# UK Business Counts 2023, Leicester and Leicestershire - Leicestershire

Released at the 27/09/2023 the Office for National Statistics UK Business Counts contains two datasets, one containing counts based on the number of enterprises and the other on local units. This report uses the number of enterprises.

An enterprise can be thought of as the overall business, made up of individual sites or workplaces. A local unit is an individual site associated with an enterprise. As may be expected there are more local units than enterprises.

Data contained in the report covers the period 2015 to 2023 and is at a two digit level (Standard Industrial Code).

UK Business Counts are estimates that are available at a range of geographies. The geographies used in this and accompanying reports are at the LLEP, local and distrct authority areas. Comparator data is made available at a national level (England).


# Estimated Business Population.

In the Leicester and Leicestershire area in 2023 it was estimated that there were 43,085 businesses. In the Leicestershire area there were 29,590.



### Local Authority and District Area Estimated Share of Business Population.


In 2023 over two thirds (68.7% or 29,590) of the estimated local business population of the Leicester and Leicestershire area were based in Leicestershire and the rest (31.3% or 13,500) in Leicester.



### Estimated Business Growth in the Leicester and Leicestershire Area 2015 to 2023




### Estimated Business Growth in the Leicestershire Area 2015 to 2023







### Industries with the Largest Estimated Numbers in the Leicester and Leicestershire Area




### Industries with the Largest Estimated Numbers in the Leicestershire Area





### Benchmark Industry Share Leicestershire and England Areas 2023




### Industry Business Location Quotients Leicester and Leicestershire Area 2023




### Industry Business Location Quotients Leicestershire Area 2023

The clustered bar chart demonstrates location quotients based on industry share locally compared to the share nationally. Location quotients that are 1.5 and above are considered to be area specialities. Local specialities can be a good or bad thing depending on the industry. High location quotients do not guarantee high business or employment numbers. Those industries shown have 30 or more businesses.




### Largest Estimated Rises in Business Numbers 2021 to 2023 Leicester and Leicestershire






## **Estimated Employment Population**


In the Leicester and Leicestershire area in 2022 it was estimated that there was employment of 522,005. In the Leicester area there was employment of 345,560.




### Local Authority and District Area Estimated Share of Employment


### Estimated Employment Growth in the Leicestershire Area 2014 to 2022








### Industries with the Largest Estimated Employment Numbers in the Leicestershire Area




## Benchmark Industry Share of Employment Leicestershire and England Areas 2022




