Blaby Annual Economic Profile 2023

Introduction

Since the completion of the last economic profile (2022) there have been many changes to the economy.

The completion of the last profile was marked by the reopening of the economy and the withdrawal of government support for business following the Covid 19 pandemic. The reopening of markets saw a resetting of the economy which led to some businesses/ industries having to rethink how they operate/ do business.

Some businesses/ industries were affected more than others. For many this has been a tough period of trading that has been further exasperated by world events. The resetting of and recovery of the economy looks to go well beyond 2023, the war in Ukraine, staff and skills shortages, energy prices, Brexit, a cost of living crises and inflationary pressures are set to prolong recovery and uncertainty is likely to remain a key feature of the local and national economies.

Purpose

Annual Economic Profiles have been produced since 2013. Their purpose is to bring together data from a variety of sources that:

- Help provide a snapshot of the local economy.
- Demonstrate how the local economy is performing.
- Show what businesses support the economy and local employment and where this is changing.
- Illustrate where there are economic strengths and weaknesses.
- Help to understand where there has been growth and how the economy has changed.

Note: It is important to understand that some data supplied has time-lags. As a result data may not fully appreciate how local and national events have impacted the economy.





Activity LA Share




In the Blaby area 55,000 people were economically active. This was 90.2% of those that were of working age. The England average was 78.7%.


The 55,000 make up 10.5% of the population of the Leicester and Leicesteshire area that are economically active.




Activity Share (LLEP Area)



Activity District Share




Activity Share (Leicestershire)




Economic Activity Sex

Of the male working age population 94.4% (29,100) were economically active. Of the female working age population 85.9% (25,900) were active.

Fifty two point nine percent of those who were economically active were male and 47.1% were female.






Economic Inactivity

In the Blaby area 6,000 were economically inactive. This was 9.8% of those that were of working age. The average was 21.3%. Of those that were economically inactive 4.3% lived in Blaby.







Inactivity LA Share




Inactivity LA Numbers




Inactivity Share (LLEP Area)



Inactivity District Share




Inactivity Share (Leicestershire)




Economic Inactivity Sex

Of the male working age population 5.6% (1,700) were economically inactive. Of the female working age population 14.1% (4,300) were inactive.


Seventy one point seven percent of those that were inactive were female and 28.3% male. The England average was 58.8% and 41.2%.



Inactivity Share Comparator




Economic Inactivity Sex



Job Type Occupation Numbers


With employment of 11,800 Professional is the largest of the broad occupation areas identified.




Job Type Occupation Share

Of the broad occupation areas identified there were 5 with a 10% share or more of jobs. With a share of 21% of all jobs Professional is the largest occupation area, it is however smaller than average (26.4%).

The Blaby area has on average a larger share of Skilled Trade and Administrative and Secretarial occupations. There are on average fewer Professional and Elementary occupations.



Professional as a share of all occupations has seen significant growth since 2017.




Job Postings Year to Date (June)

In 2023 there have been 1,472 unique job postings in the Blaby area (up to the end of June).


When the year to date figures for June 2023 are compared to those for June 2016, 2017 etc. figures for 2023 are considerably higher. In 2022 there were 2,593 unique job postings. This is higher than other years.




Job Postings Year to Date (Whole Year)



Job Postings (2016 - 2023)




Job Postings (2020 - 2023)







Historically there have been more male claimants than female claimants. At it's highest point (May 2020) the rate was for males was 5.5%. At it's highest the female claimant rate was 3.6%. (August 2020).

The latest figure (June) was 2.2% for males and 1.8% for females.










The graphs demonstrates quarterly unemployment figures from 2011 to 2022. The latest figure is 1,000 (1.7%) (reporting quarter January 2022 to December 2022). Over the last year (from January 2021 to December 2021) unemployment has fallen from 4.1%. At a national level over the last year unemployment has fallen from 4.6% to 3.6%. Blaby's unemployment rate is 1.9 percentage




Business Size

In 2022 there were 4,150 businesses. The majority of businesses in the area (89.2% or 3,700) were micro businesses (less than 10 staff). This is in line with the average (89.6%).


There were 365 (8.8%) small businesses, 65 (1.6%) medium and 15 (0.4%) large businesses.

Combined small and medium sized (not micro) make up 430 (10.4%) businesses.








Business Size Time Series (2011 to 2022)












Business Structure 2022




Business Sector Share 2022 Comparator


Dissolved and Incorporated Businesses Monthly and YTD

Traditionally and as demonstrated in the graphs below, the number of business incorporations has been been larger than business closures. The relationship between incorporations and closures has changed. This was especially in the case in 2021 and 2022.. Figures for 2023 demonstrate a continuation of this trend and figures up to the end of June show more closures than incorporations.


Dissolved and Incorporated Monthly Businesses



Dissolved and Incorporated Businesses Year to Date






Employment Location Quotients











Resident Earnings

Median resident earnings in the Blaby area are £650.50. This is above the average of £645.80. Male resident earnings in the area are £672.20, this is lower than average (£690). Male resident earnings are higher than female resident earnings (£583.90).




Workplace Earnings

Median workplace earnings in the Blaby area are £678.80 (resident earnings £650.50). This is above the average of £645.60. Male workplace earnings in the area are £698.80 (resident earnings £672.20), again this is higher than average (£689.90). Male workplace earnings are higher than female workplace earnings (£619.10). Female workplace earnings are also higher than average (£584.50).










Population Sex




Population Age
