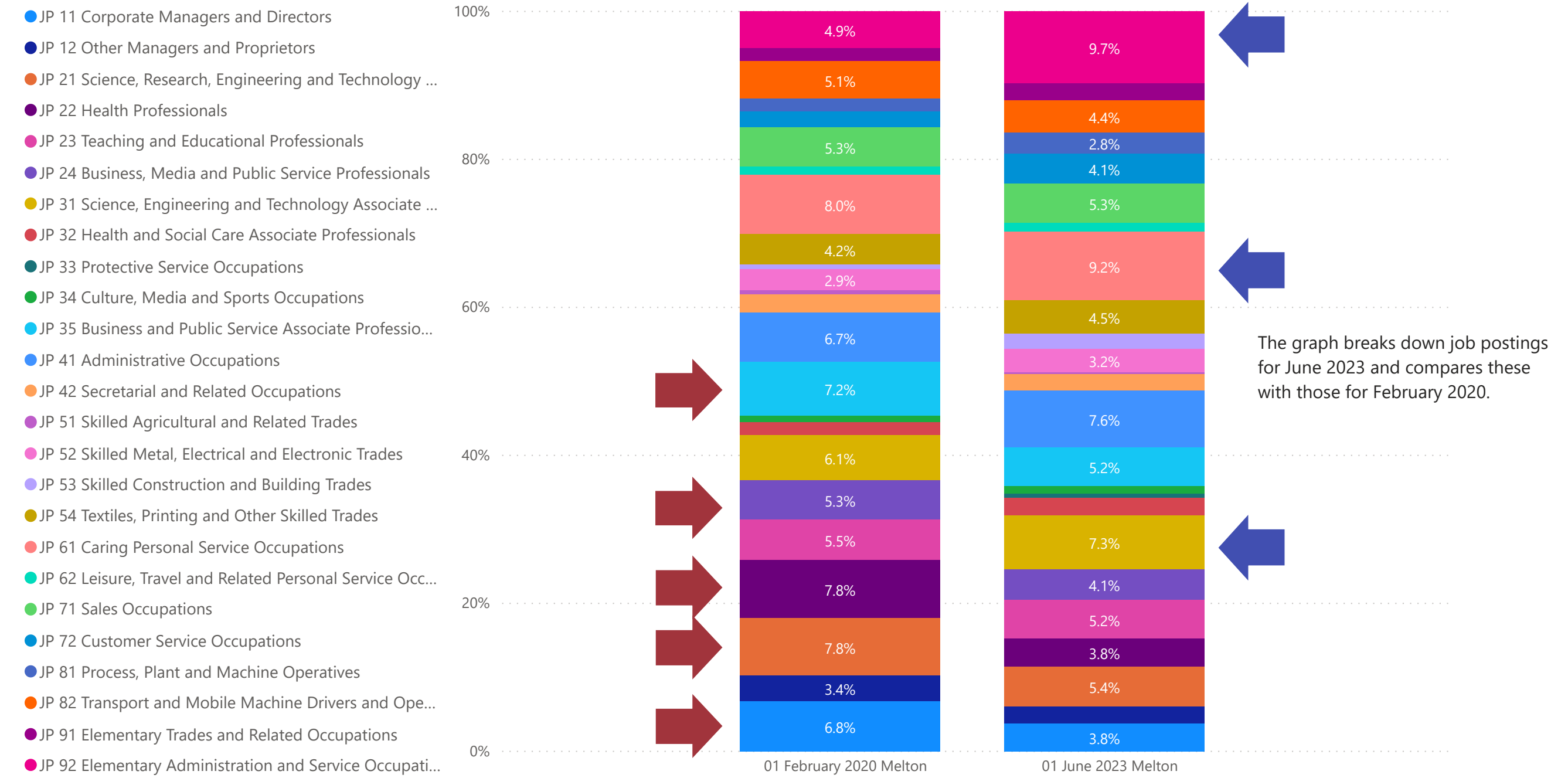

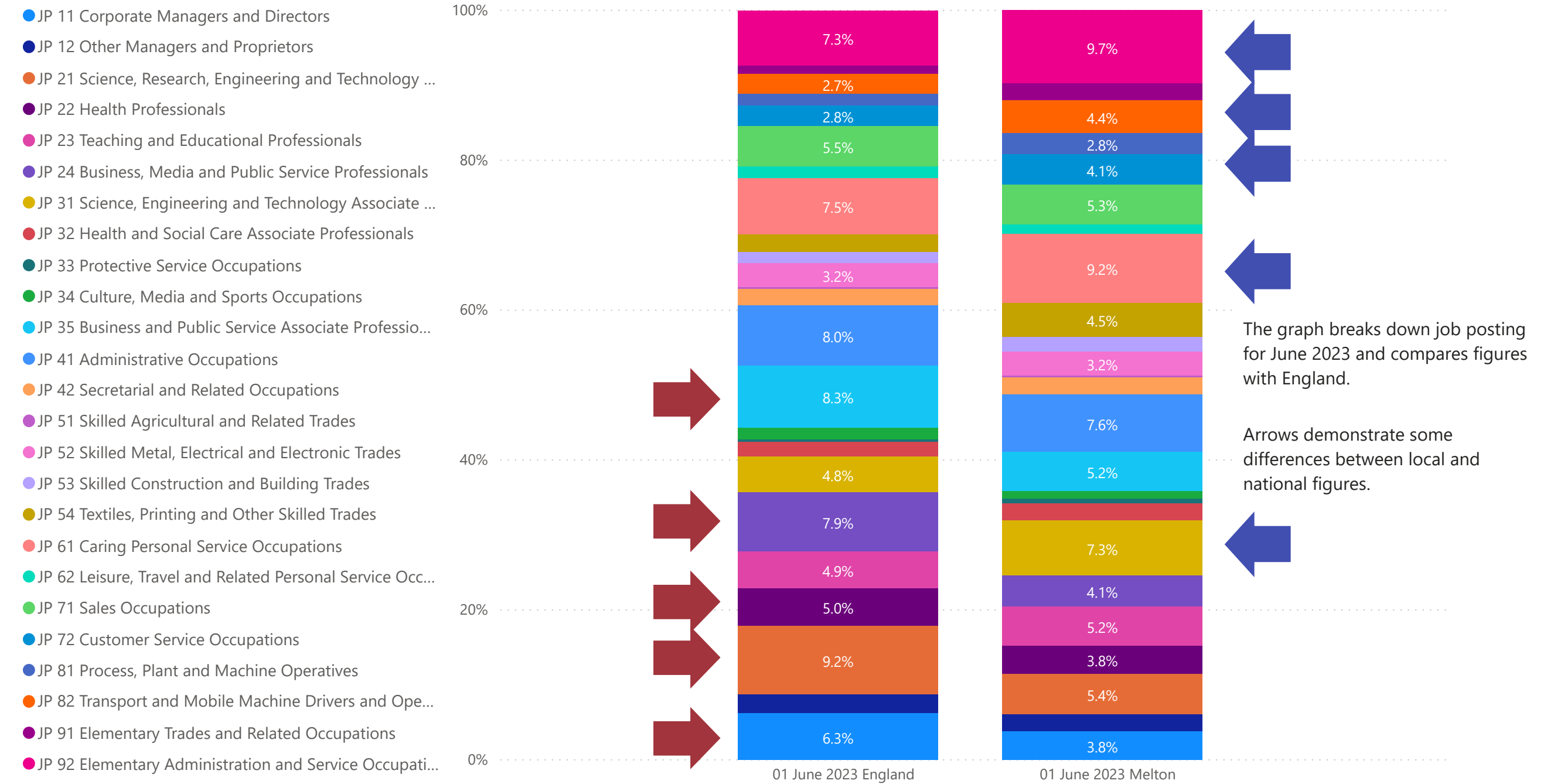

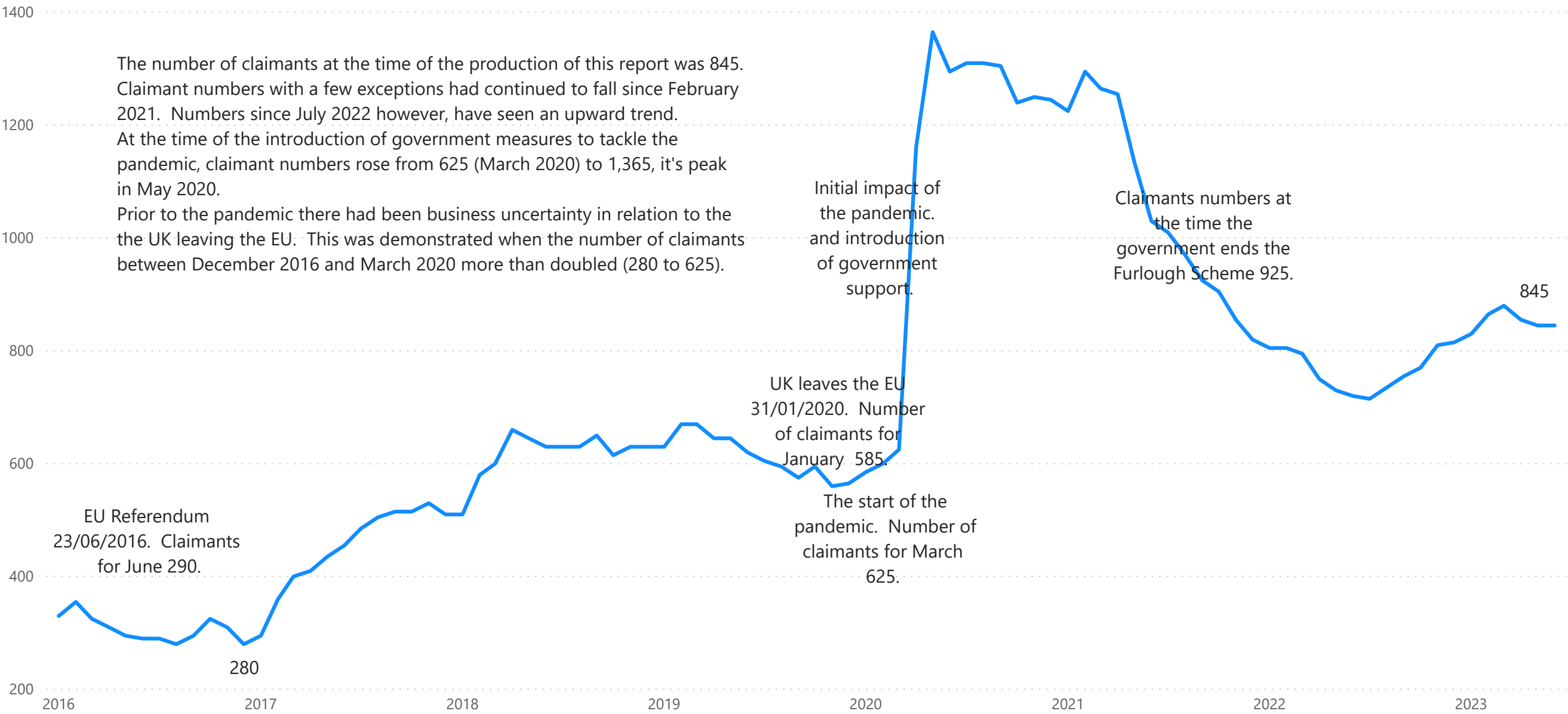

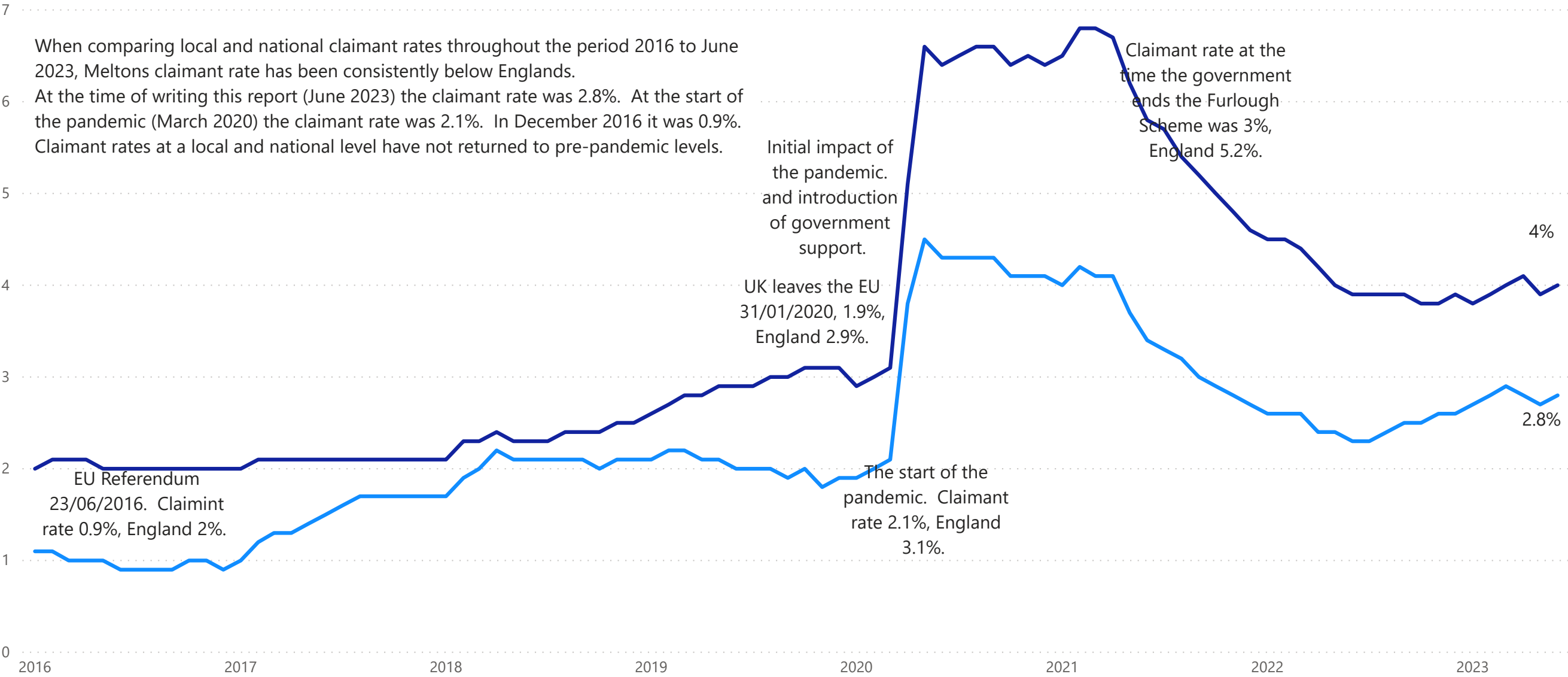

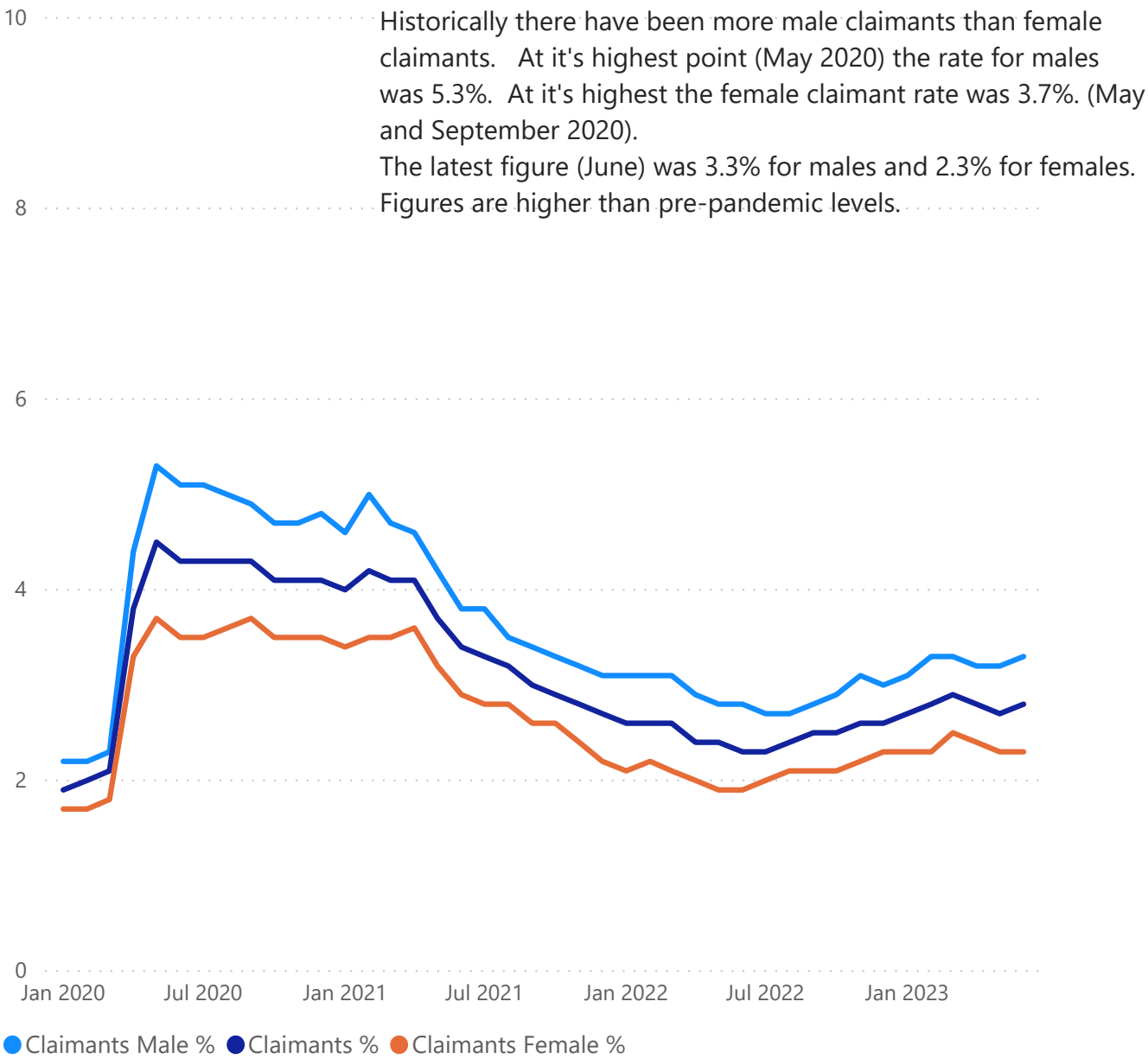

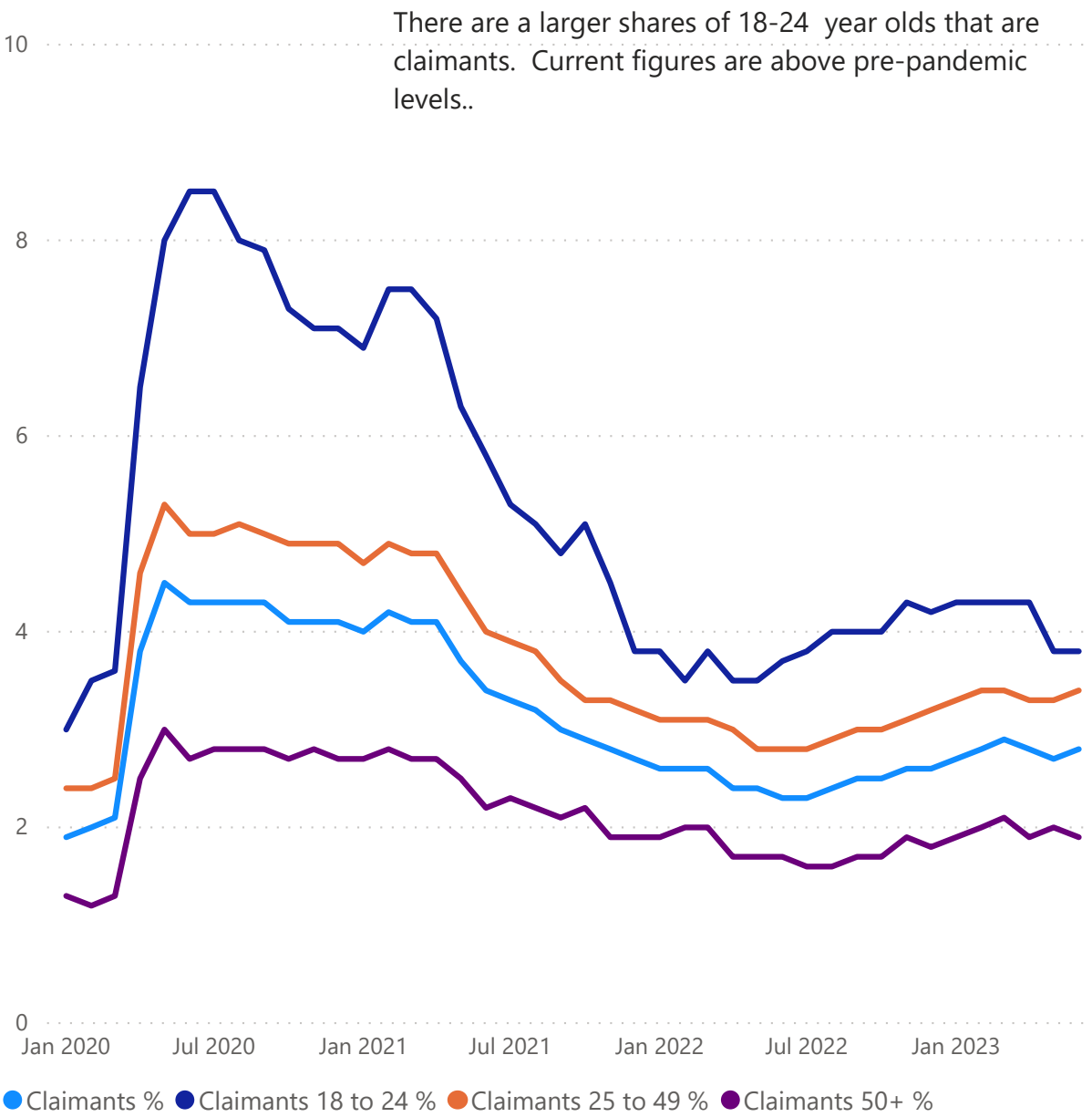

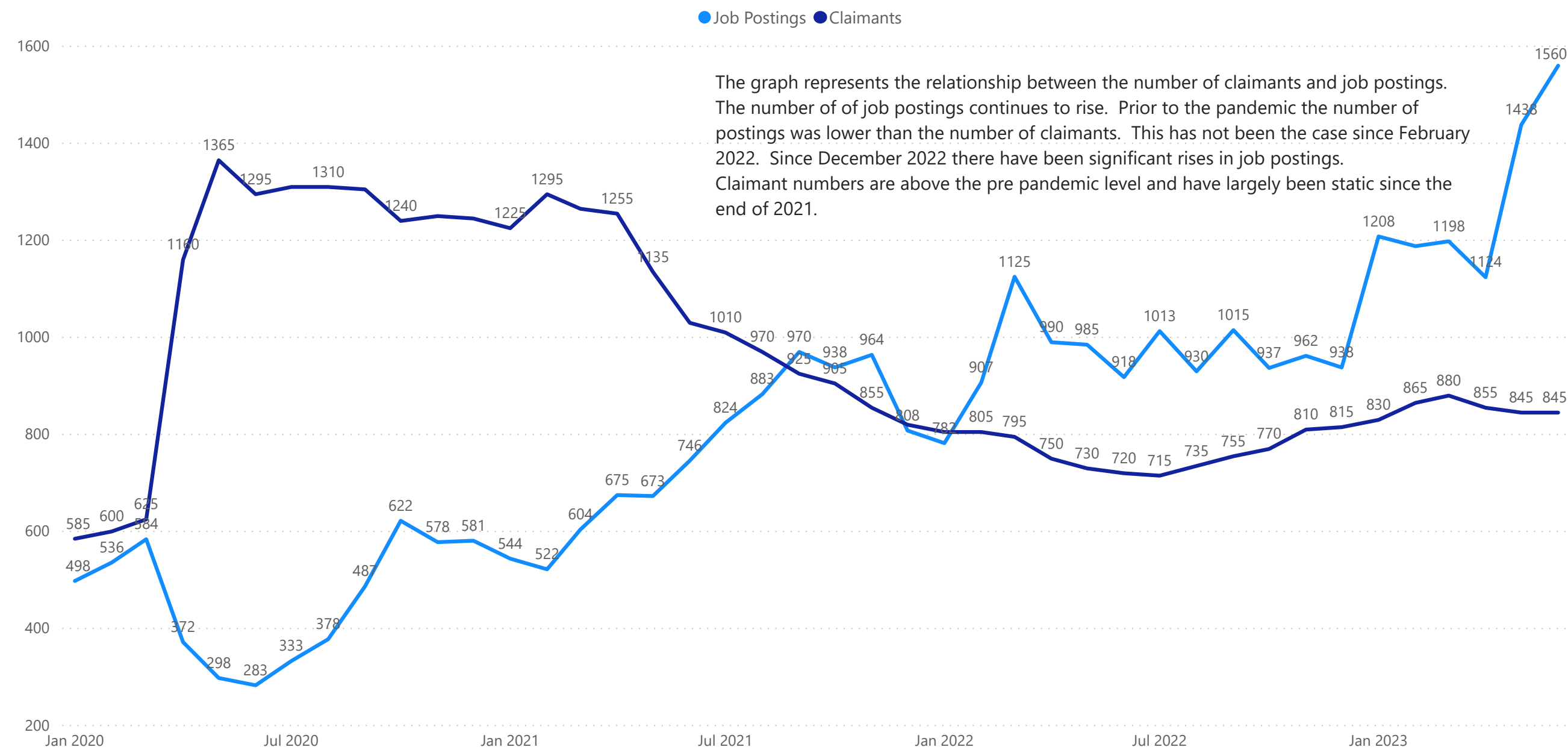
Claimant Rate Comparator by Sex



Claimant Rate Comparator by Age



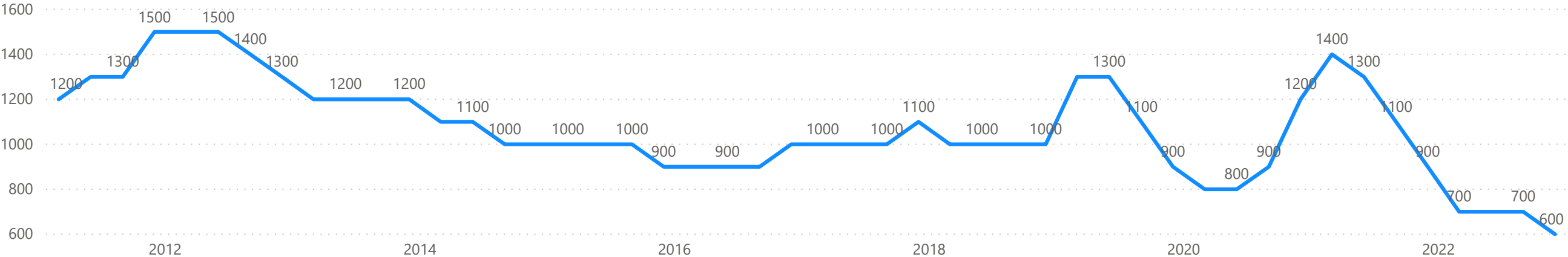

Unemployment

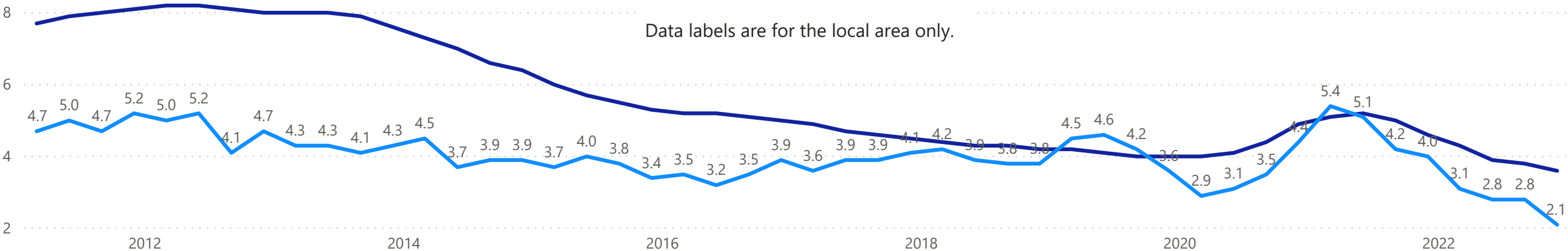
The graph demonstrates quarterly unemployment figures from 2011 to 2022. The latest figure is 600 (2.1%) (reporting quarter January 2022 to December 2022). Over the last year (from January 2021 to December 2021) unemployment has fallen from 4%. At a national level over the last year unemployment has fallen from 4.6% to 3.6%. Melton's unemployment rate is 1.5 percentage points lower than the national rate.

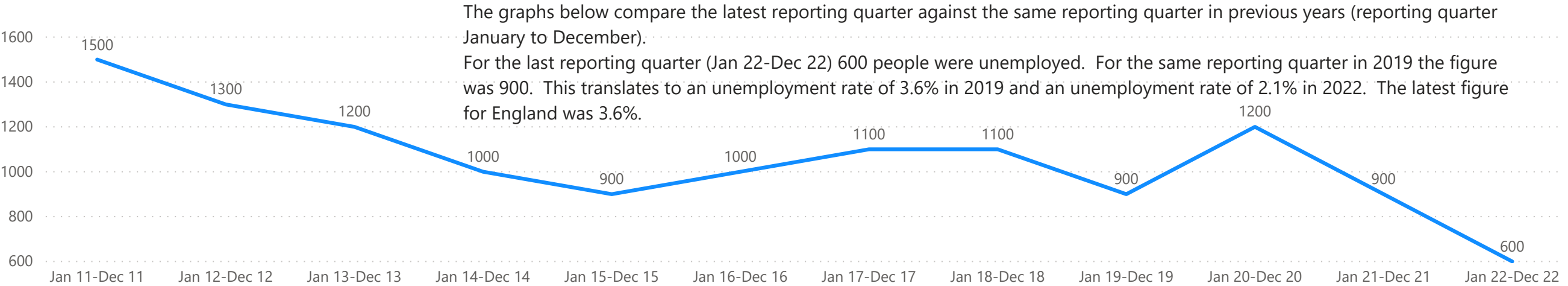

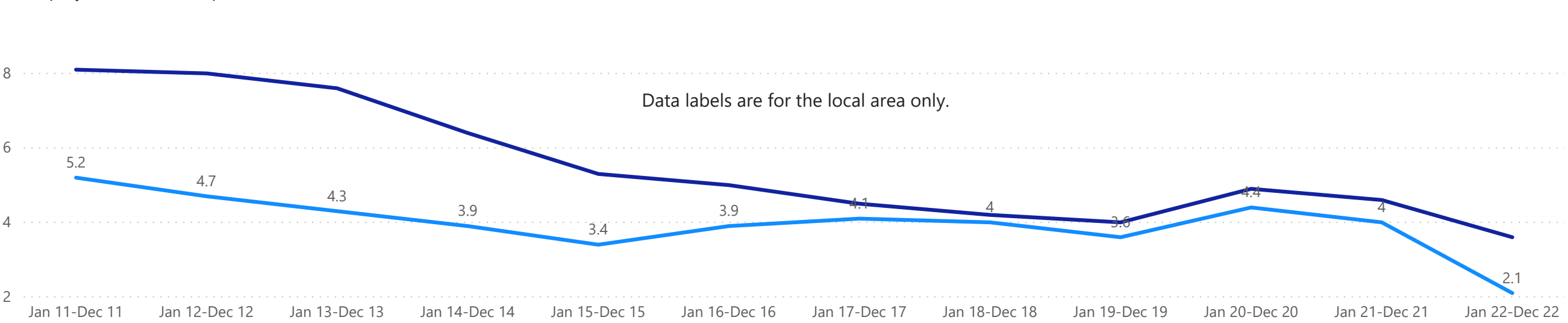
Unemployment (Reporting Quarter Jan to Dec)

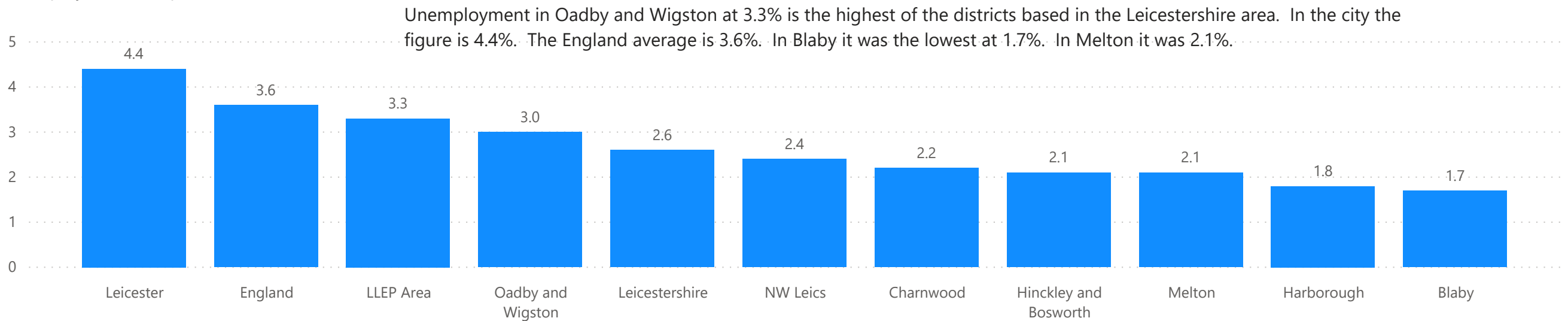
Unemployment Rate Comparator



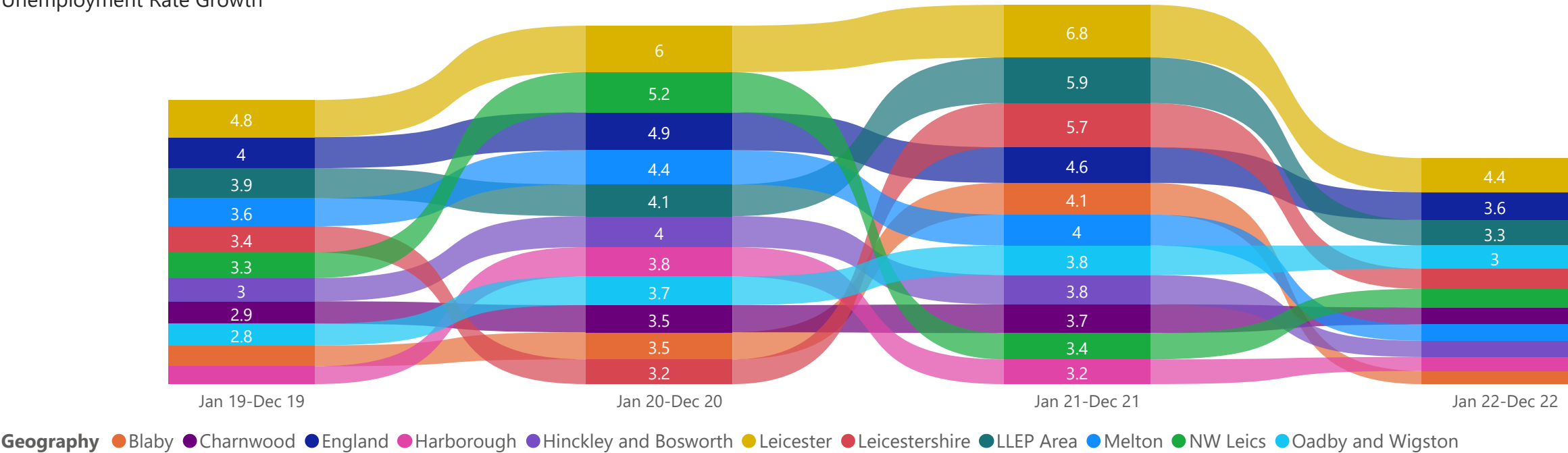

Unemployment Rate Growth



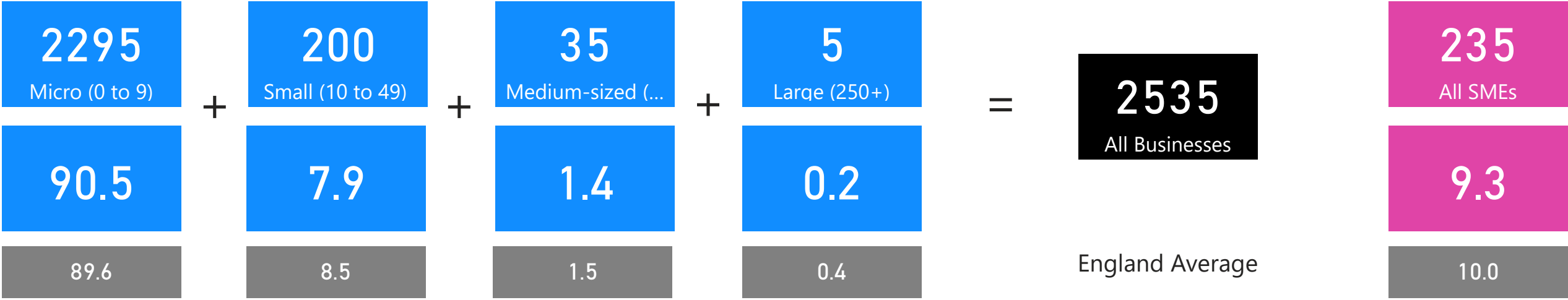
Business Size

In 2022 there were 2,535 businesses. The majority of businesses in the area (90.5% or 2,295) were micro businesses (less than 10 staff). This is above the average (89.6%).

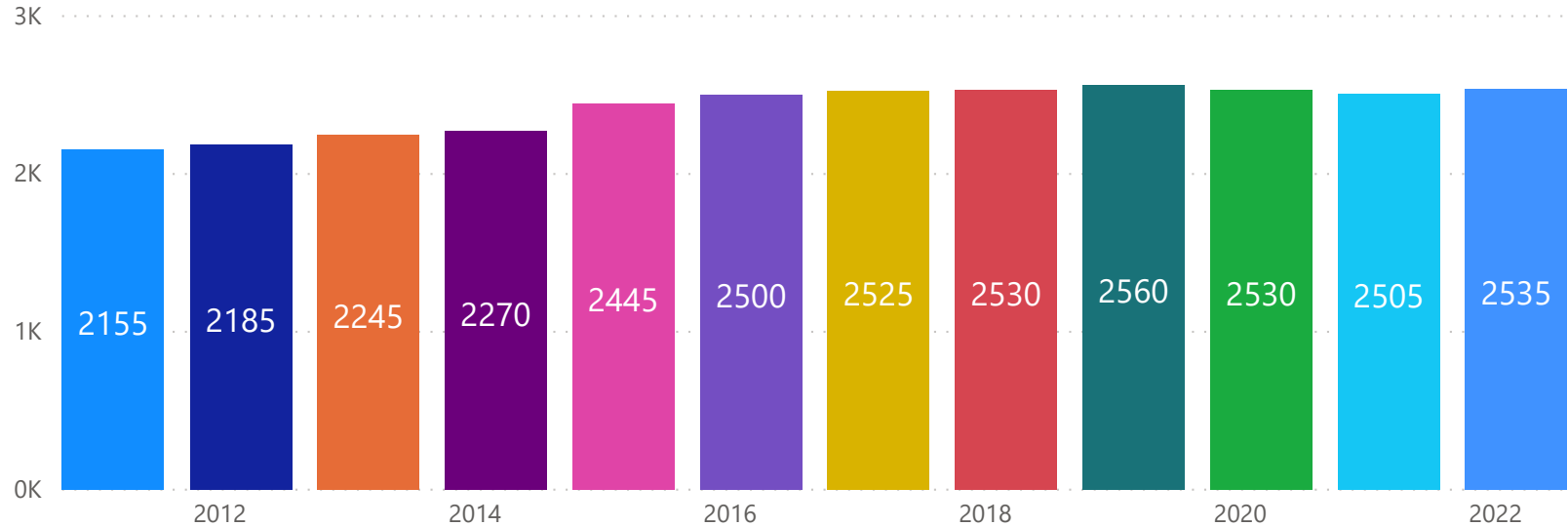
There were 200 (7.9%) small businesses, 35 (1.4%) medium and 5 (0.2%) large businesses.

Combined small and medium sized (not micro) make up 235 (9.3%) businesses. The average is 10%.

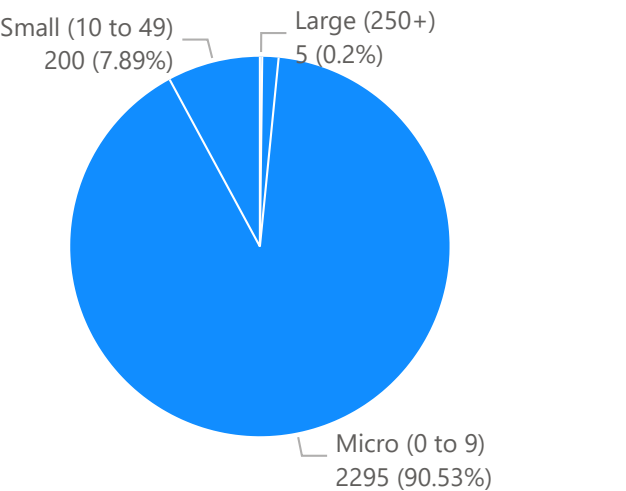
Business Size and Share



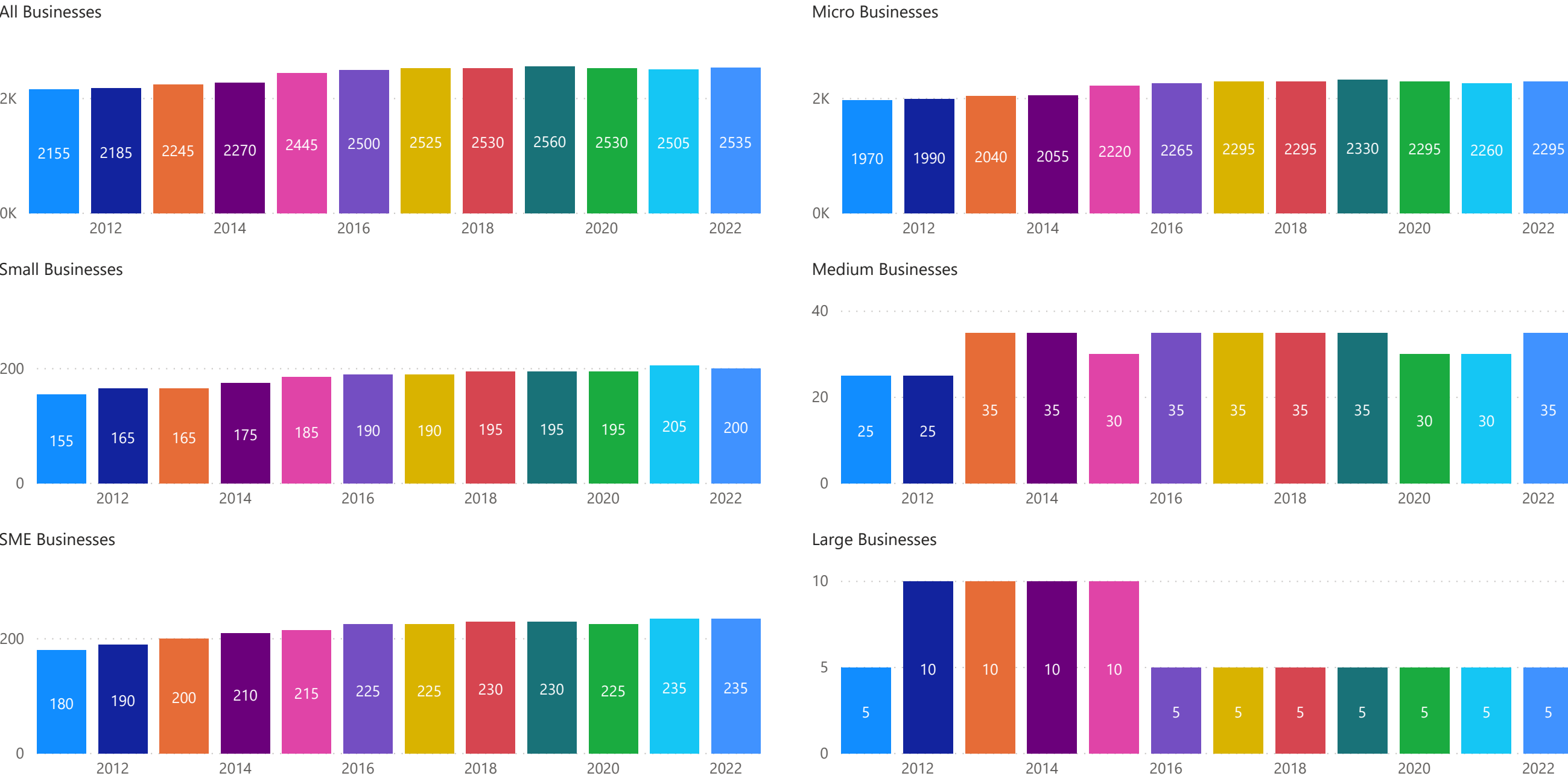
Business Numbers Time Series



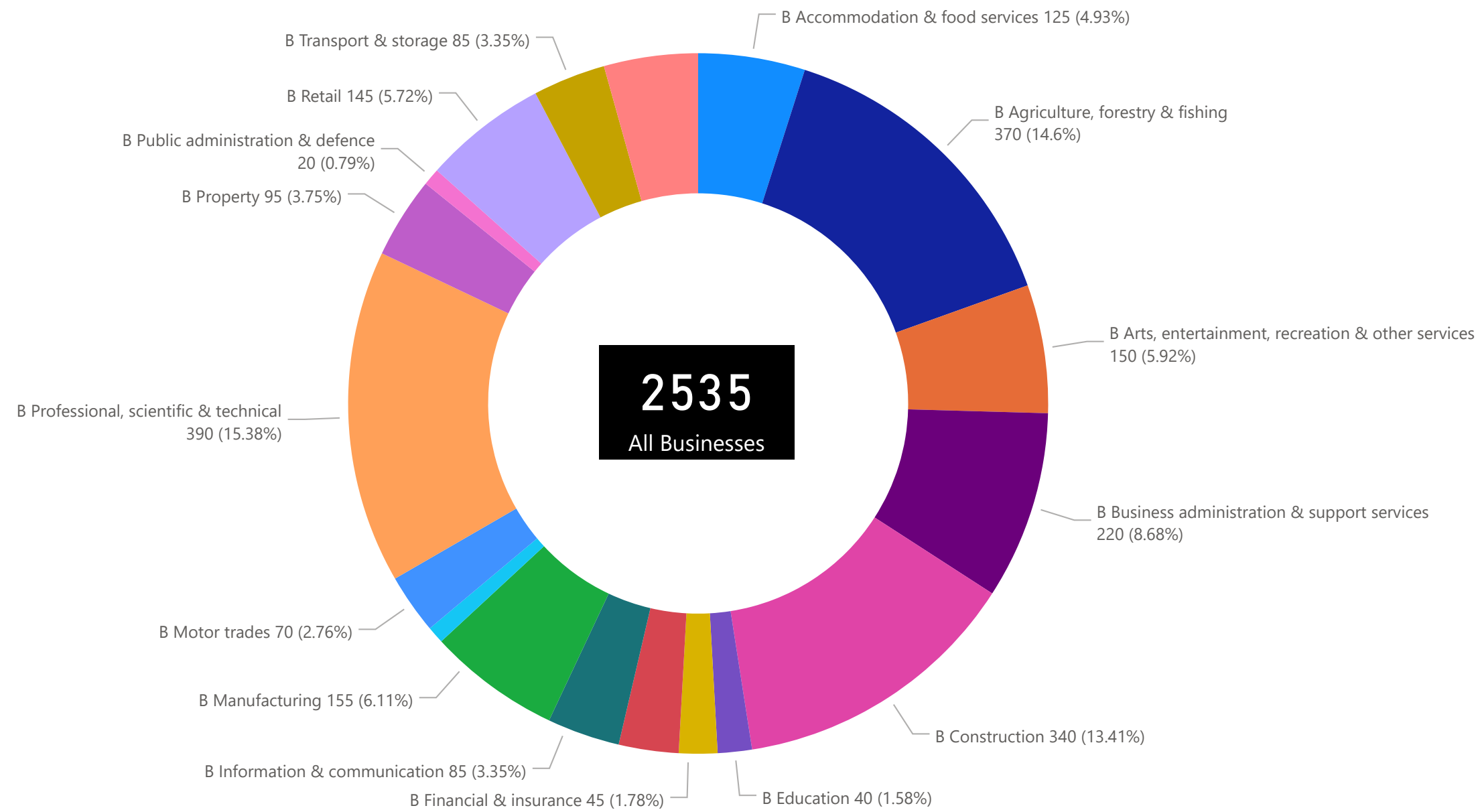
Business Size and Share



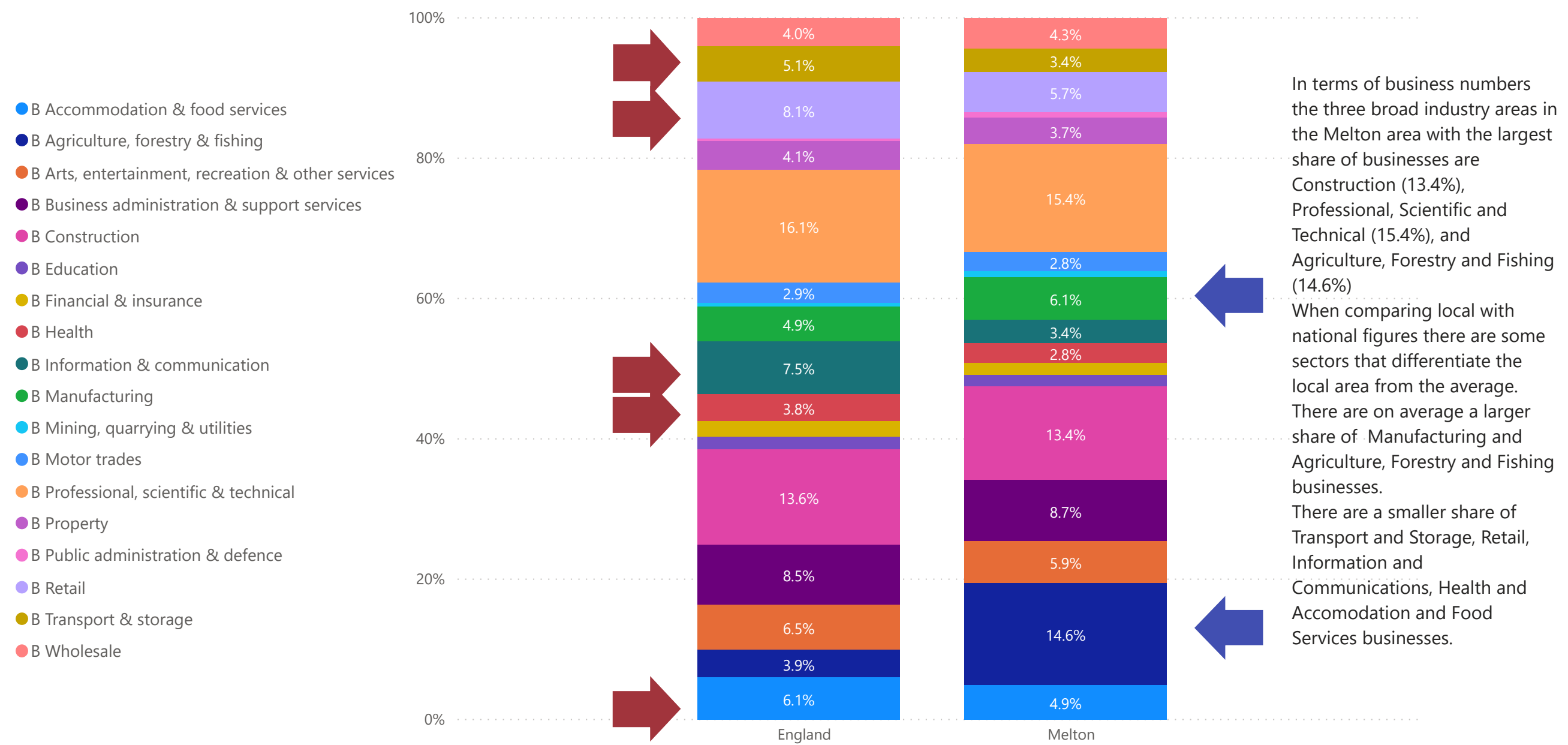
Business Size Time Series (2011 to 2022)



Business Structure 2022

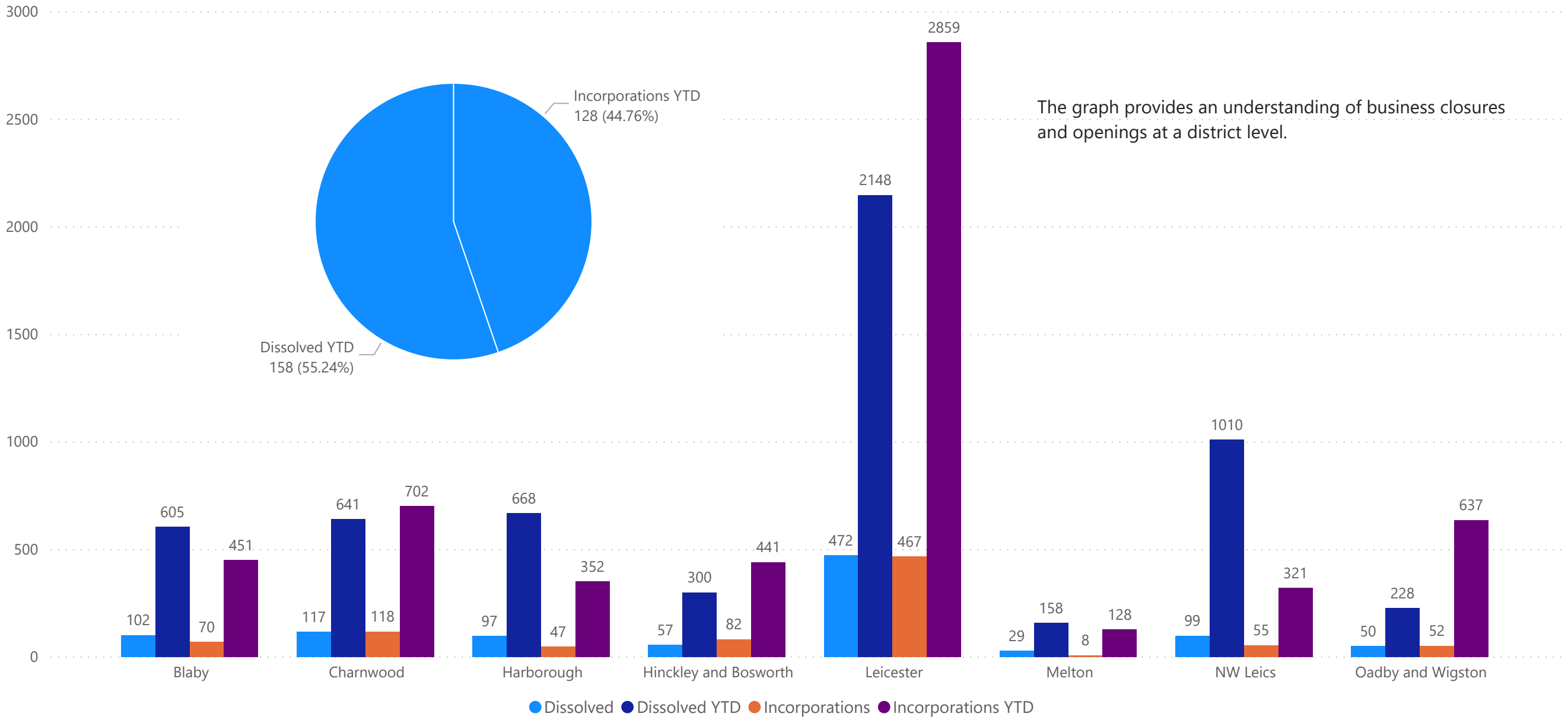


Business Sector Share 2022 Comparator

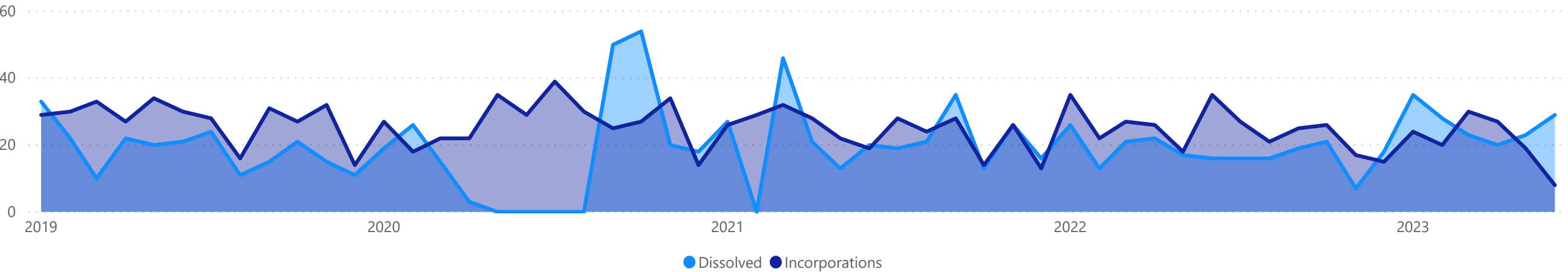
Dissolved and Incorporated Businesses Monthly and YTD



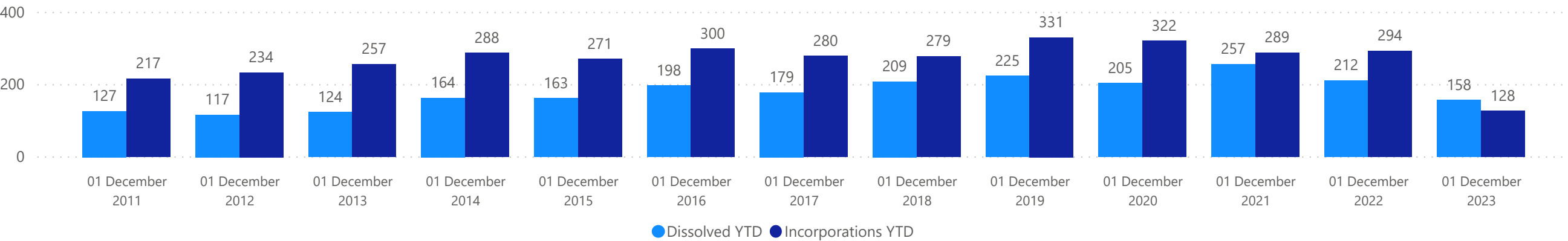
Dissolved & Incorporated Businesses

Traditionally and as demonstrated in the graphs below, the number of business incorporations has been larger than business closures. There are a few exceptions to this. Twenty twenty one saw the largest number of dissolved businesses but this was still fewer than incorporations. Year to date figures in 2023 demonstrate for the first time larger numbers of dissolved businesses than incorporated businesses.

Dissolved and Incorporated Monthly Businesses

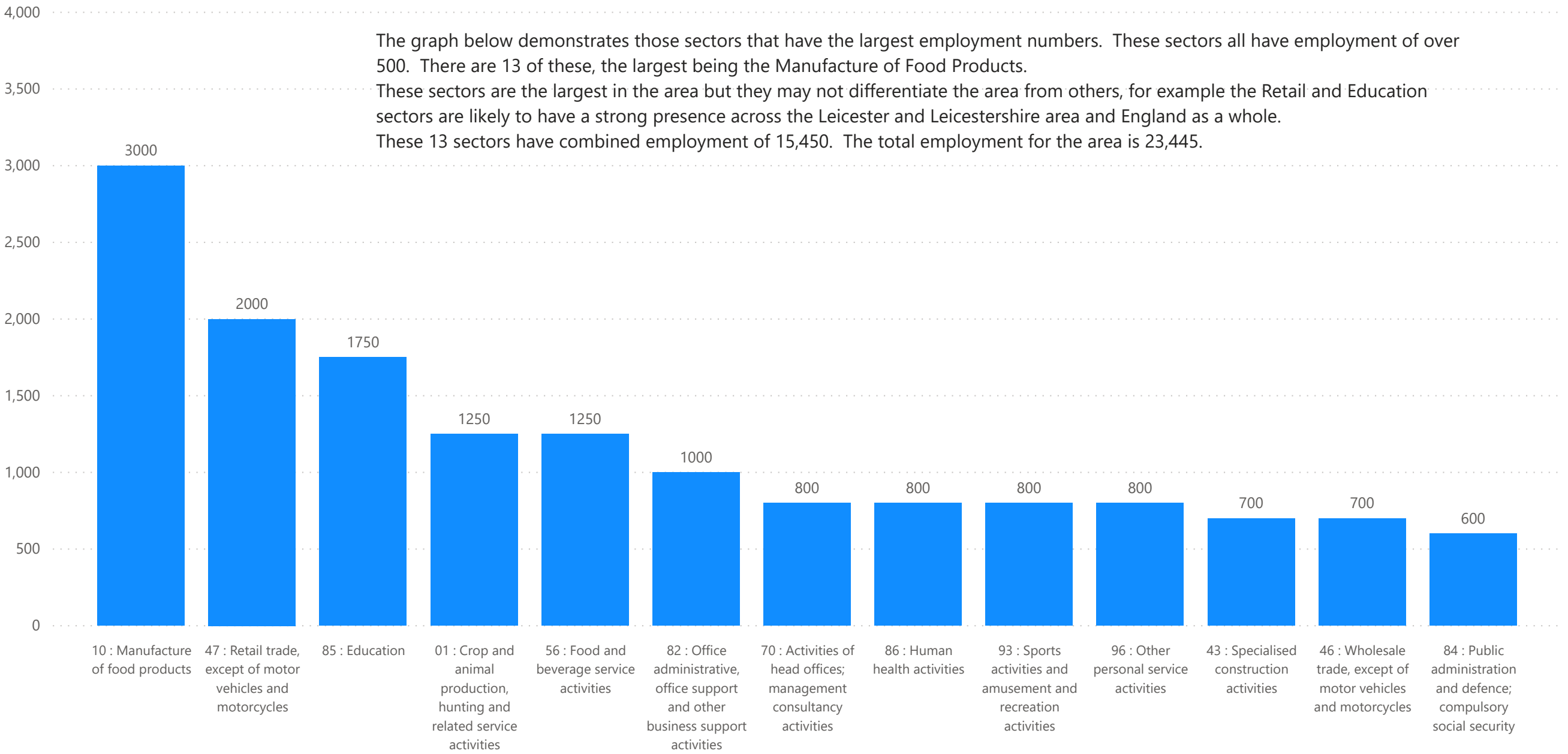


Dissolved and Incorporated Businesses Year to Date



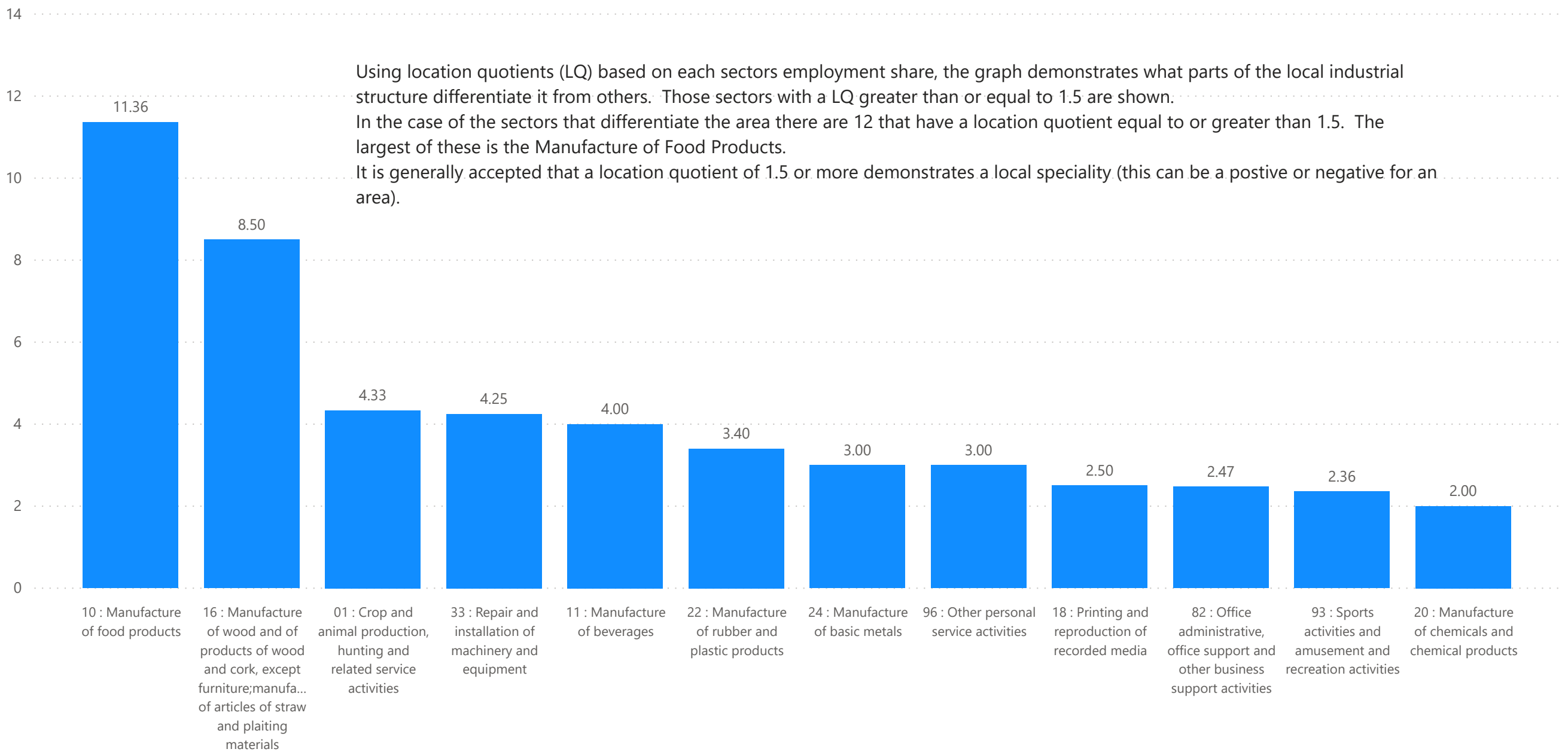

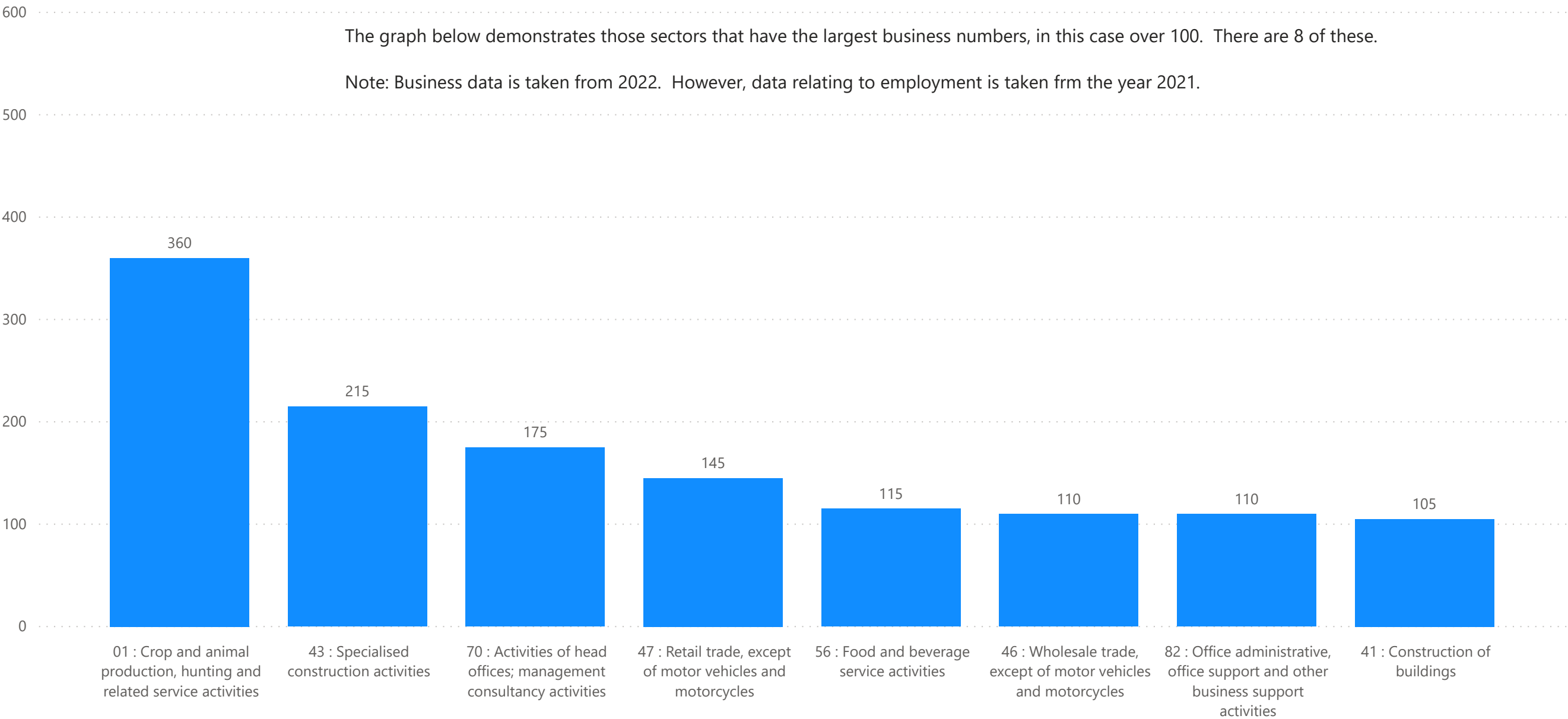

Resident Earnings

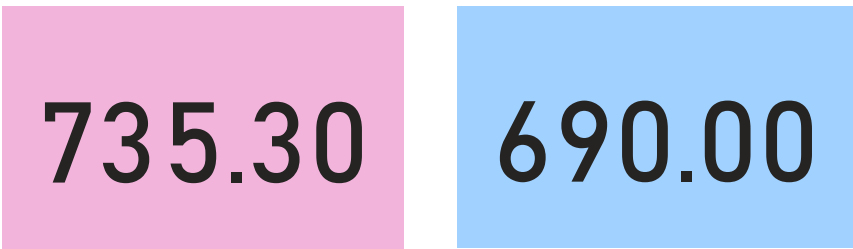
Median resident earnings in the Melton area are £641.80. This is below the average of £645.80. Male resident earnings in the area are £735.30, this is higher than average (£690). Male resident earnings are higher than female resident earnings (£483.50). Female resident earnings are lower than the national average (£584.50).



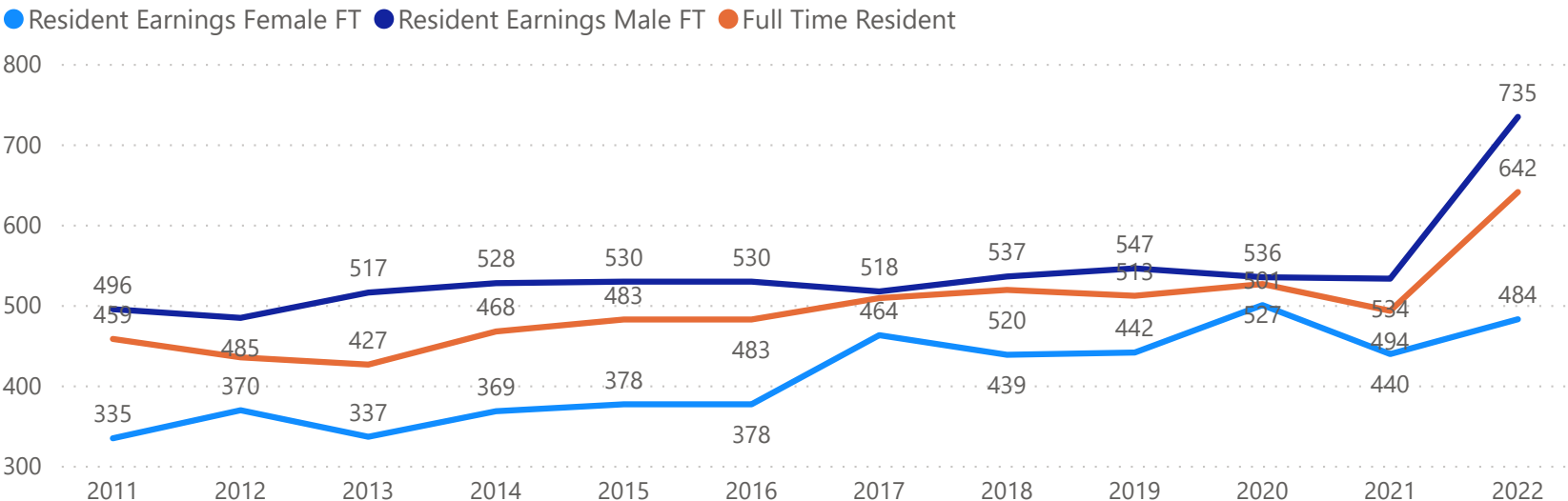

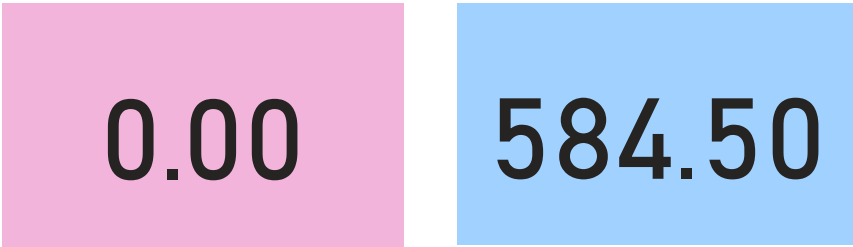
Workplace Earnings

Median workplace earnings in the Melton area are £602.60 (resident earnings £641.80). This is below the average of £645.60. Male workplace earnings in the area are £637.90 (resident earnings £735.30), again this is lower than average (£689.90).

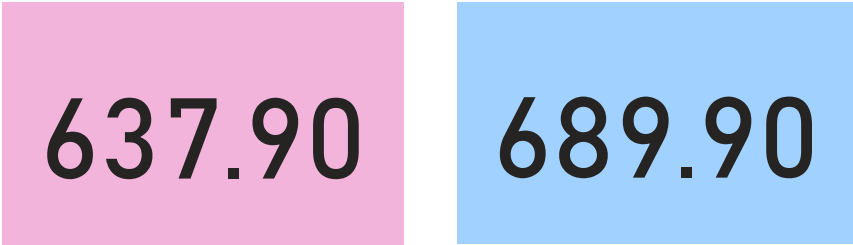

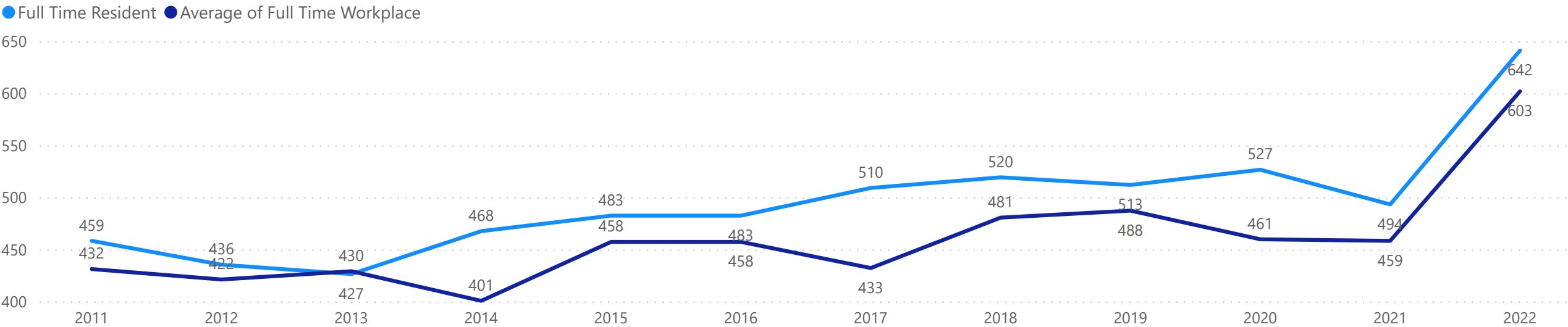
Geographic Resident and Workplace Earnings

The graph below demonstrates resident and workplace earnings and compares these against other areas locally and also with the national average.



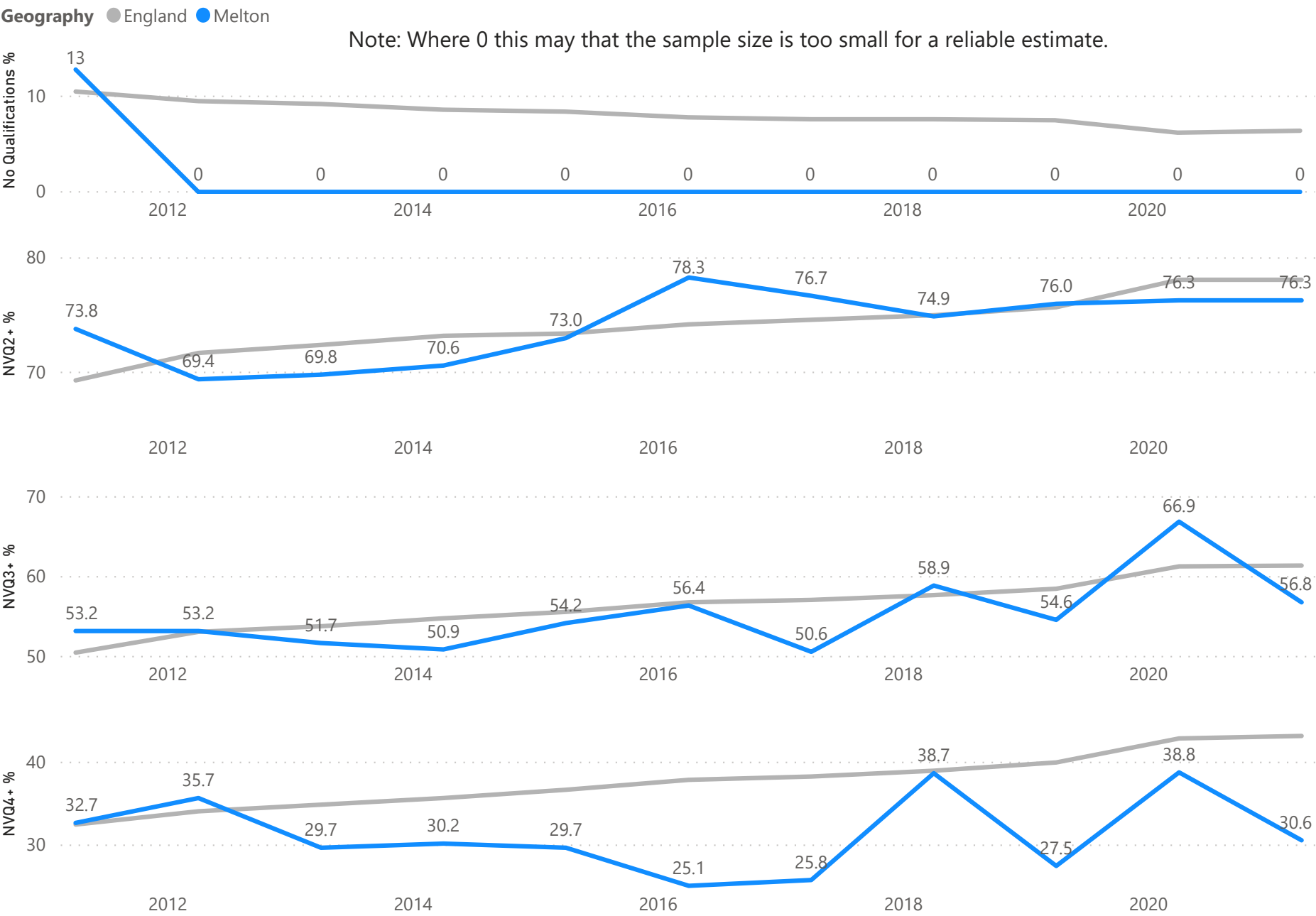
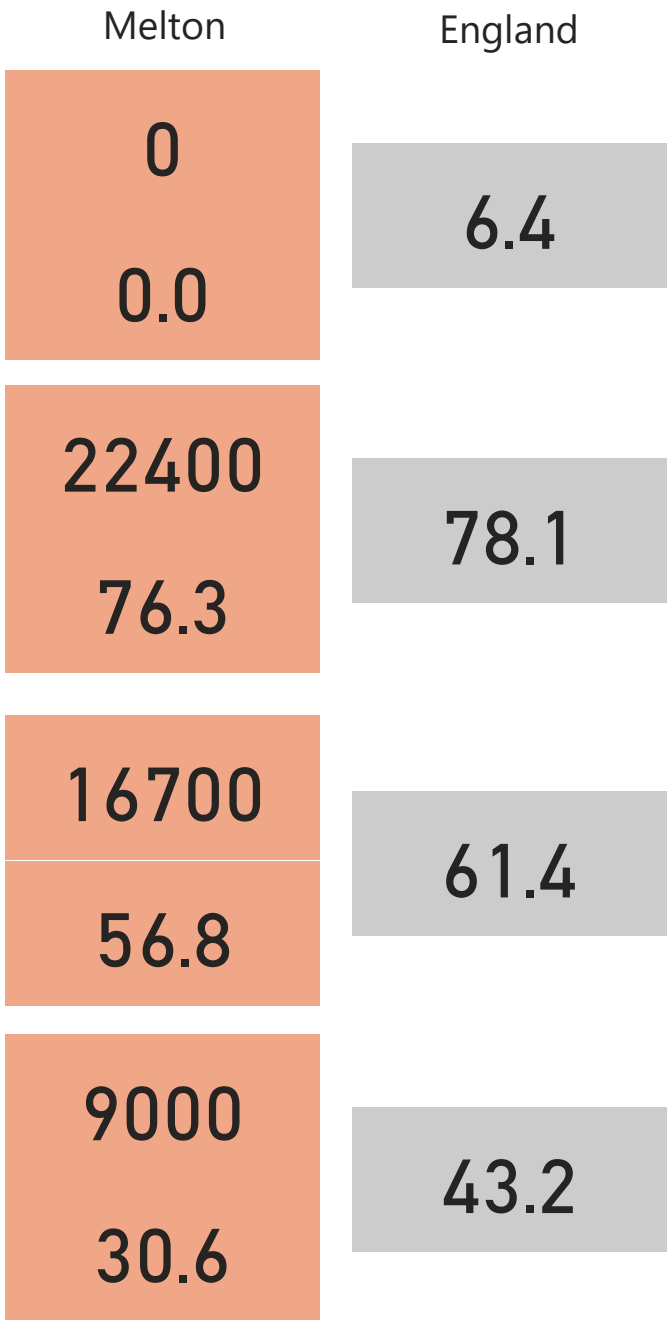
Resident and Workplace Earnings

The graph below demonstrates Melton resident and workplace earnings over the period 2011 to 2022.



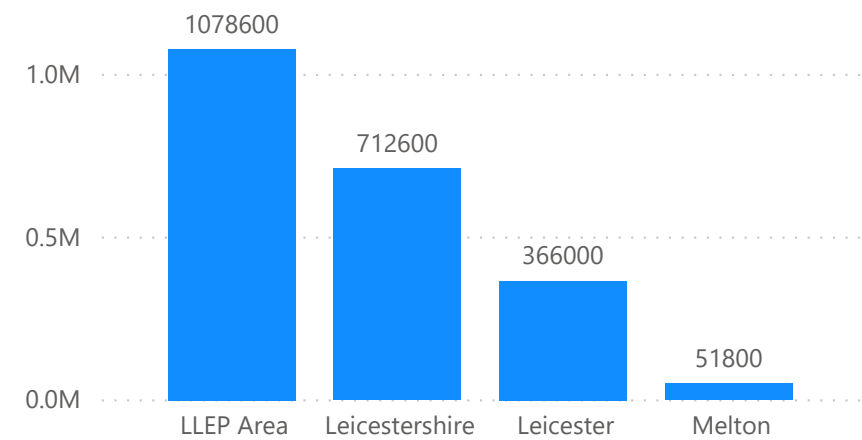
Qualifications

Thirty point six percent of the working age population have a level 4+ qualification. This is below the England average (43.2%). On average at all levels in Melton there are fewer people with qualifications.

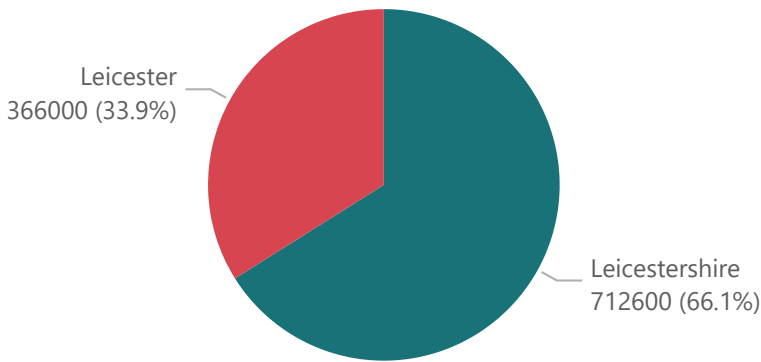

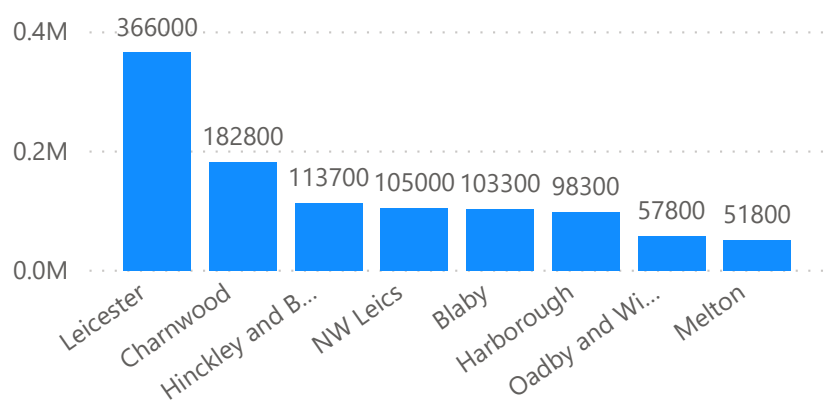

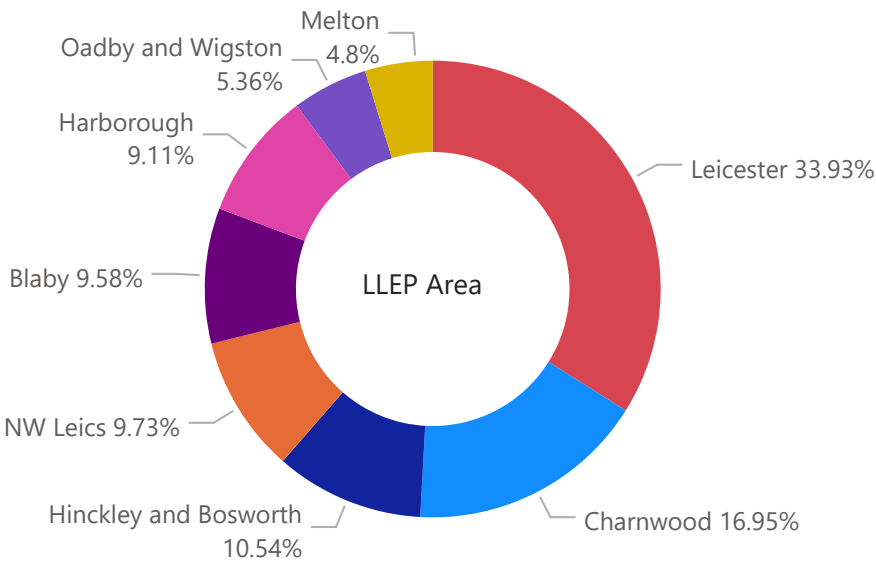
Population Share



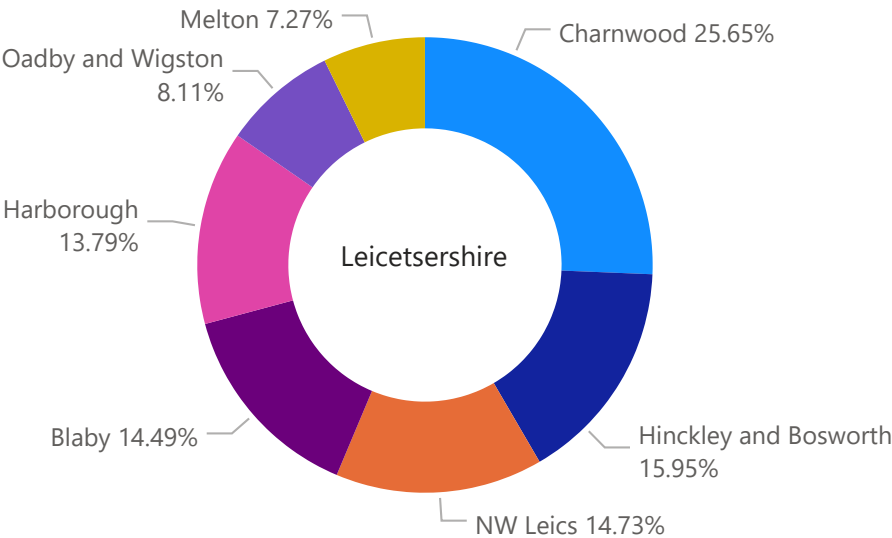
Population District Numbers



Population Share (LLEP Area)

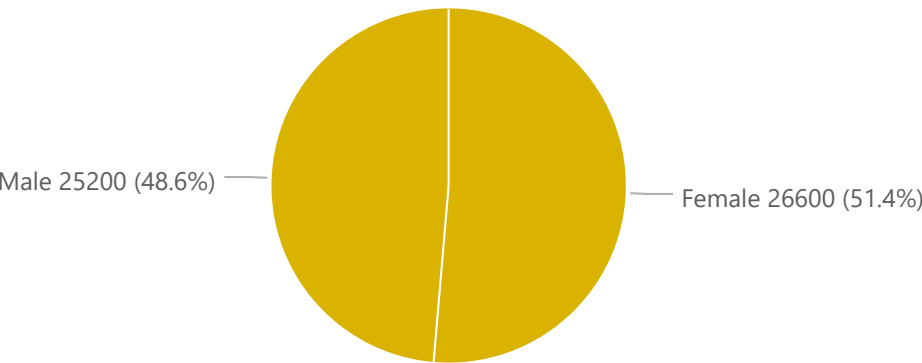


Population Share (Leicestershire)

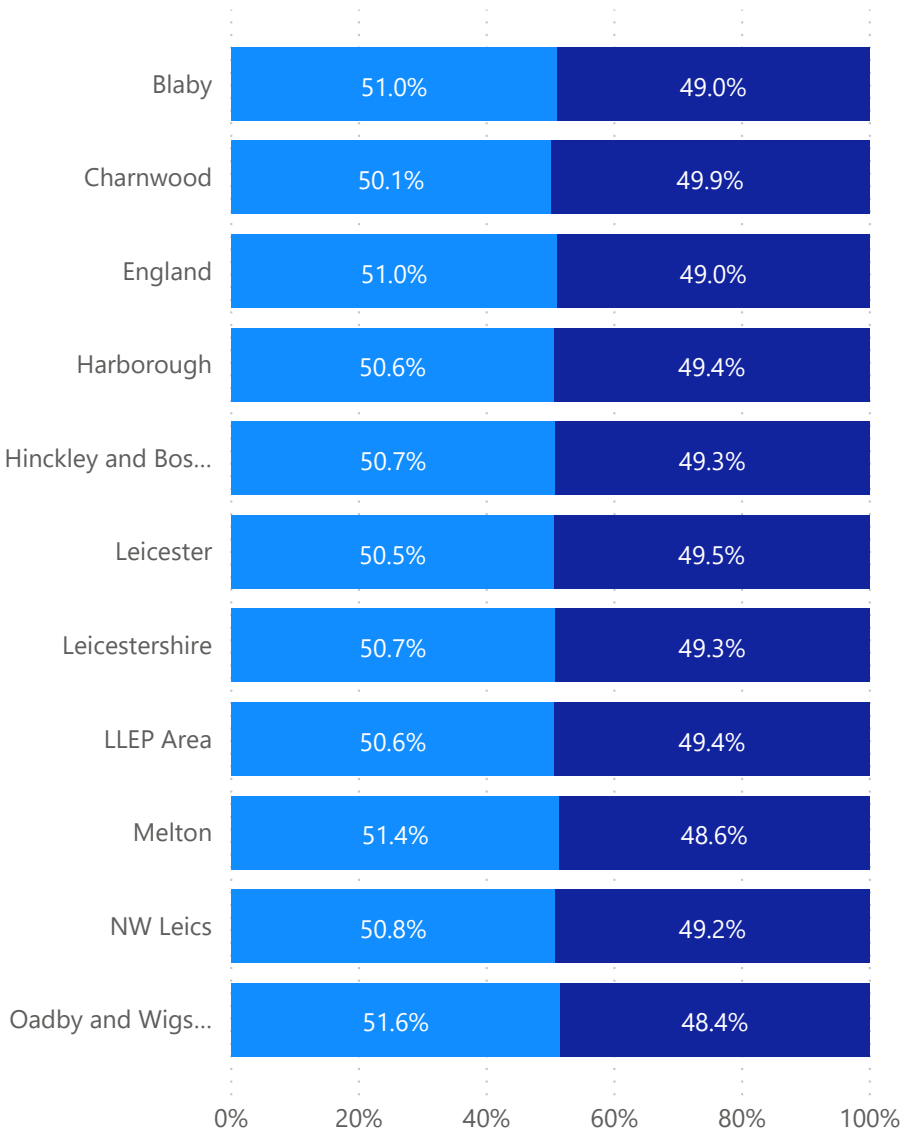

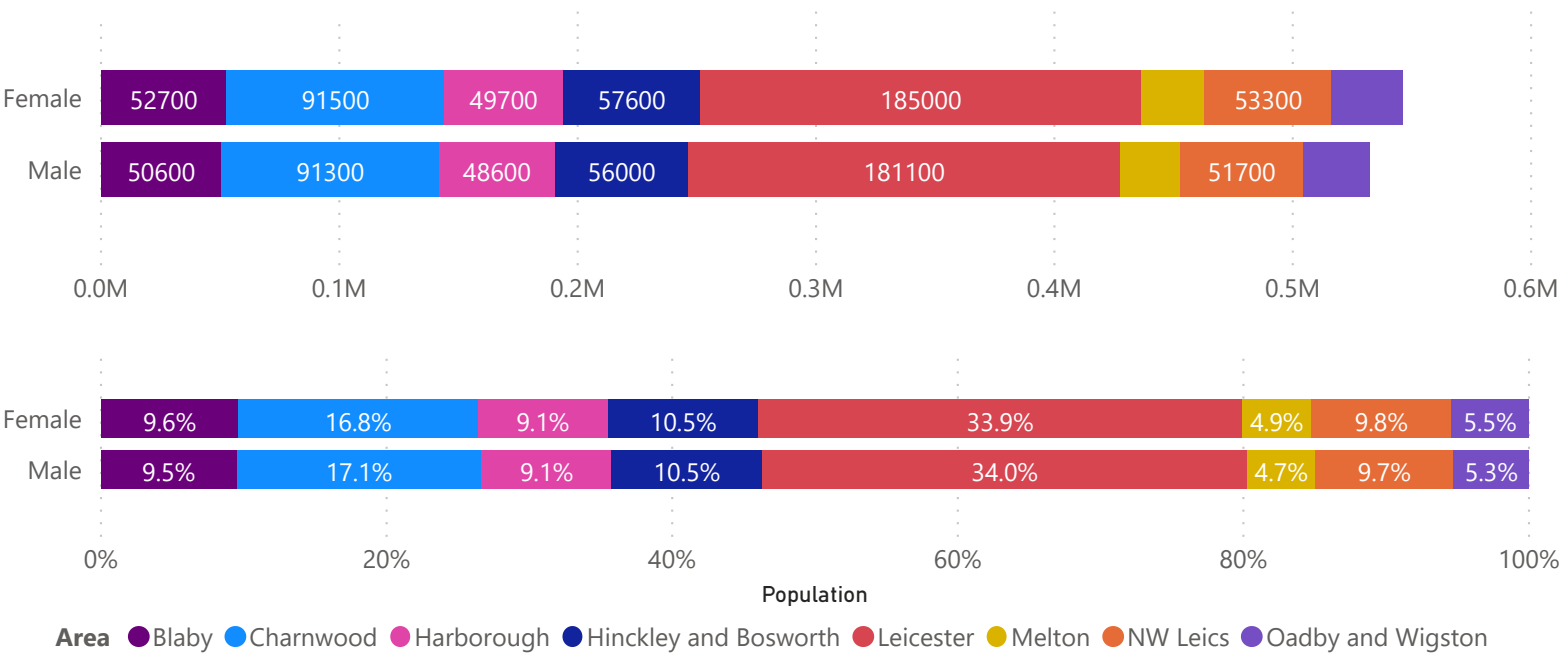
Population Share by Sex

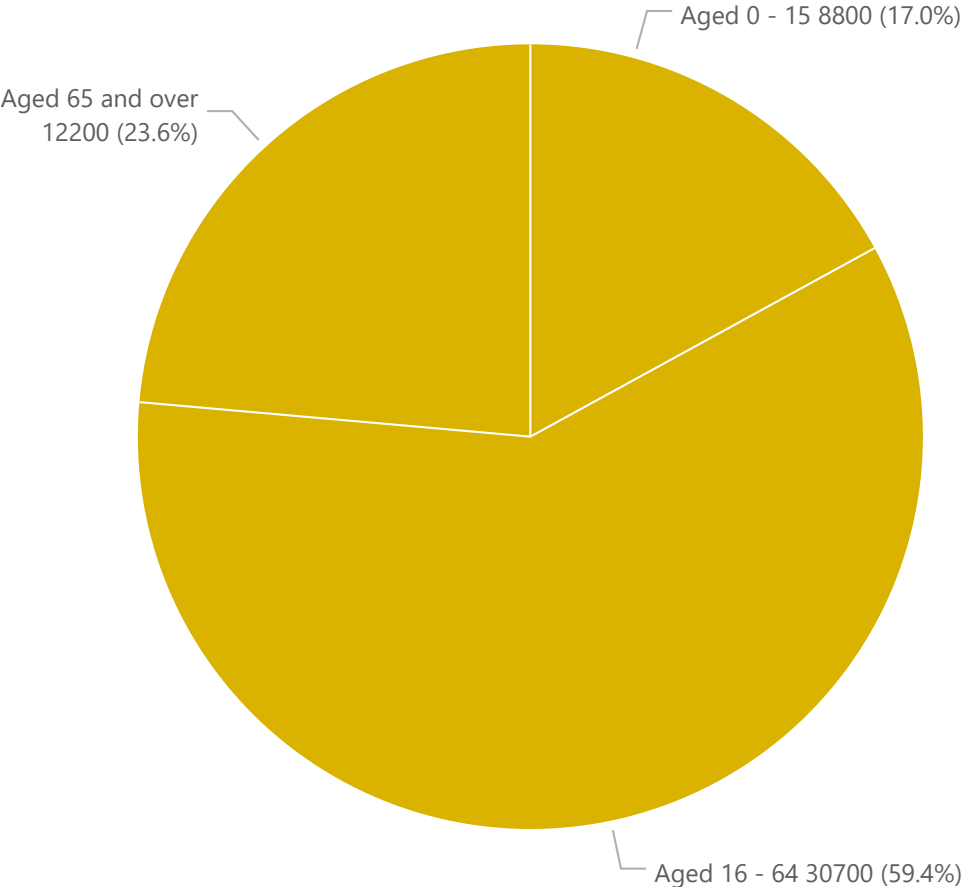
