Over three weeks, students have worked in groups, each taking on a different role from design engineers to health and safety managers.

During the final week they had to present their projects to the Cavendish volunteers. The students were fantastic and Cavendish were really impressed.

The winning group will be taking part in a workshop at their site in February and all groups received a goodie bag for all their hard work.

The aim is to link school subjects to the world of work, raise aspirations and broaden horizons by opening children's eyes to the multitude of jobs in the sector, and providing career insights and networking opportunities with our colleagues.

Their new Aerozone with its interactive role-play areas, will have a number of new activities and resources using digital technology to bring the airport to life, including a new flight simulator.
