Released at the 27/09/2023 the Office for National Statistics UK Business Counts contains two datasets, one containing counts based on the number of enterprises and the other on local units. This report uses the number of enterprises.

An enterprise can be thought of as the overall business, made up of individual sites or workplaces. A local unit is an individual site associated with an enterprise. As may be expected there are more local units than enterprises.

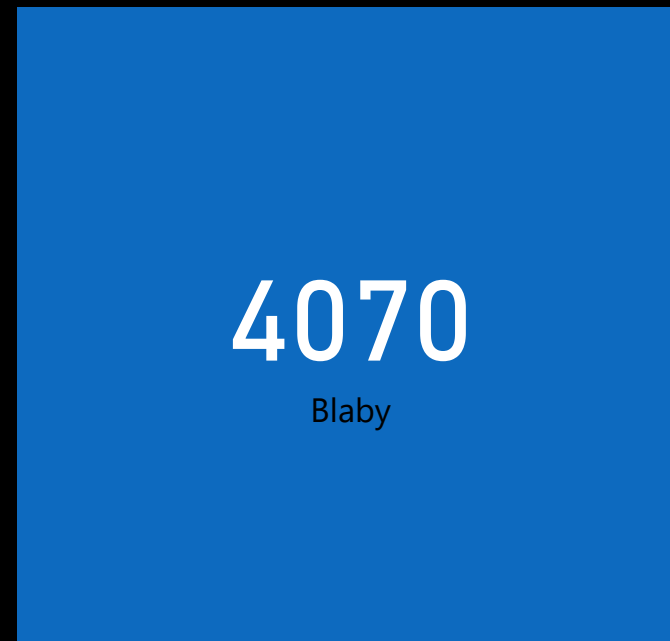
Data contained in the report covers the period 2015 to 2023 and is at a two digit level (Standard Industrial Code).

UK Business Counts are estimates that are available at a range of geographies. The geographies used in this and accompanying reports are at the LLEP, local and district authority areas. Comparator data is made available at a national level (England).

Estimated Business Population

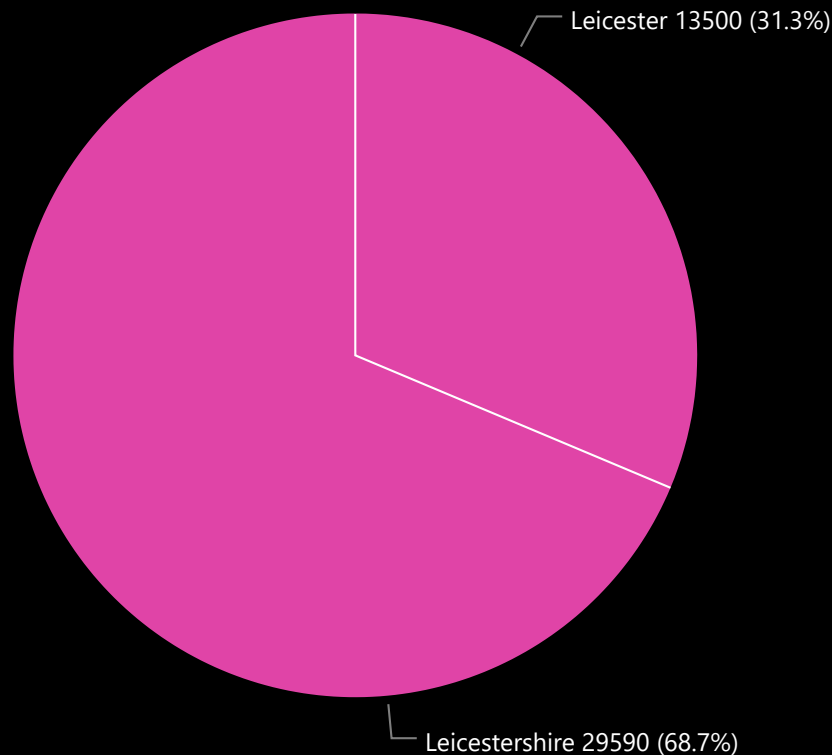
In the Leicester and Leicestershire area in 2023 it was estimated that there were 43,085 businesses.
In the Blaby area there were 4,070.



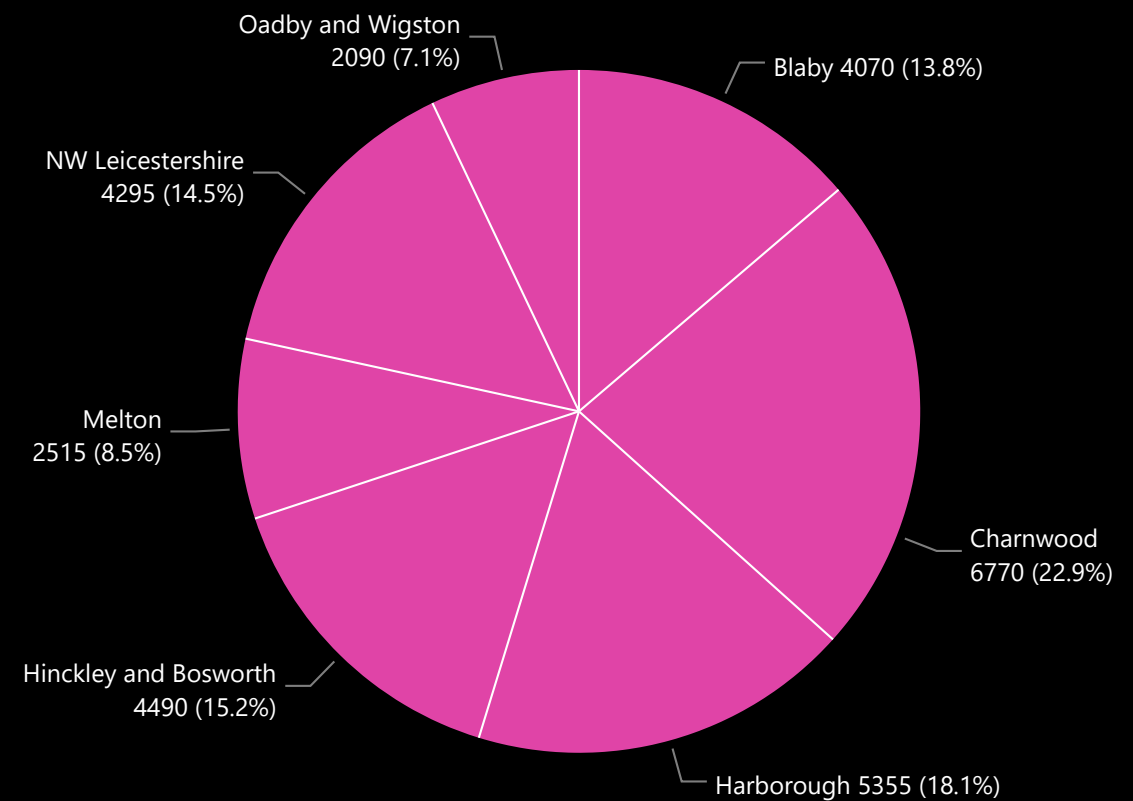
Local Authority and District Area Estimated Share of Business Population.

In 2023 over two thirds (68.7% or 29,590) of the estimated local business population of the Leicester and Leicestershire area were based in Leicestershire and the rest (31.3% or 13,500) in Leicester. The 4,070 enterprises in the Blaby area contribute to 13.8% of the enterprises in the Leicestershire area and 9.5% of those in the Leicester and Leicestershire area.

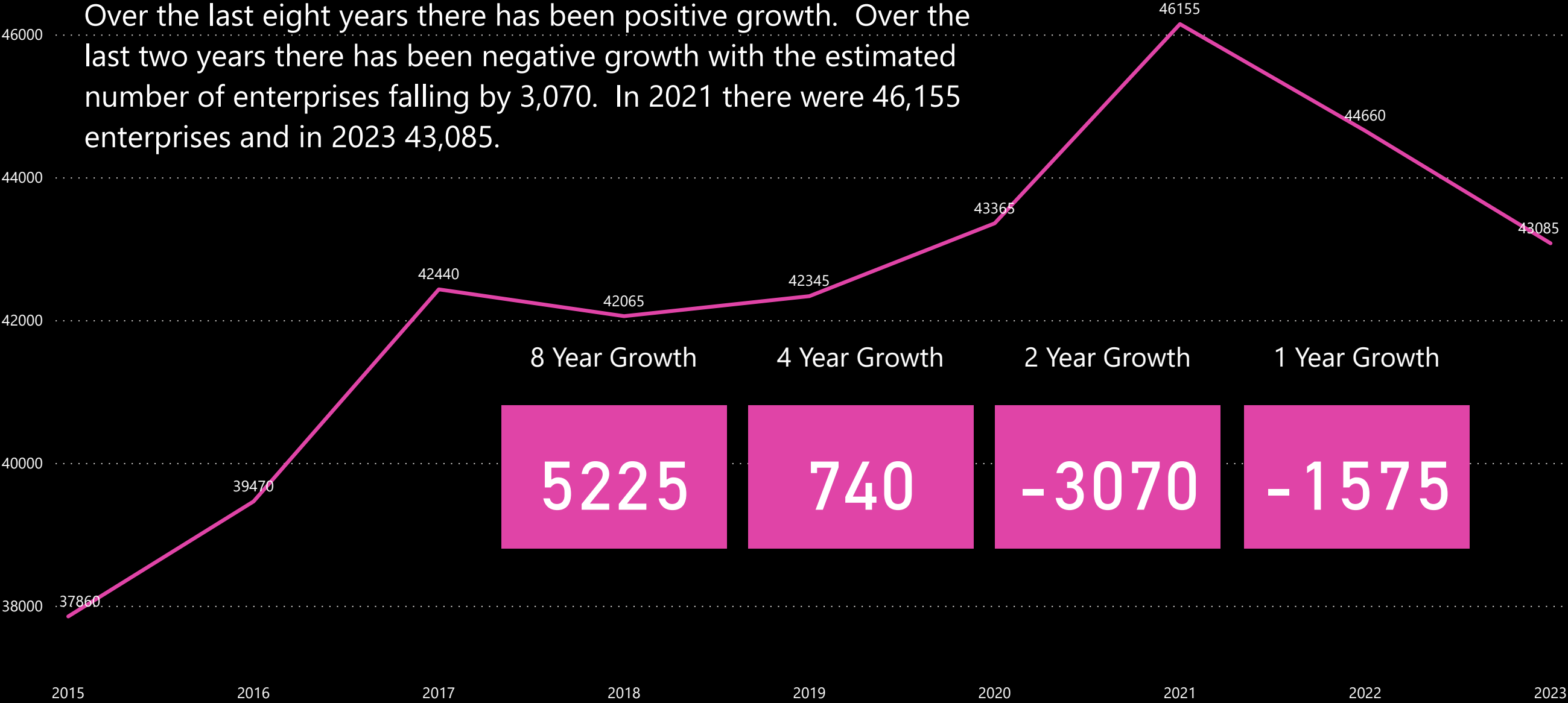

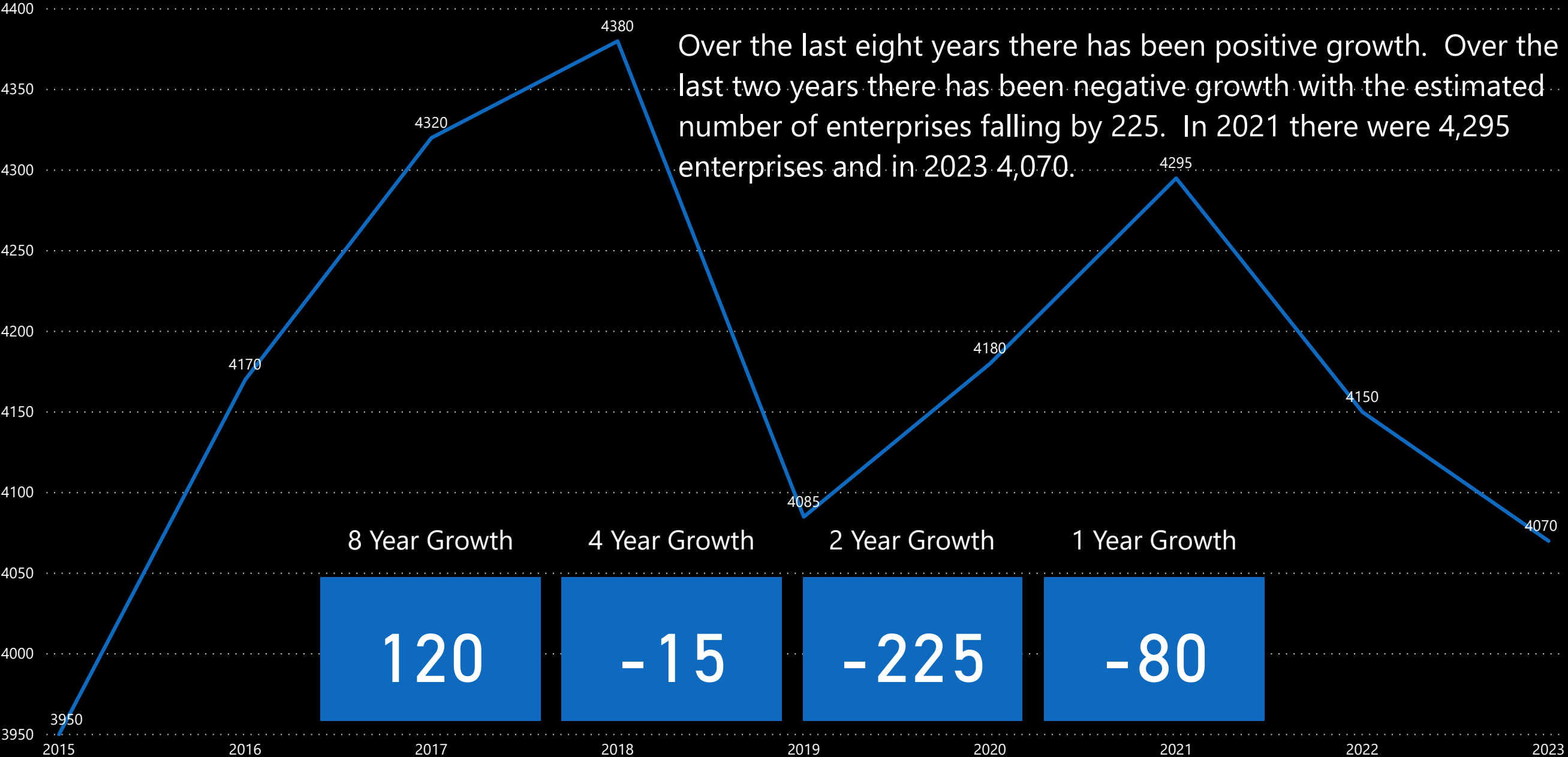


Estimated Business Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire Area 2015 to 2023

Over the last eight years there has been positive growth. Over the last two years there has been negative growth with the estimated number of enterprises falling by 3,070. In 2021 there were 46,155 enterprises and in 2023 43,085.

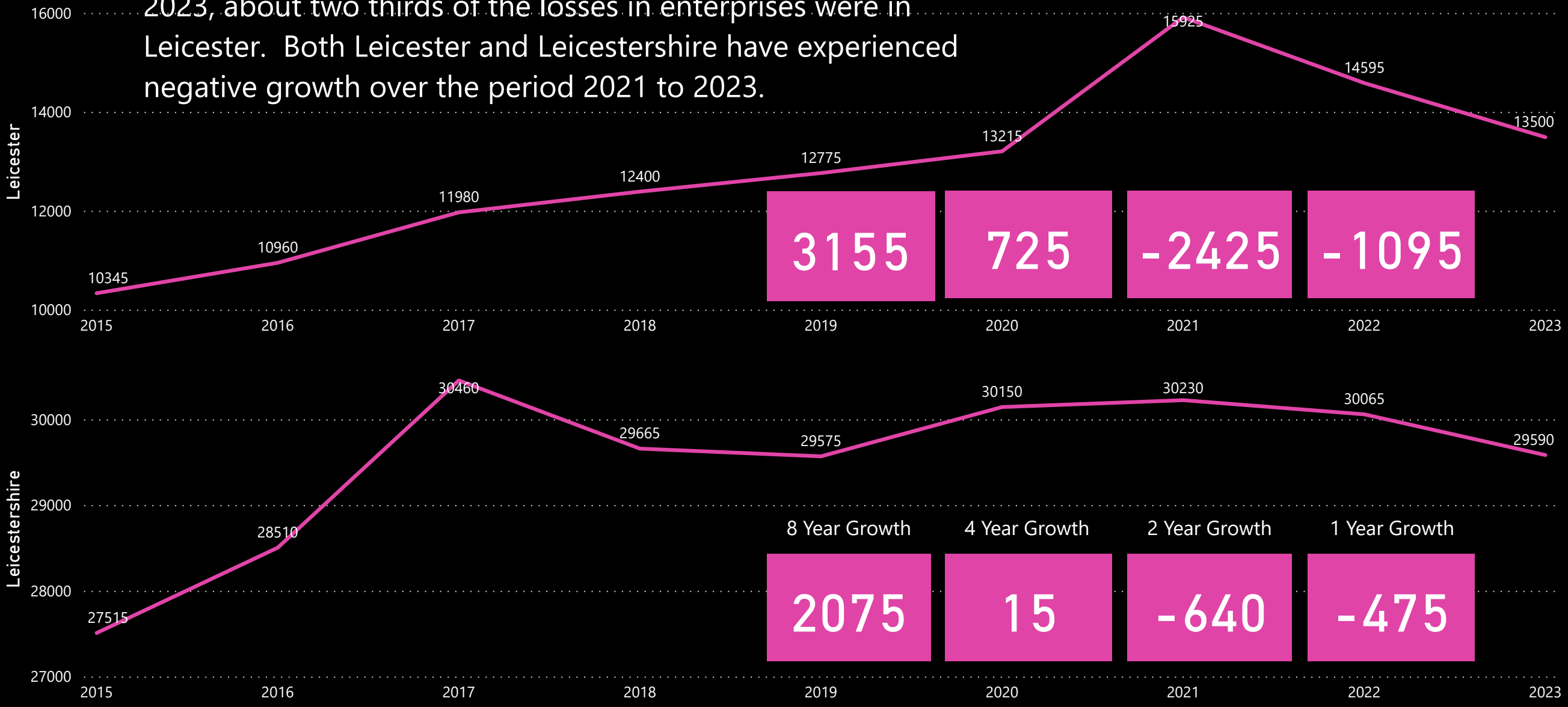


Estimated Business Growth in the Blaby Area 2015 to 2023



Estimated Business Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire Areas 2015 to 2023

Despite less than a third of enterprises being based in Leicester in 2023, about two thirds of the losses in enterprises were in Leicester. Both Leicester and Leicestershire have experienced negative growth over the period 2021 to 2023.

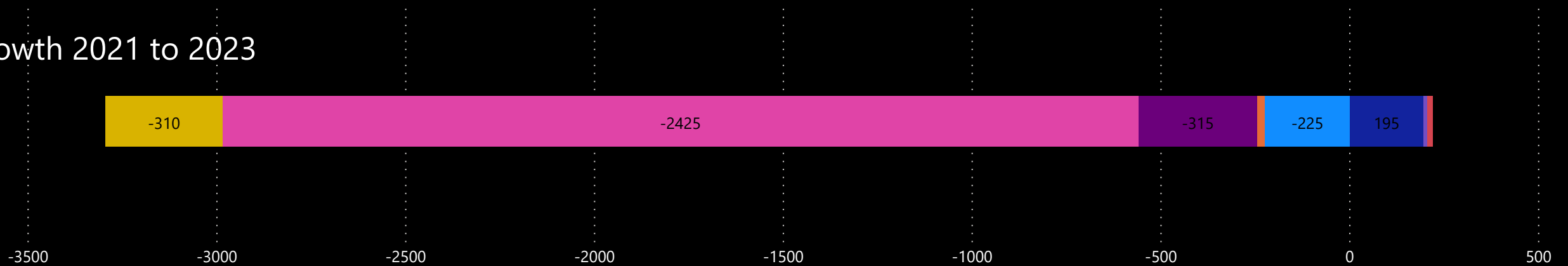


Estimated Business Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire and Blaby Areas 2021 to 2023 and 2022 to 2023

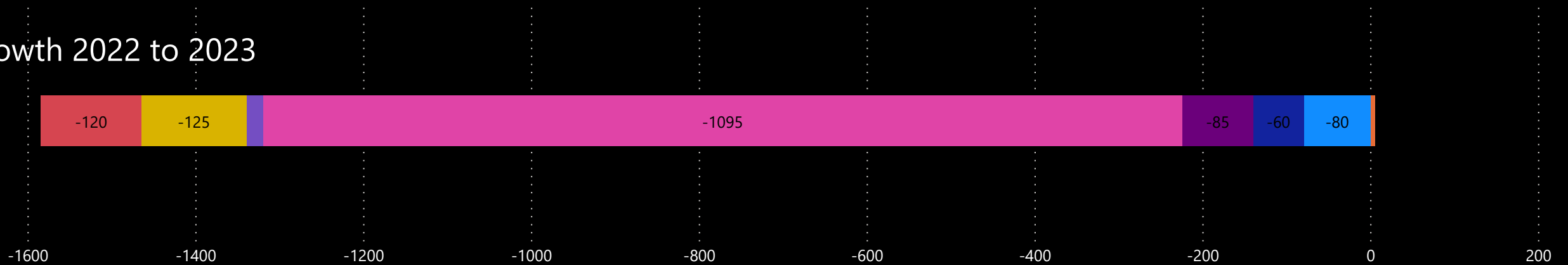

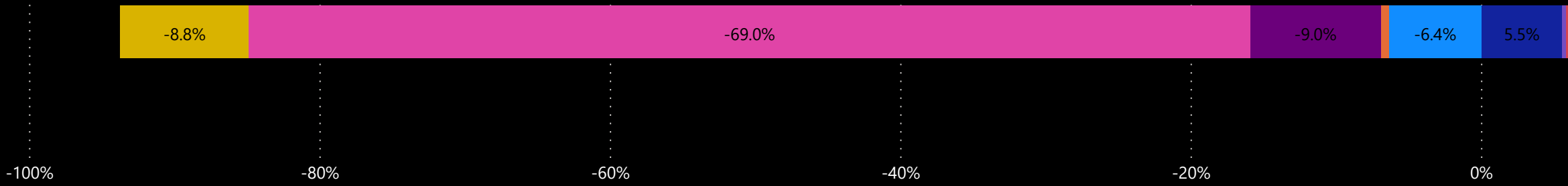


Estimated Share of Business Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire and Blaby Areas 2021 to 2023 and 2022 to 2023

The stacked bar charts below demonstrate share of business growth across the Leicester and Leicestershire and Blaby areas over the periods 2021 to 2023 and 2022 to 2023. Over the period 2022 to 2023 two thirds of the falls were in Leicester. Over the same period 5% were in Blaby.

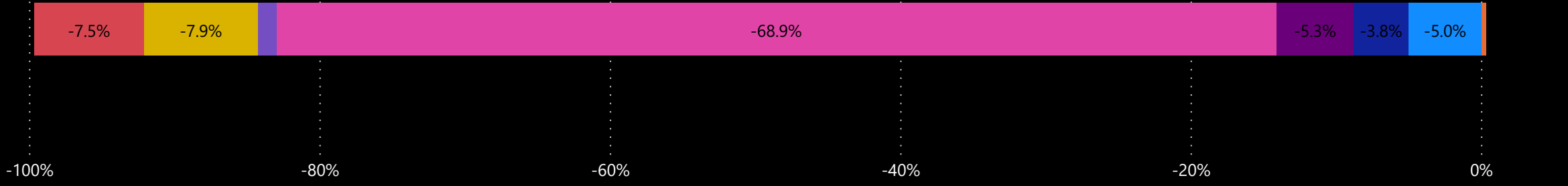

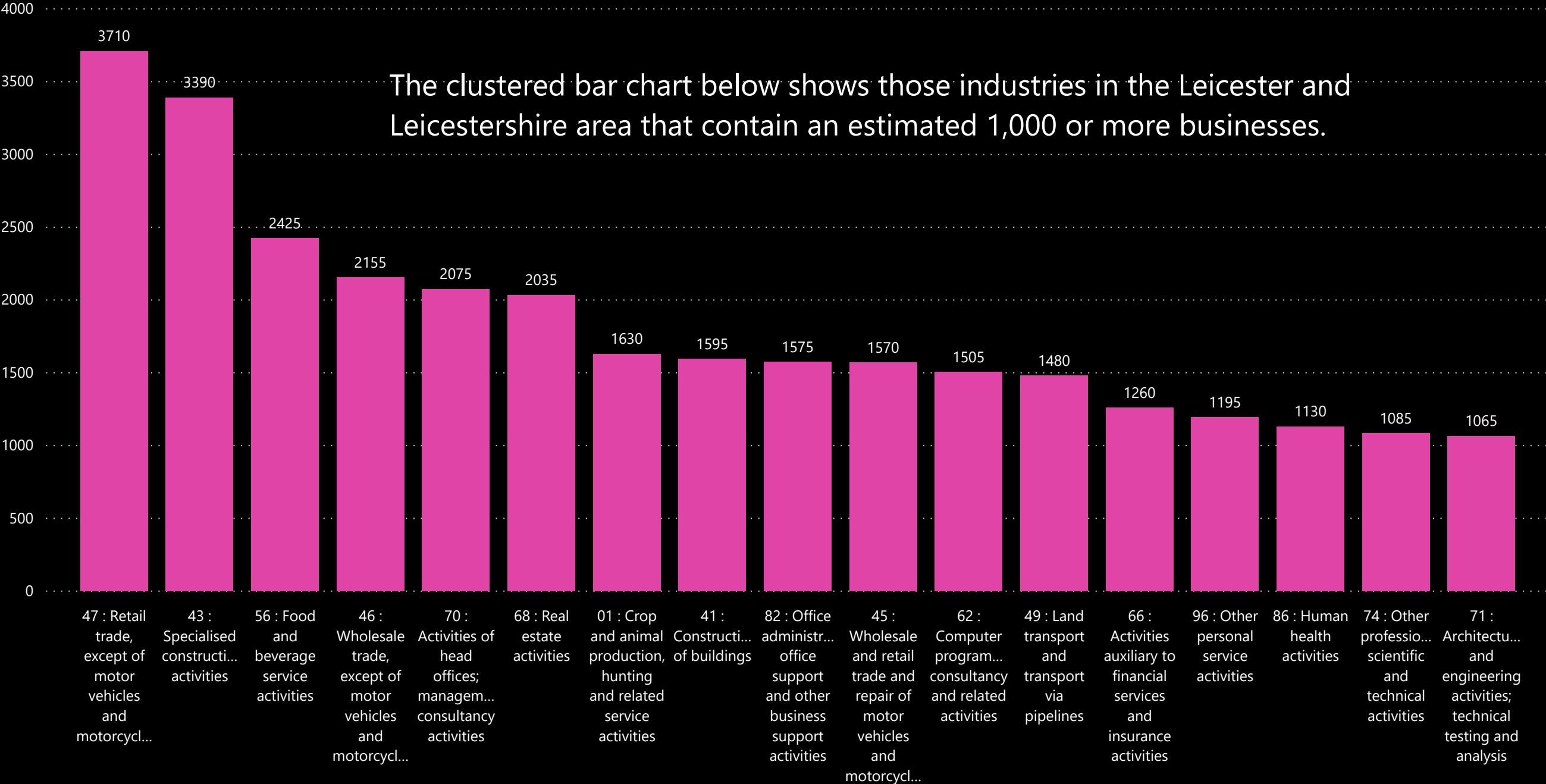
Estimated Business Growth in the Blaby Area 2021-2023 by Size

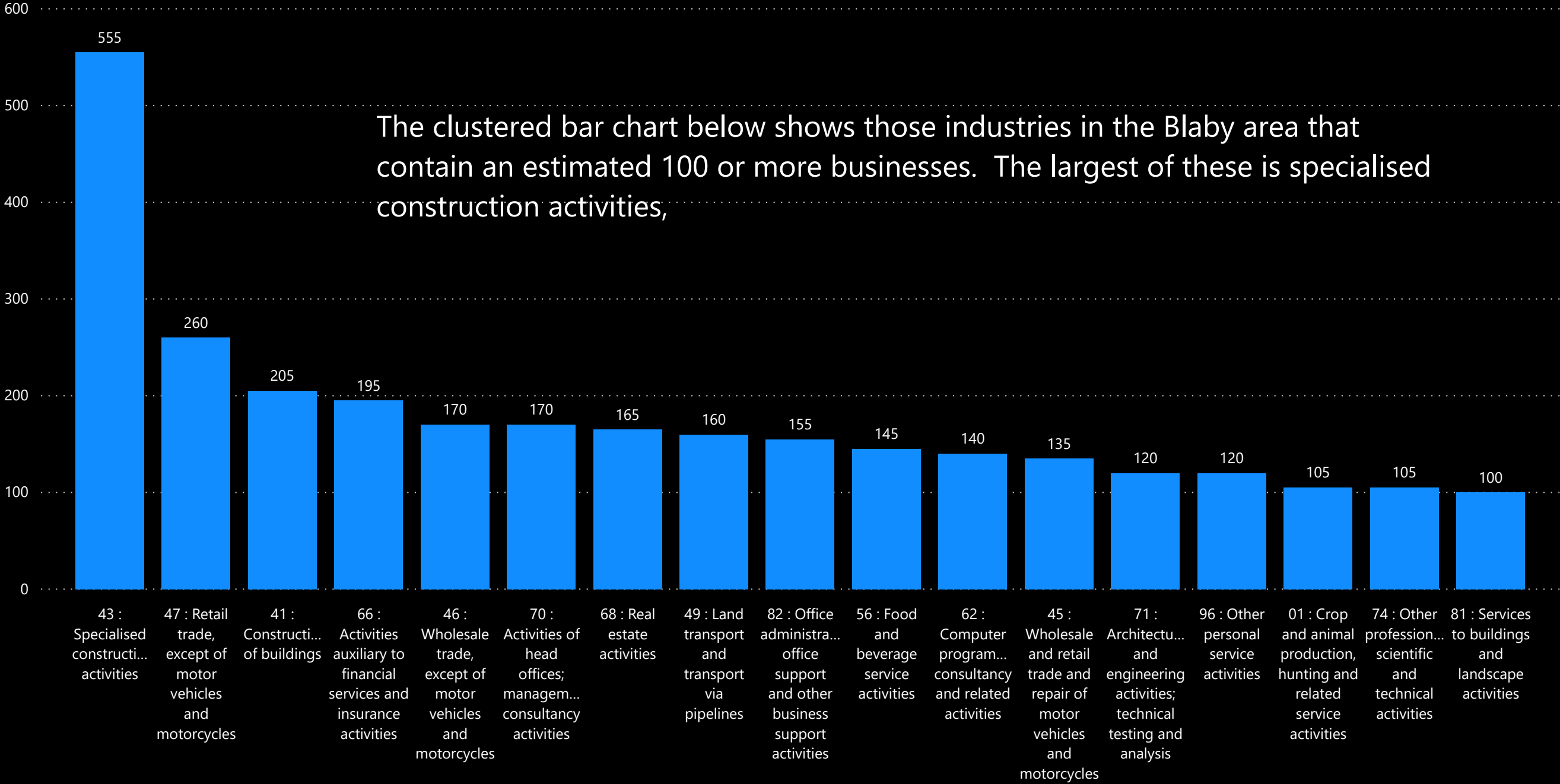
Industries with the Largest Estimated Numbers in the Leicester and Leicestershire Area

The clustered bar chart below shows those industries in the Leicester and Leicestershire area that contain an estimated 1,000 or more businesses.



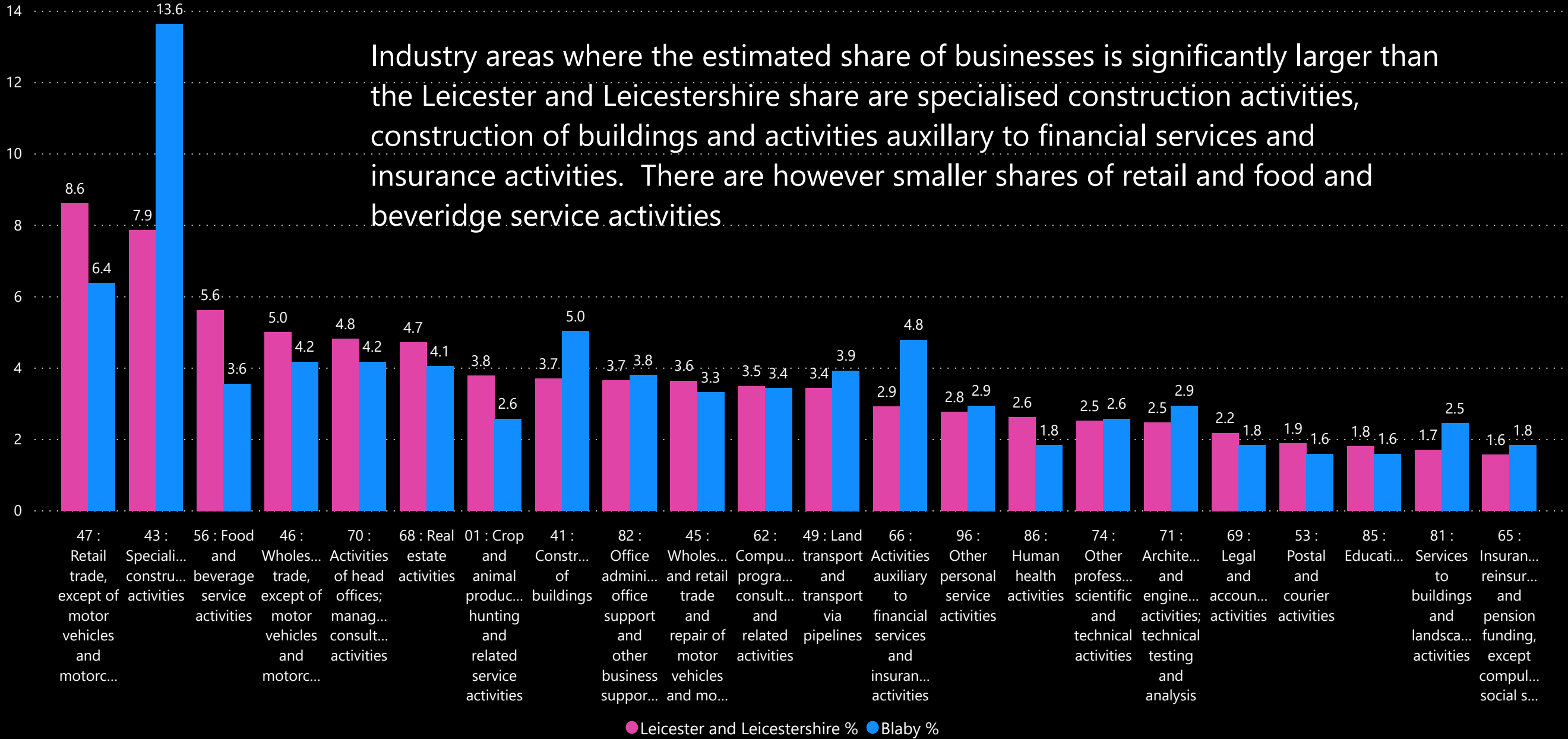
Industries with the Largest Estimated Numbers in the Blaby Area

The clustered bar chart below shows those industries in the Blaby area that contain an estimated 100 or more businesses. The largest of these is specialised construction activities,



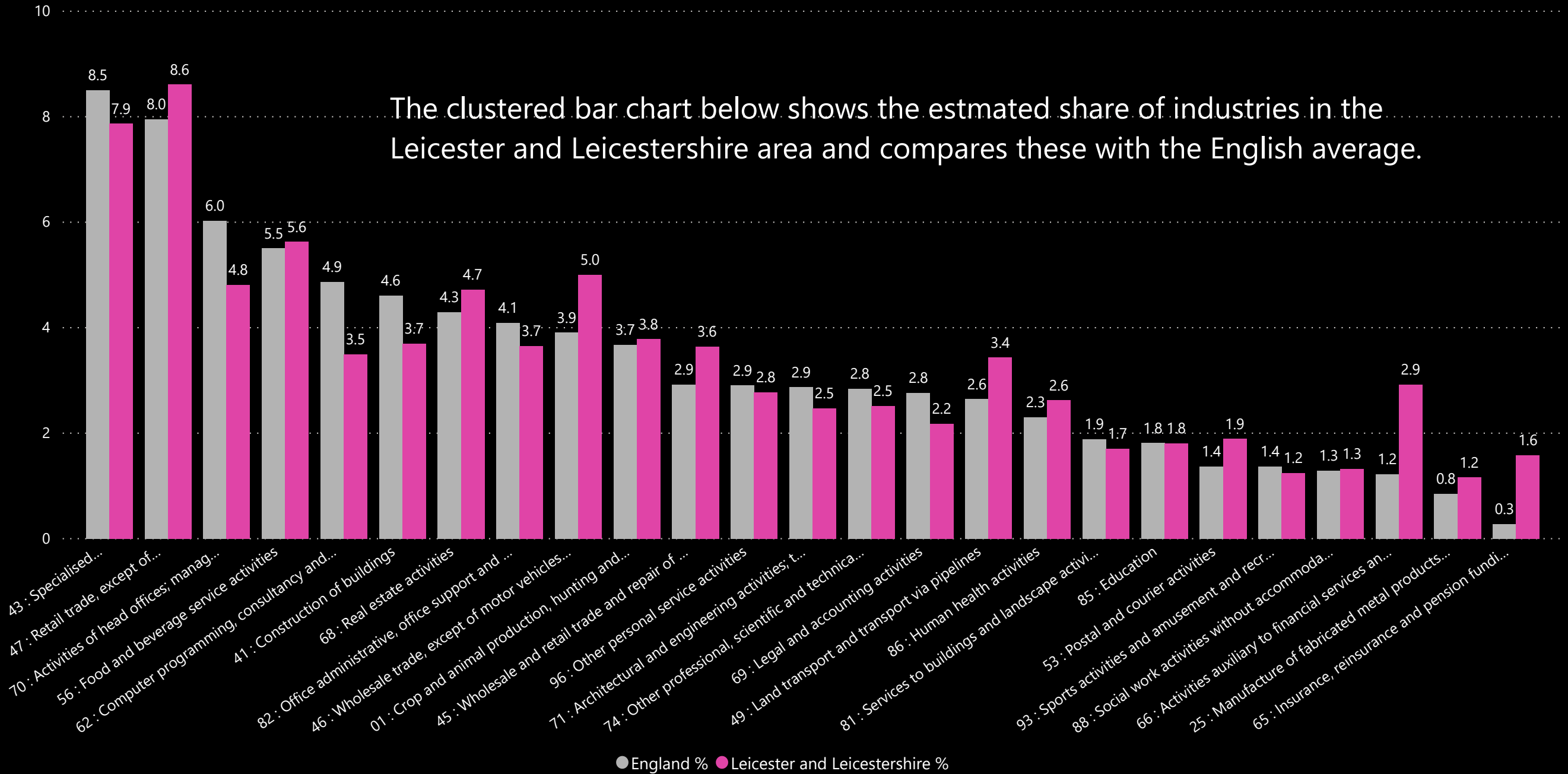
Benchmark Industry Share Blaby and the Leicester and Leicestershire Area 2023

There are however smaller shares of retail and food and beverage service activities



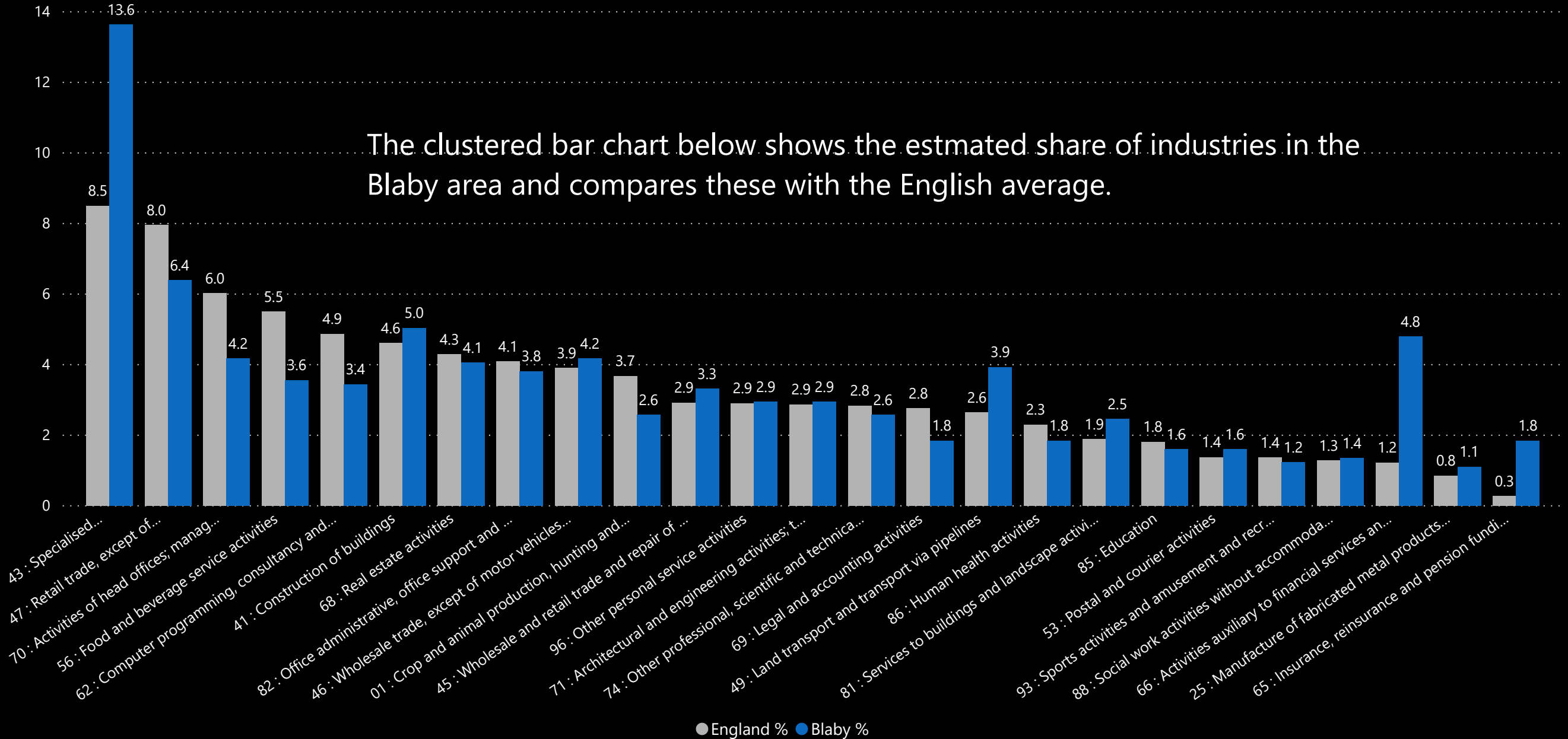

Blaby LQ by Industry

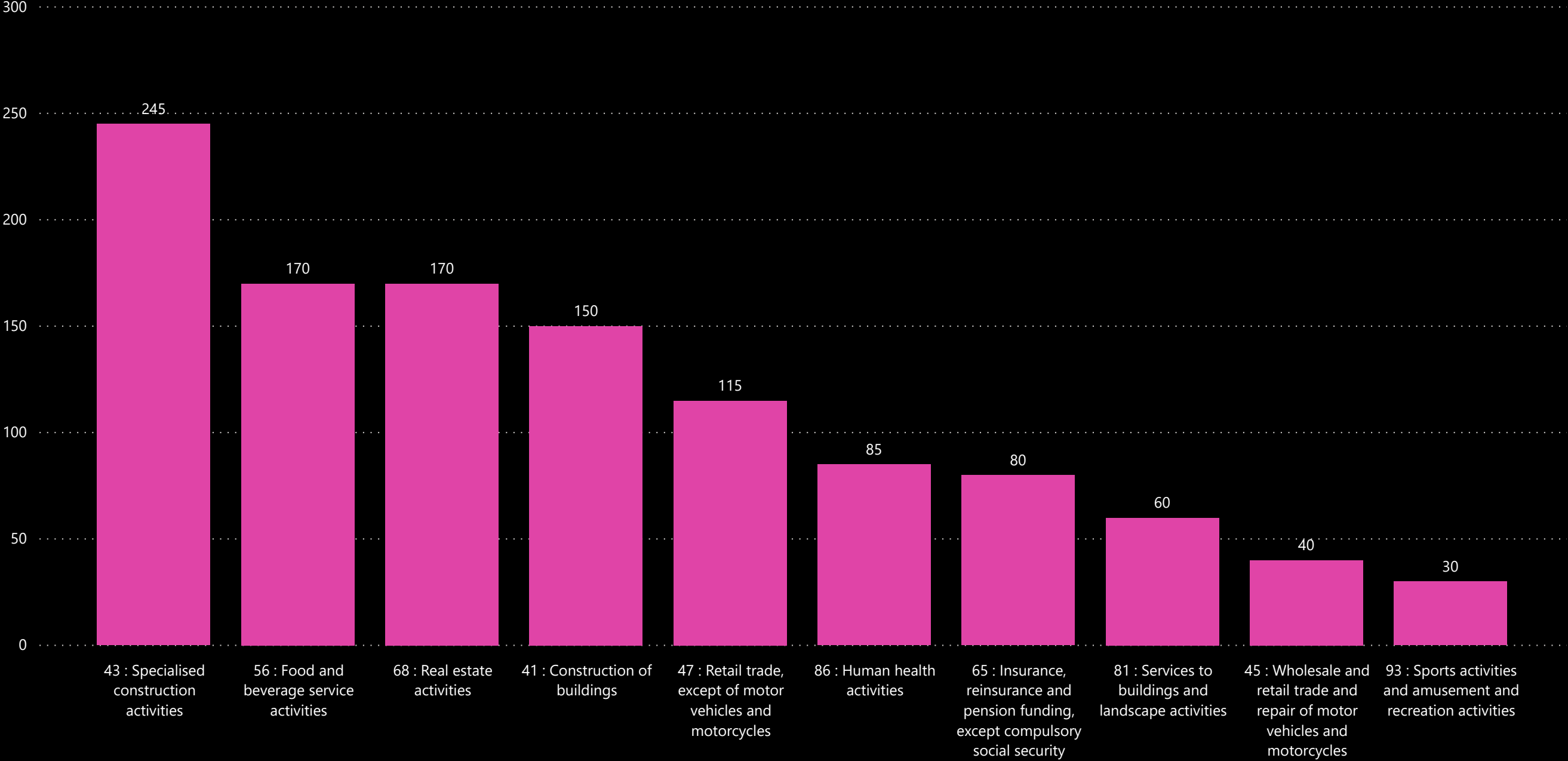

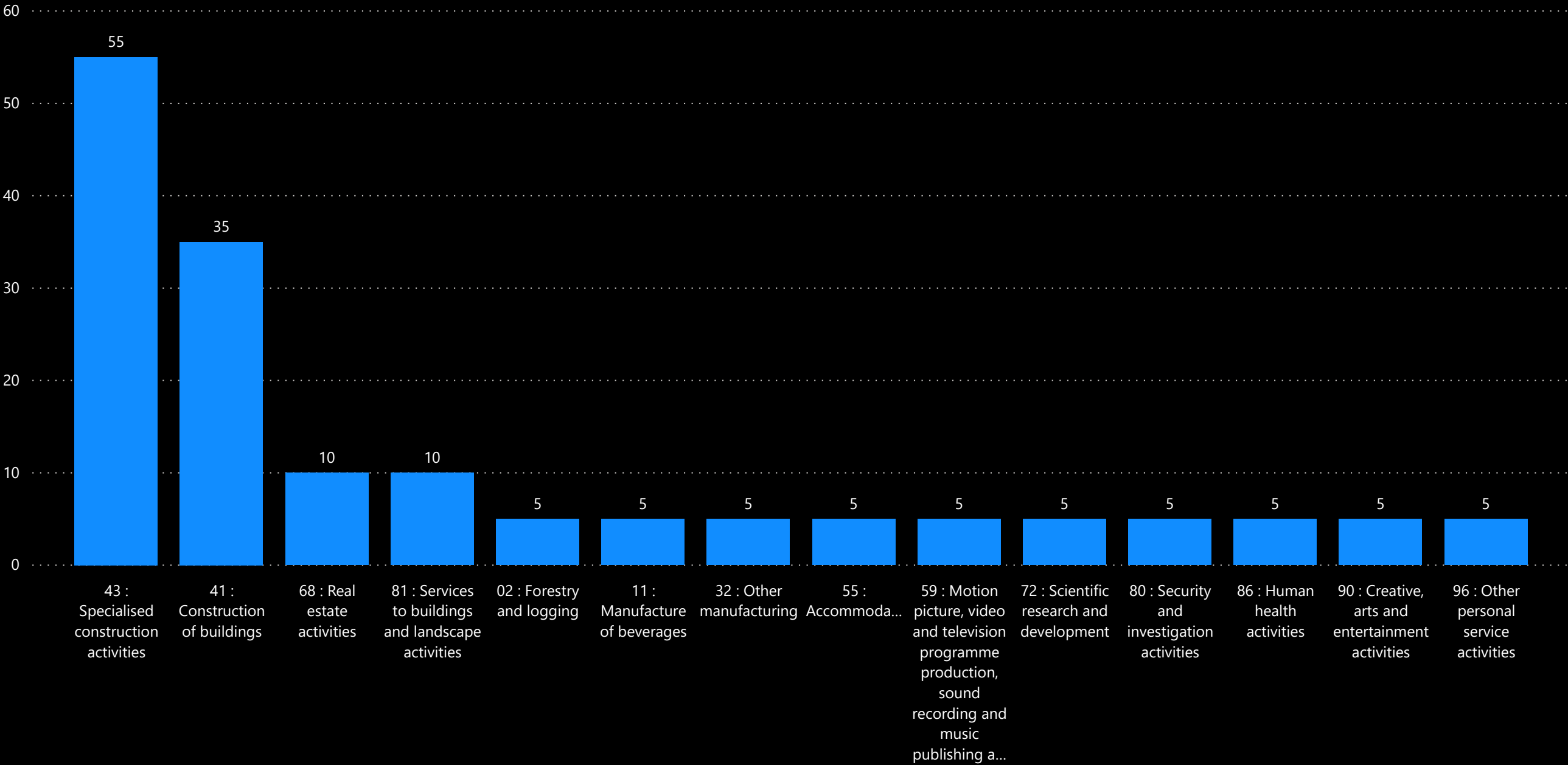

Note: Location quotients can be found by dividing the local share of business or employment for an industry by the average share (in this case England).

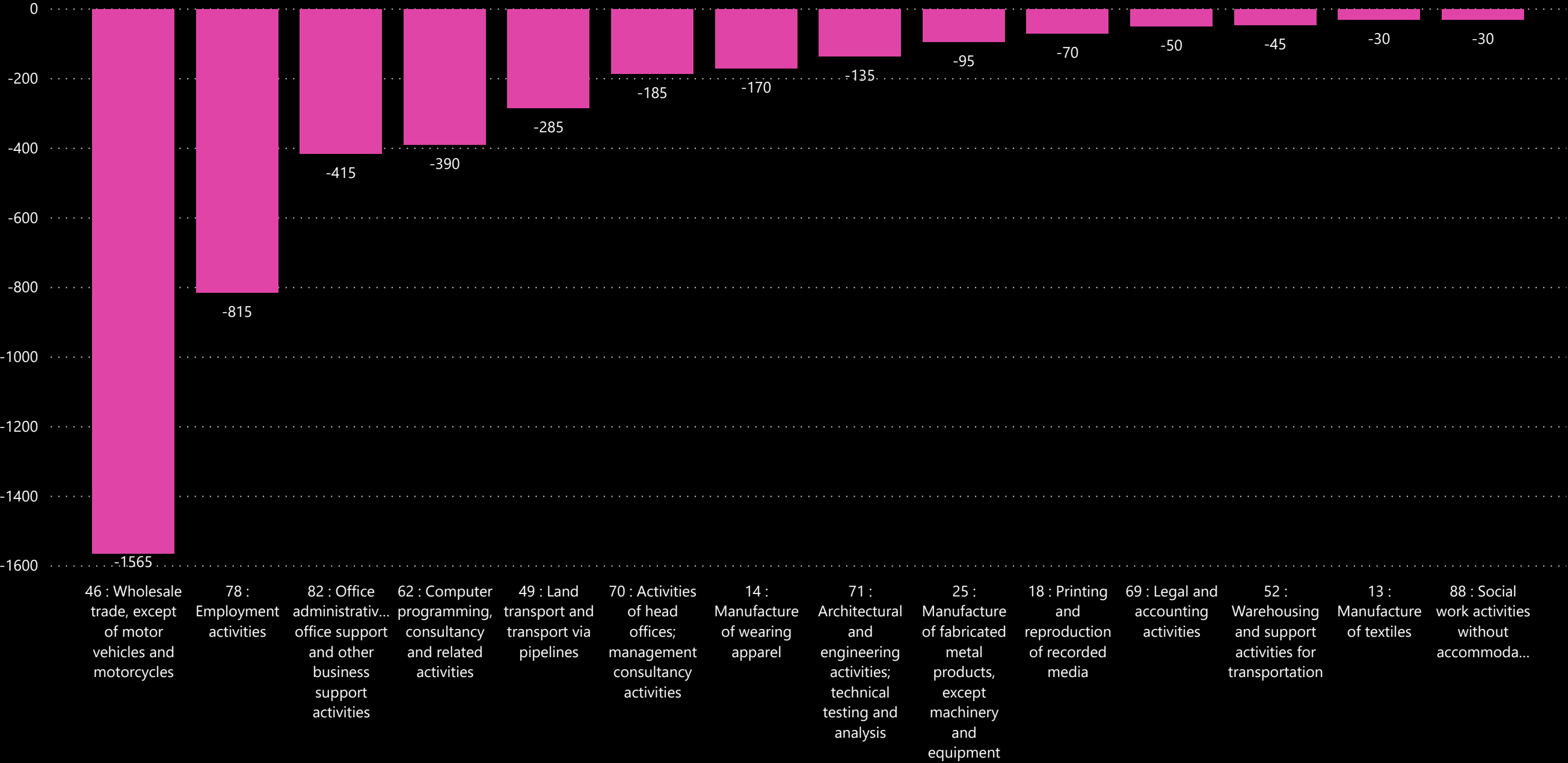
Largest Estimated Rises in Business Numbers 2021 to 2023 Leicester and Leicestershire



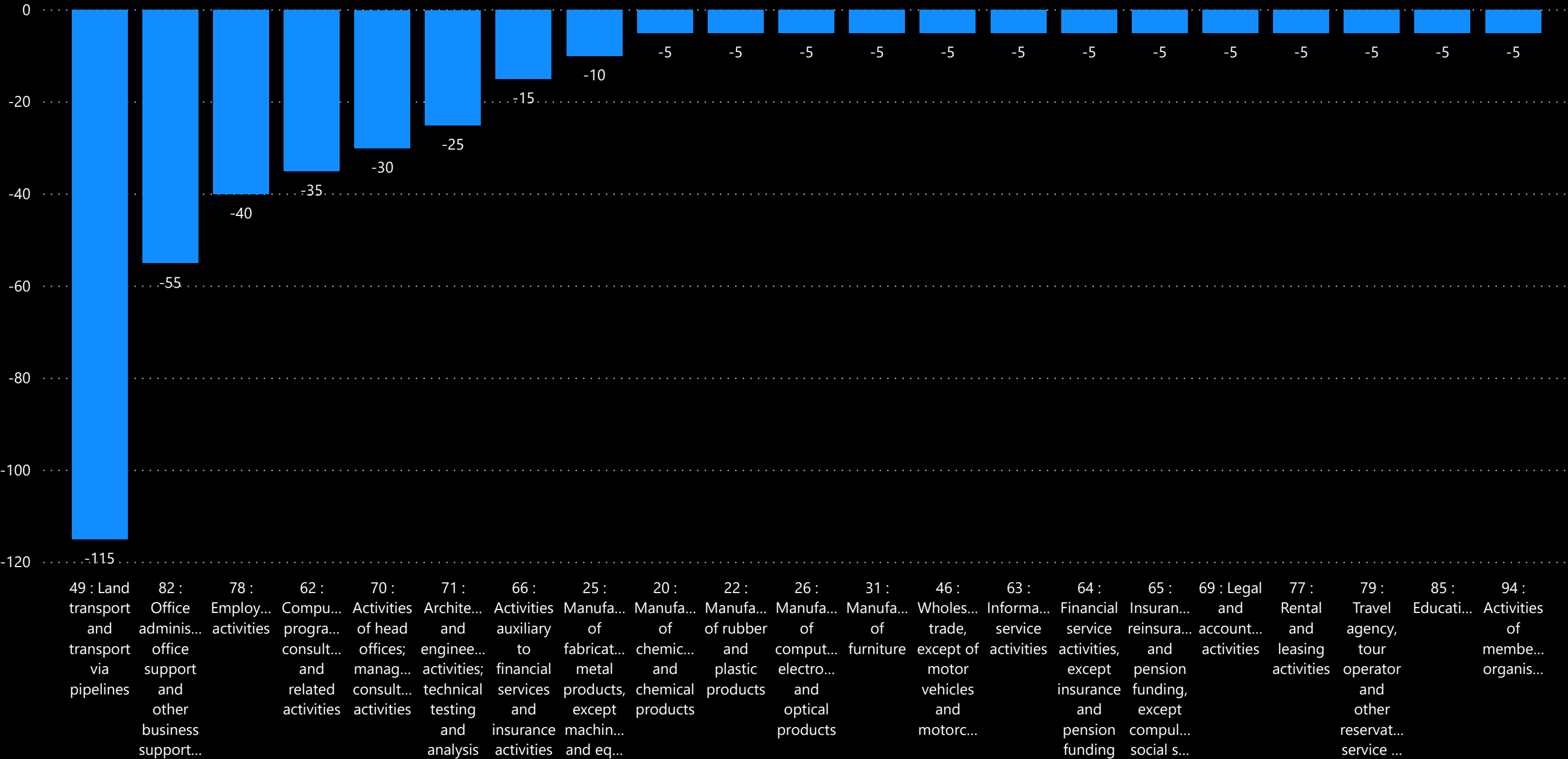
Largest Estimated Rises in Business Numbers 2021 to 2023 Blaby

Released at the 25/10/2023 the Office for National Statistics Business Registration and Employment Survey contains counts based on the number of employees and employment. This report uses employment numbers.

Data contained in the report covers the period 2014 to 2022 and is at a two digit level (Standard Industrial Code).

The Business Register and Employment Survey are estimates that are available at a range of geographies. The geographies used in this and accompanying reports are at the LLEP, local and district authority areas. Comparator data is made available at a national level (England).

Estimated Employment Population

In the Leicester and Leicestershire area in 2022 it was estimated that there was employment of 522,005. In the Blaby area there was employment of 65,140.

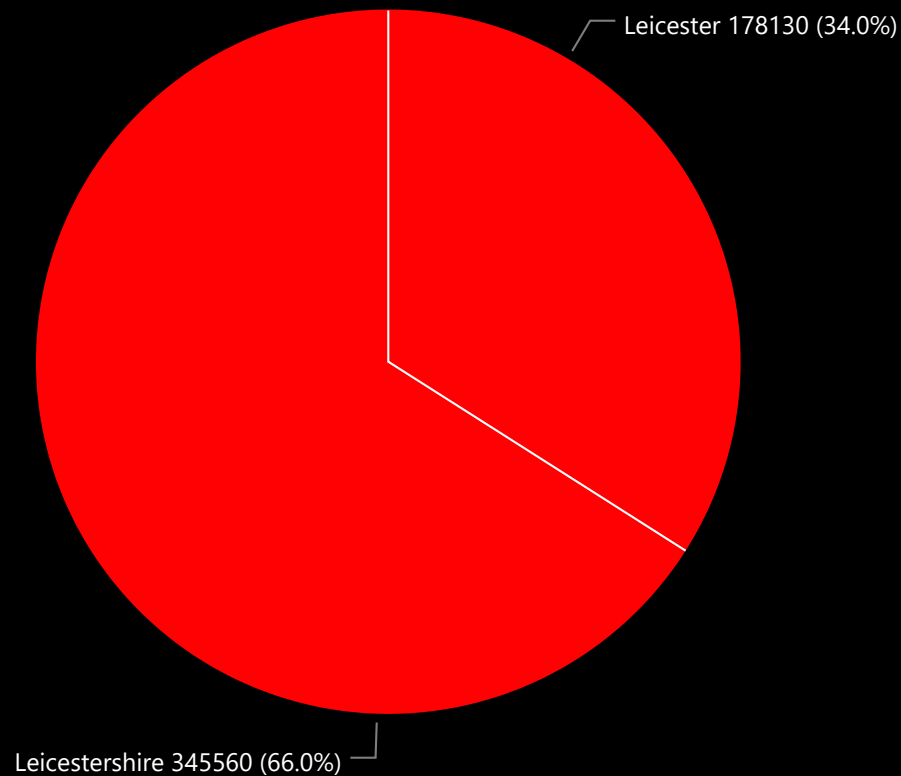

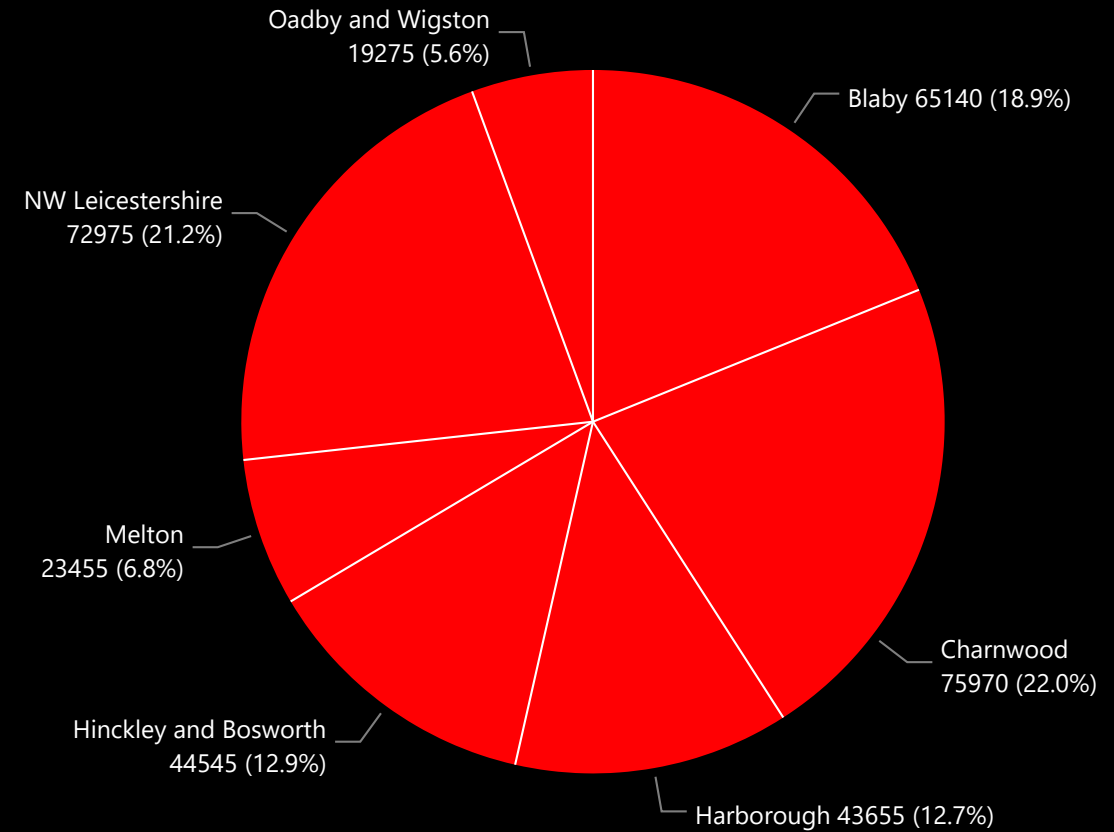
Local Authority and District Area Estimated Share of Employment

In 2022 two thirds (66% or 345,560) of the estimated local employment population of the Leicester and Leicestershire area were based in Leicestershire and the rest (34% or 178,130) in Leicester.

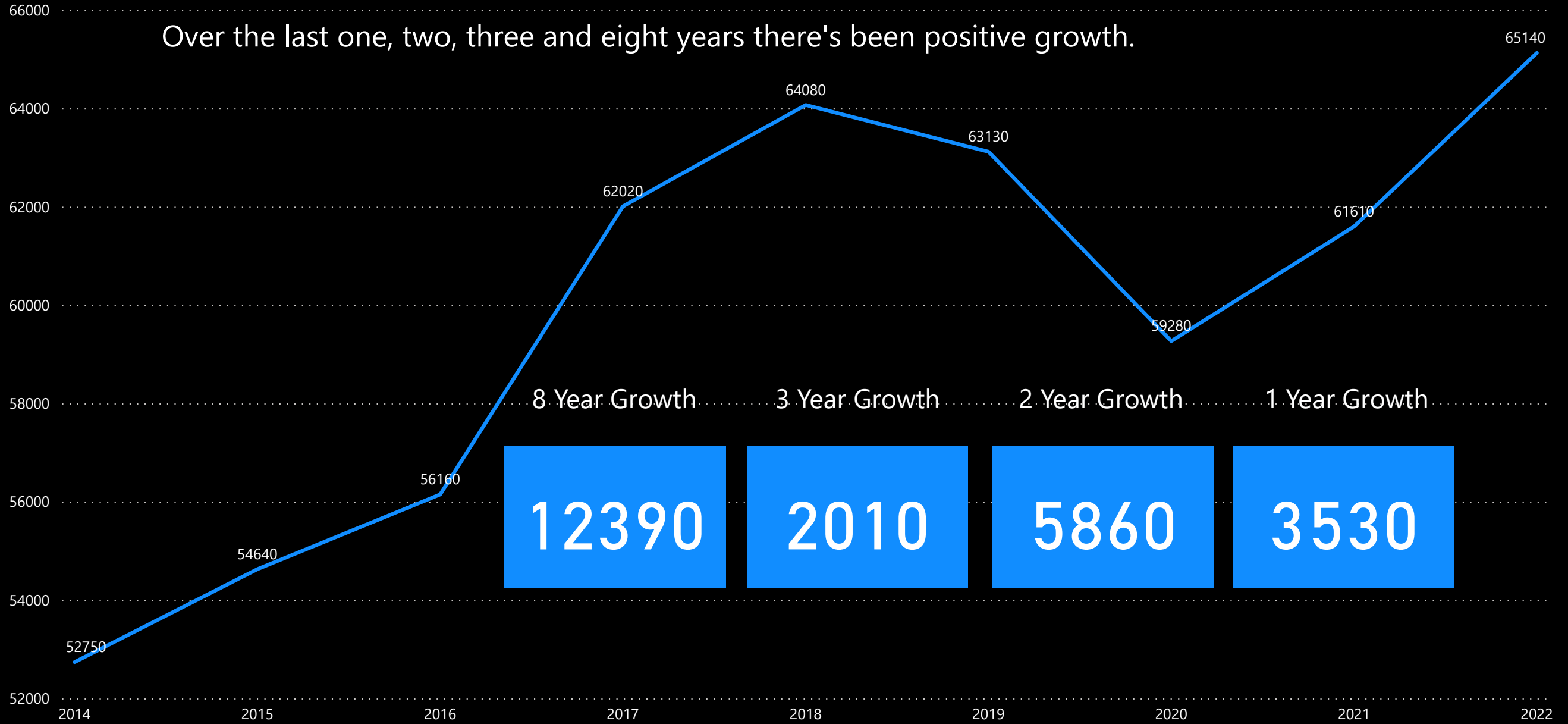


Estimated Employment Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire Area 2014 to 2022

Estimated Employment Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire Areas 2014 to 2022

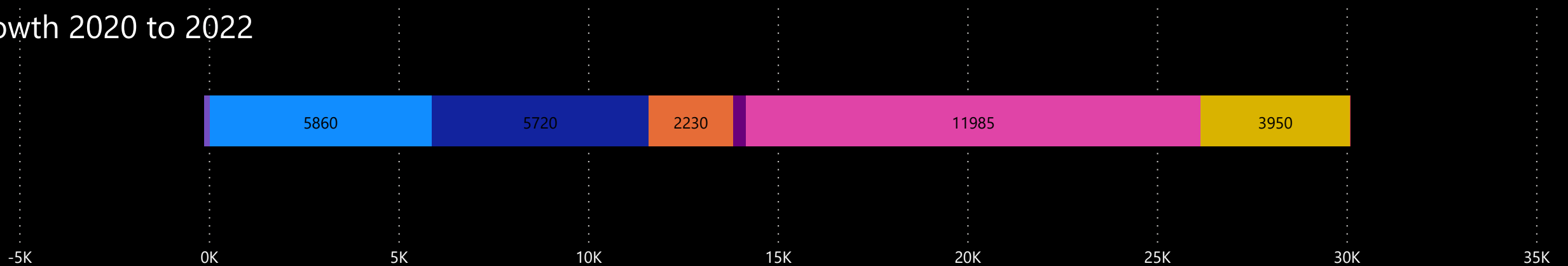

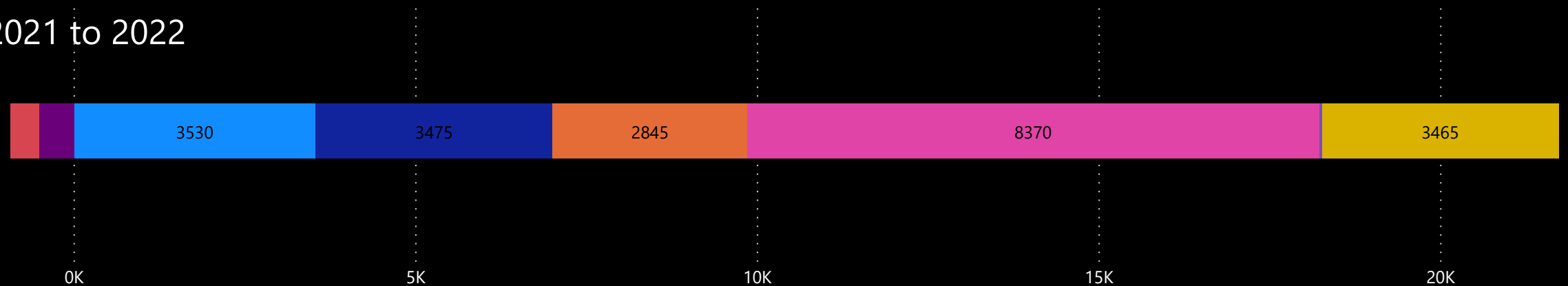

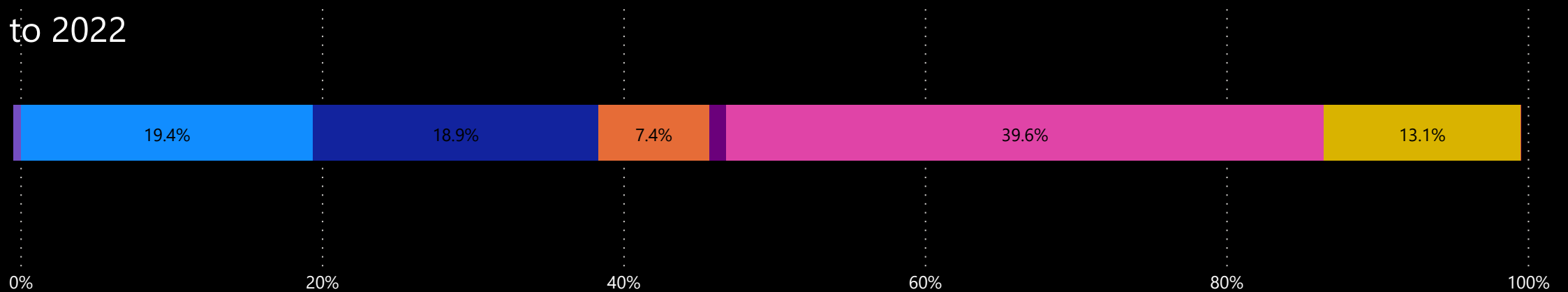


Estimated Share of Employment Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire Area 2020 to 2022 and 2021 to 2022

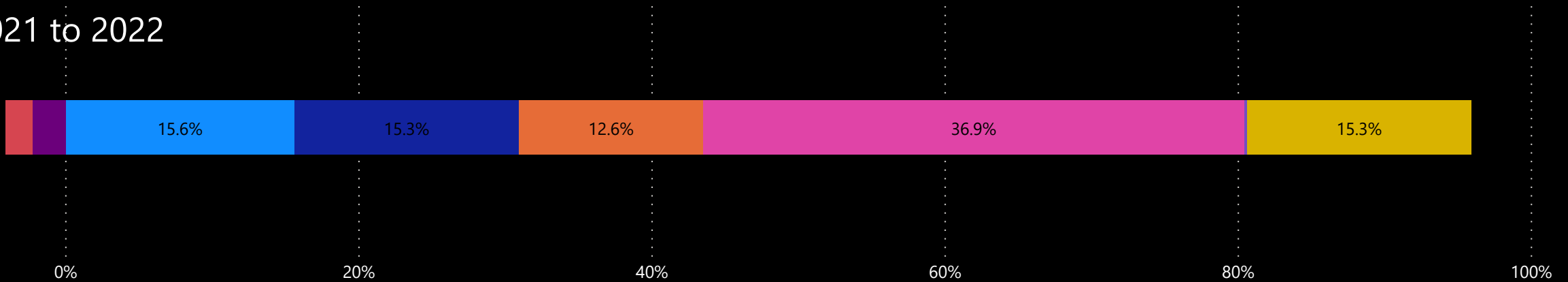

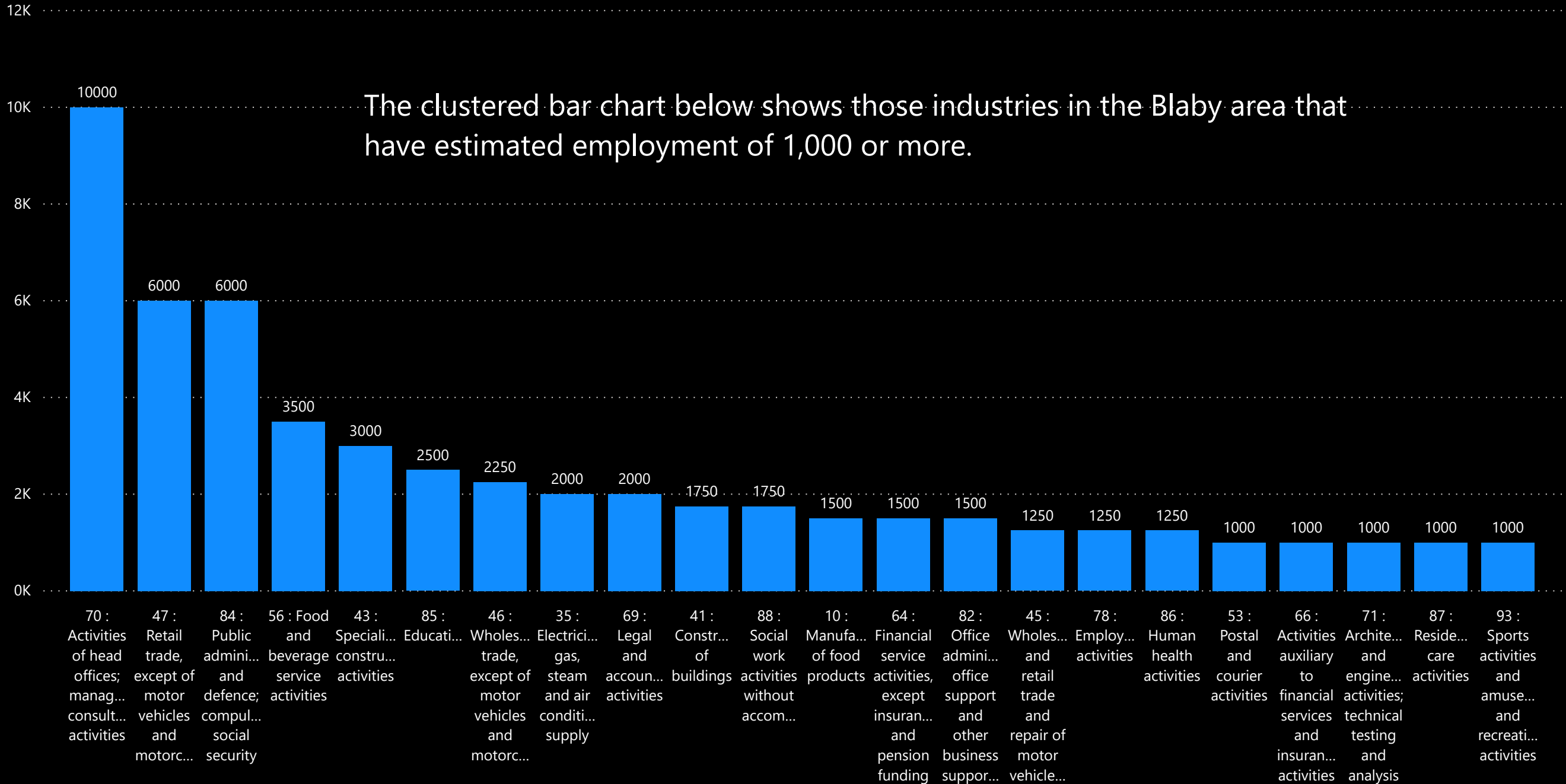

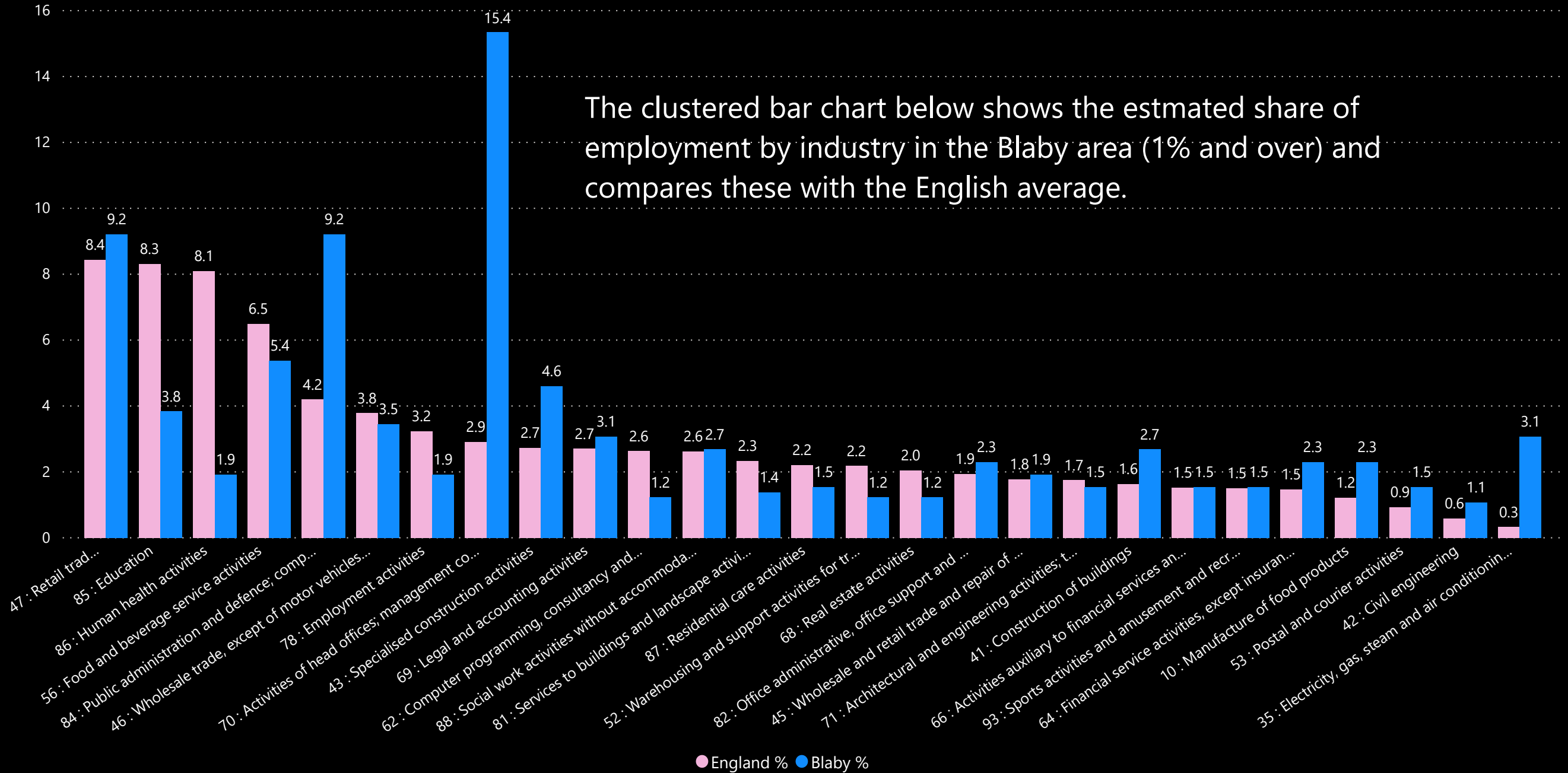
Industries with the Largest Estimated Employment Numbers in the Blaby Area 2022

Industry Employment Location Quotients Blaby Area 2022

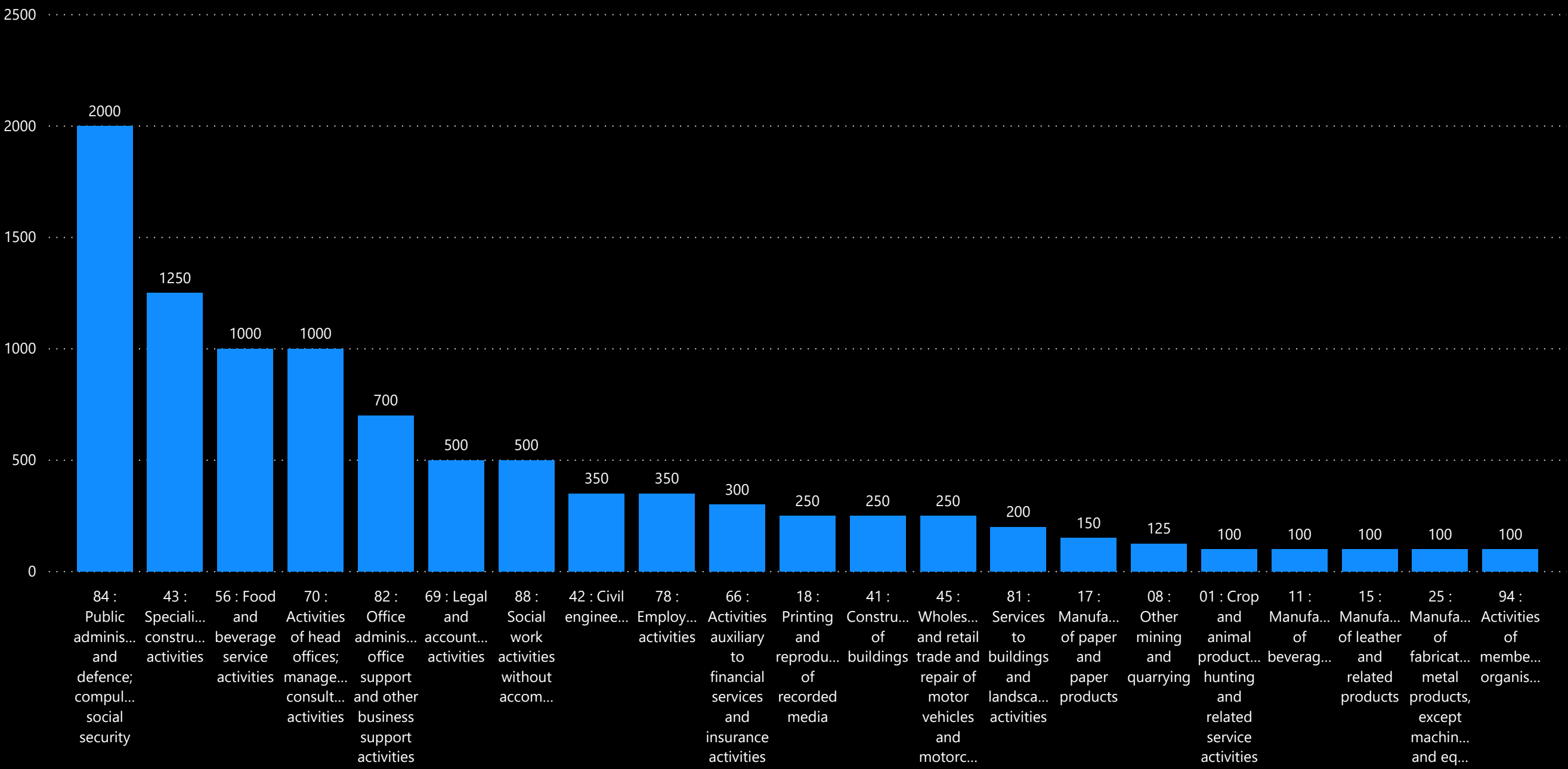

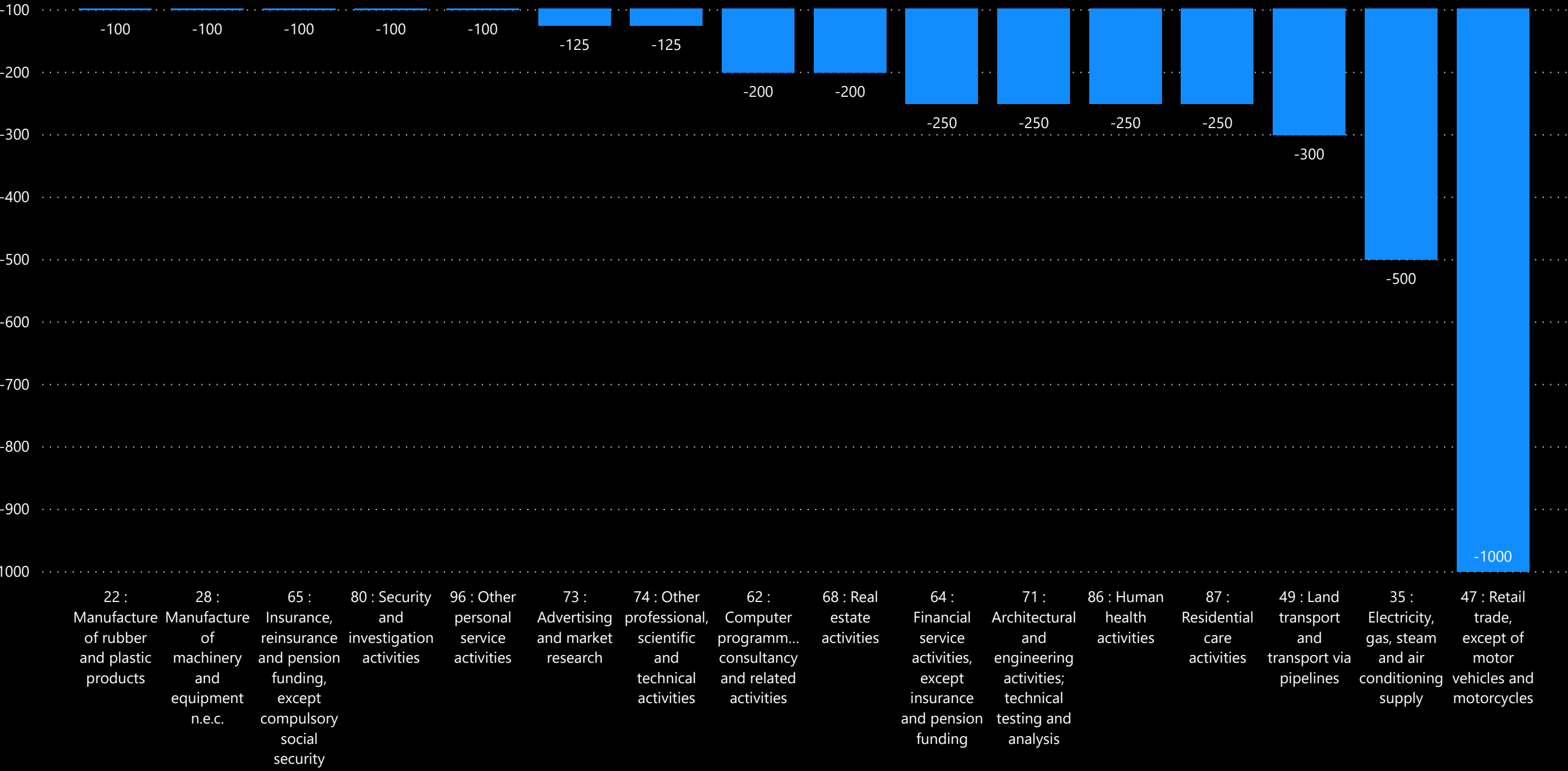
